
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Russia

Functions of the President of the Russian Federation:

- guarantees the basic rights of people;
- appoints the Chairman of the Government;
- · can dissolve the Duma;
- can veto laws passed by the Federal Assembly;
- sign bills.

State authority The legislature branch

Functions of the legislature branch of the Russian Federation:

- approves the Chairman of the Government;
- makes laws;
- · approves the government;
- · declare a war;
- assent to changes in taxation.

State authority The executive branch

Functions of the executive branch of the Russian Federation:

- organization of practical implementation of the Constitution and laws of the Russian Federation;
- administrative control after the observance of legal norms and obligatory rules;
- direct providing of safety of citizens and society.

State authority The judicial branch

Functions of the judicial branch of the Russian Federation:

- justice;
- interpretation of legal norms;
- the identity of the facts of legal significance;
