I am going to present a flower to my girlfriend!



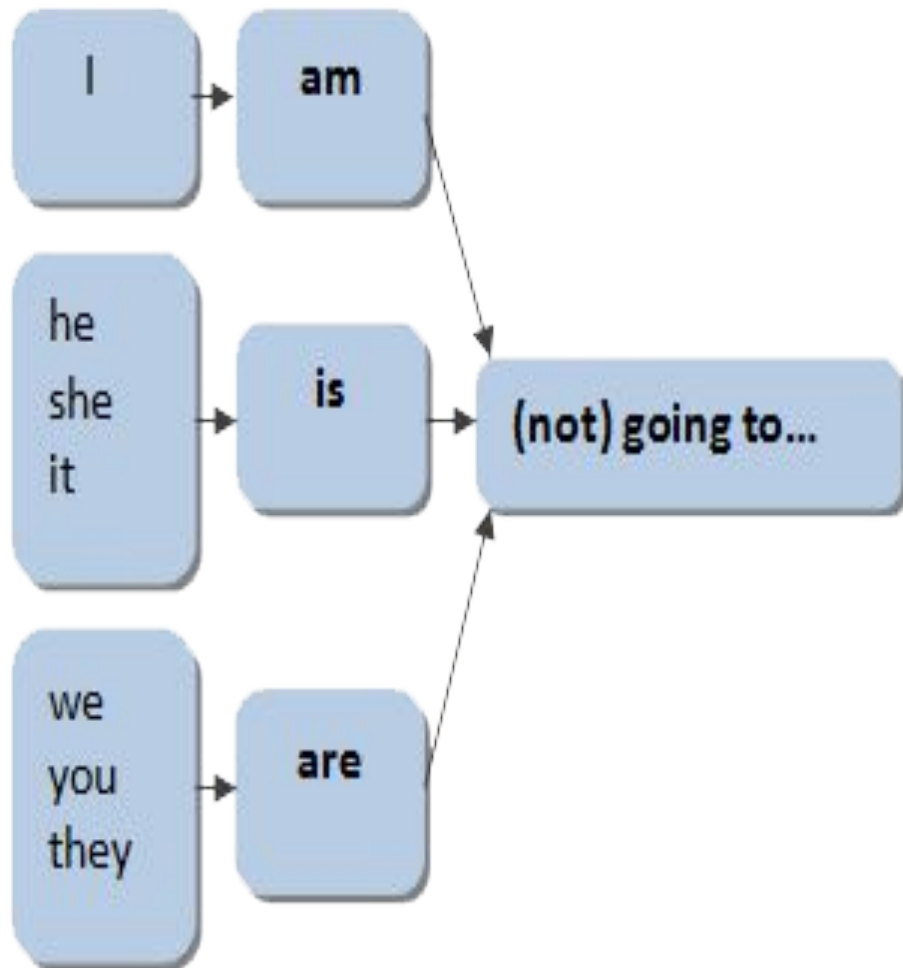
Конструкция **to be going to do sth** употребляется для того, чтобы показать, что решение уже принято и имеется намерение что-то сделать.

**Sarah is going to** sell her car. Сара собирается продать машину.

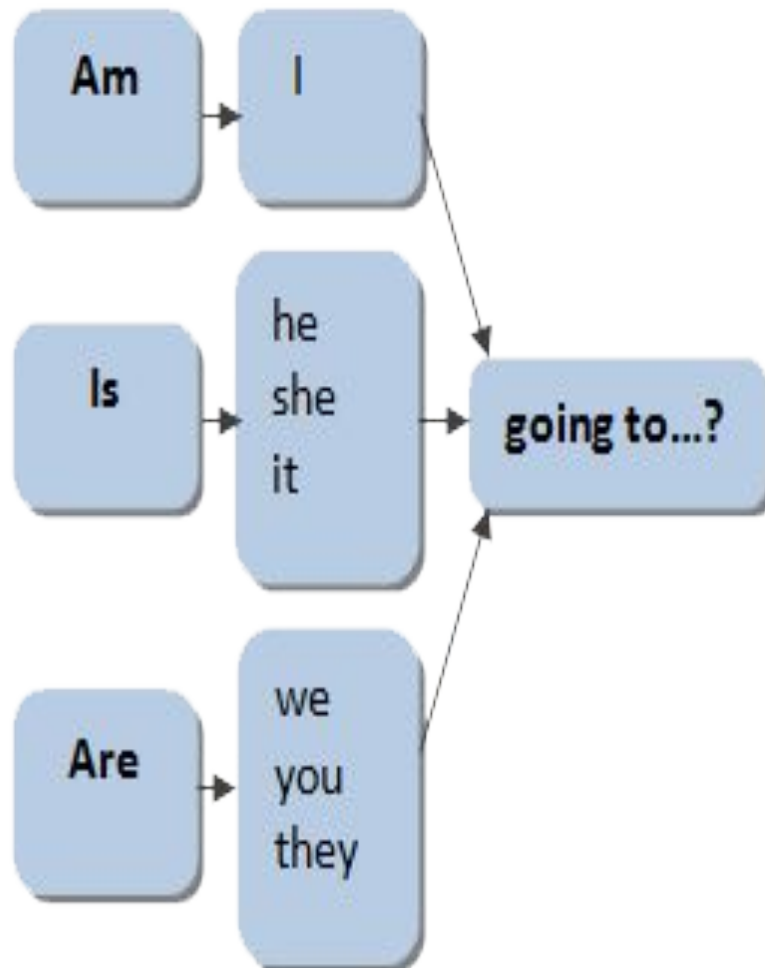
Look at the sky! **It's going to** rain.
