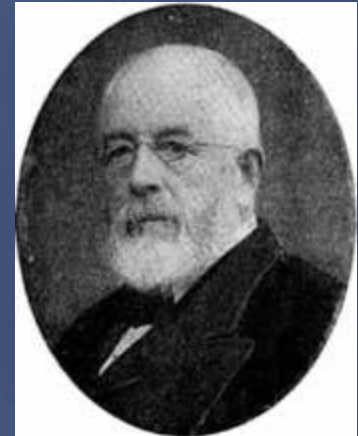

- The collection contains 2 970 214 items, including:
- paintings , works of graphic art , sculptures , archeological objects , numismatics and other exhibit items .  
The museum was founded in 1764 when Empress Catherine the Great purchased a collection of Flemish and Dutch paintings (225) from the Berlin merchant Johann Ernest Gotzkowski.
- The museum's storerooms, exhibitions, departments and services are housed in 10 buildings, one of them is Winter Palace.

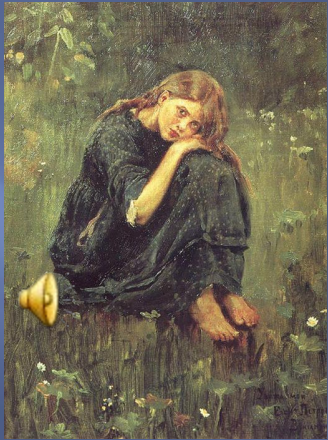

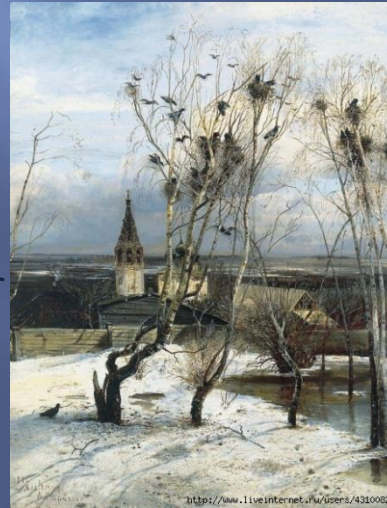

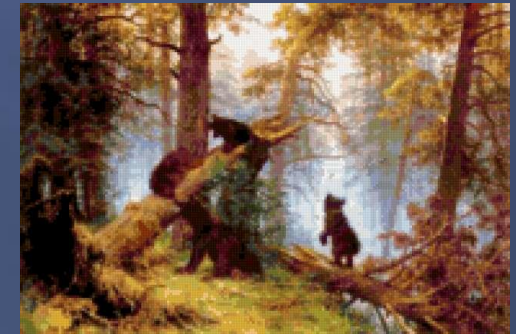
