It consist of 50 states.

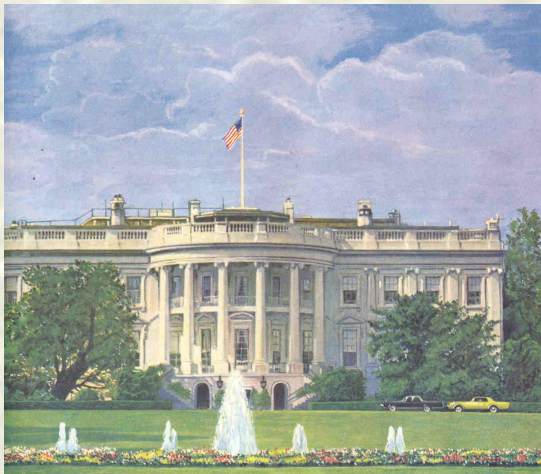

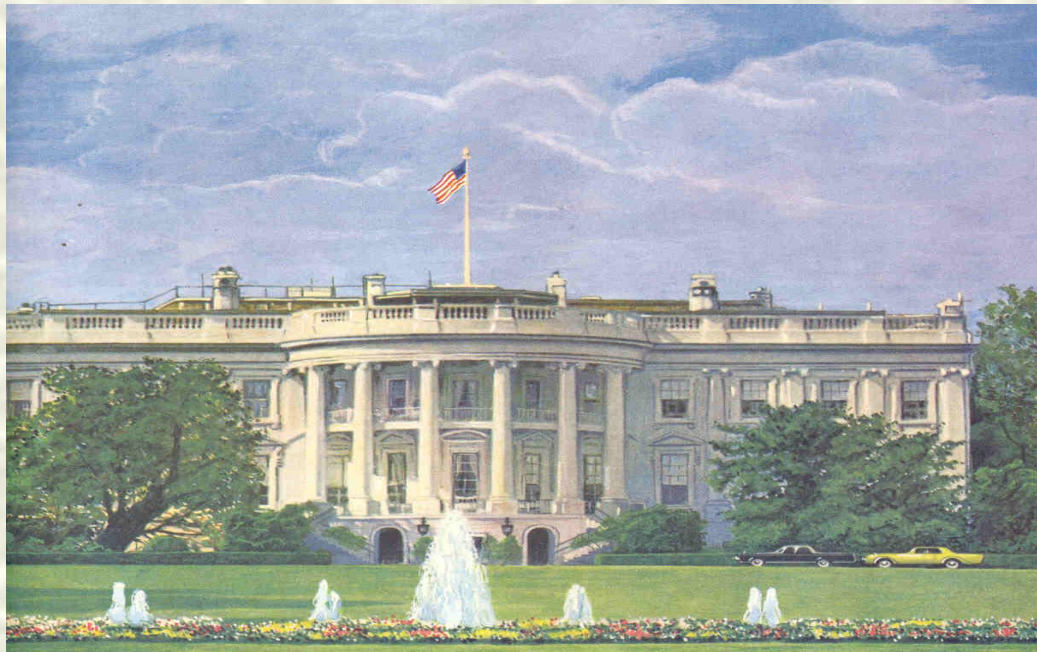

The Statue of Liberty.

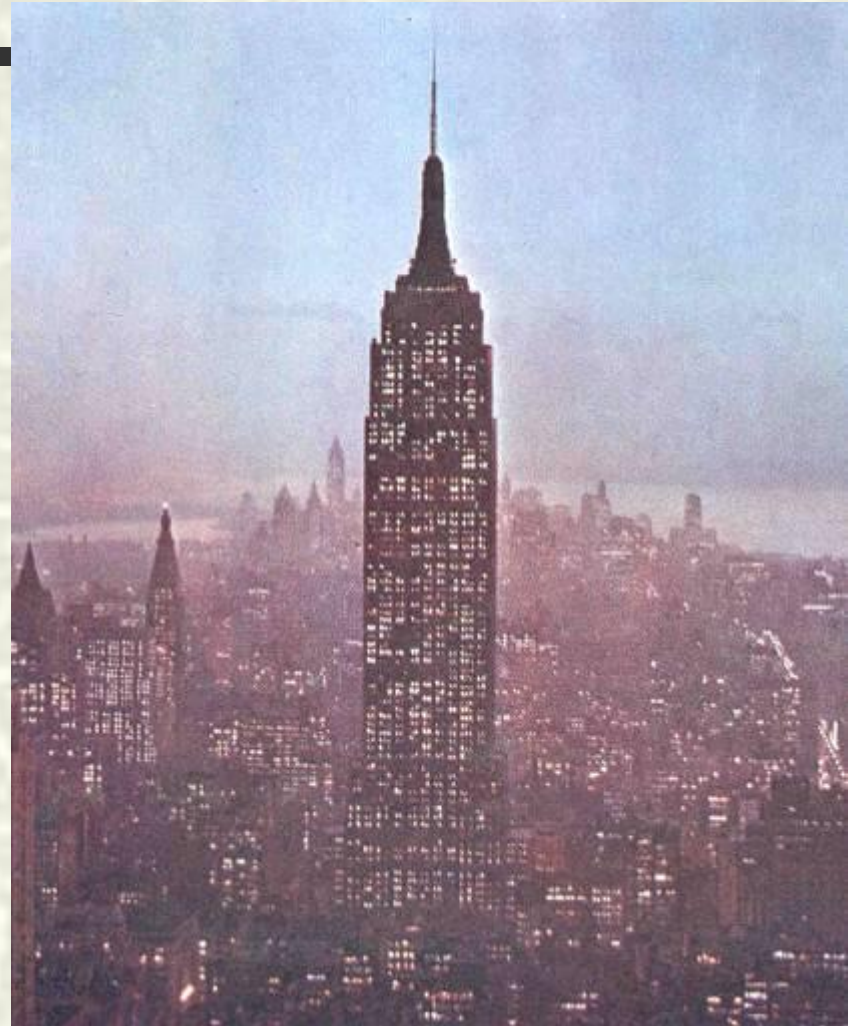


It stands on a small island at the entrance to New York harbour. It is nearly 100 metres above the water level.

Brooklyn Bridge.

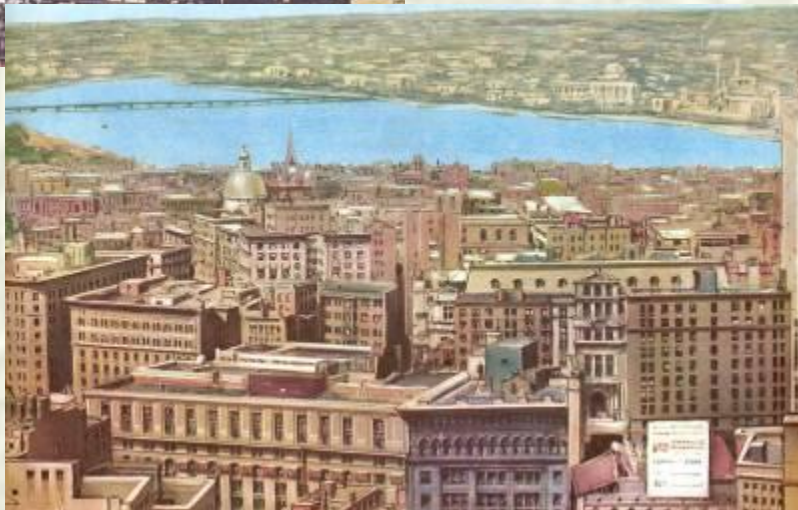
**It was completed in 1883.
