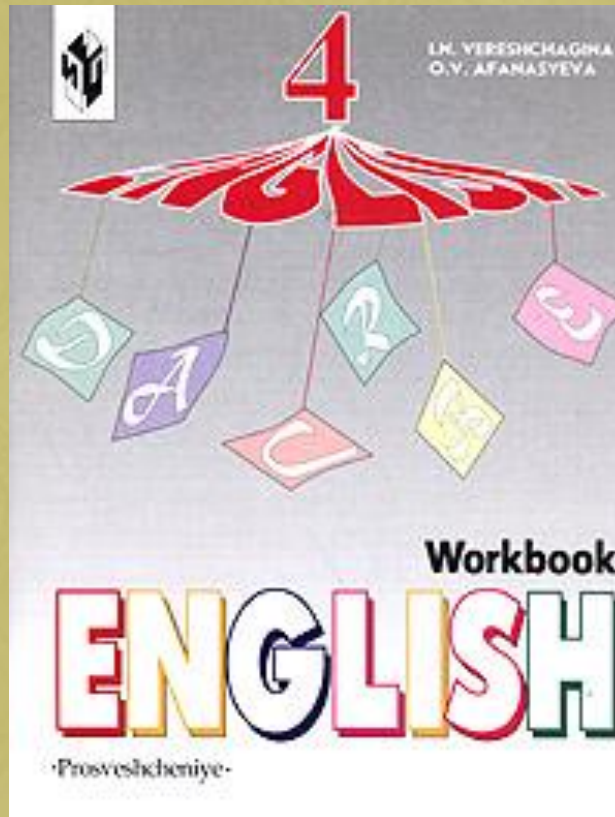

They built a town on the river Thames.

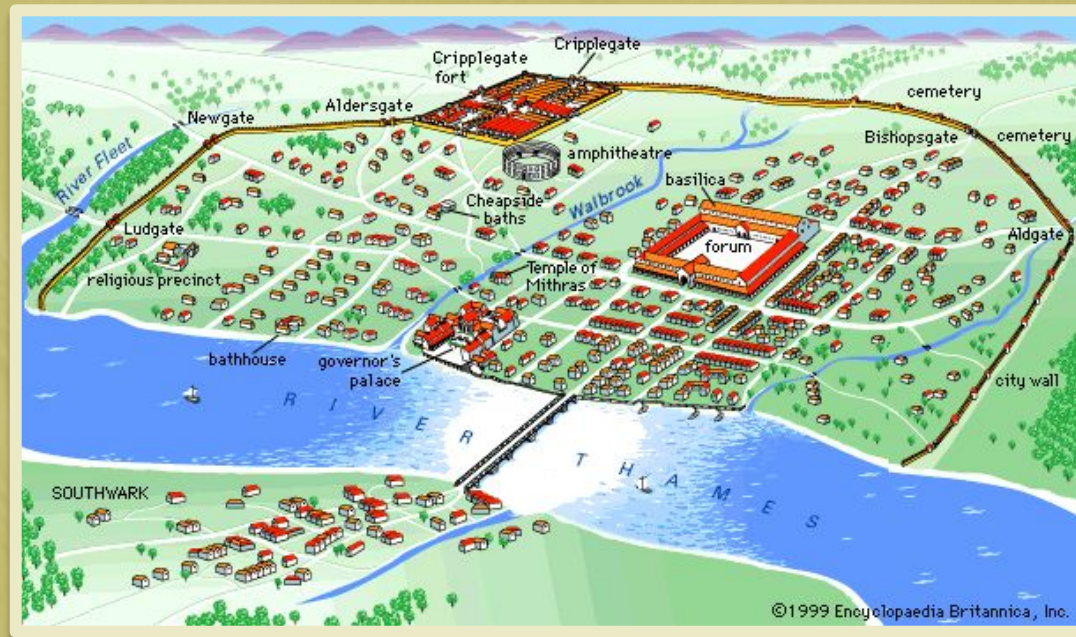


The Romans called it Londinium.

A tall wall was built around the town for defence.



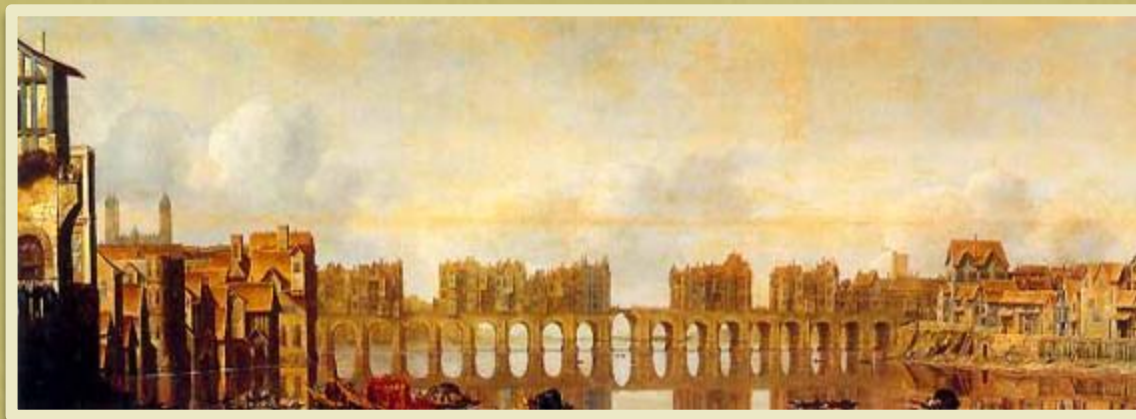
Fragment of the Roman's wall.

There were houses and shops on the Old London Bridge.



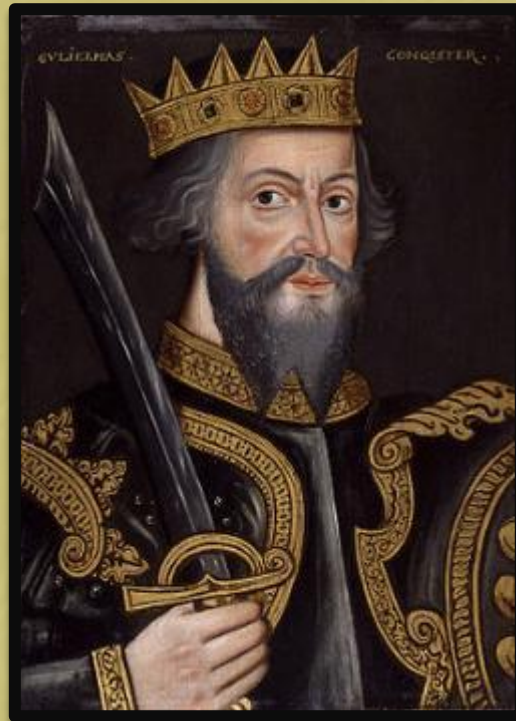
Now there are **27** bridges over the River Thames.

The fire burnt until Thursday and destroyed **80%** of the city.



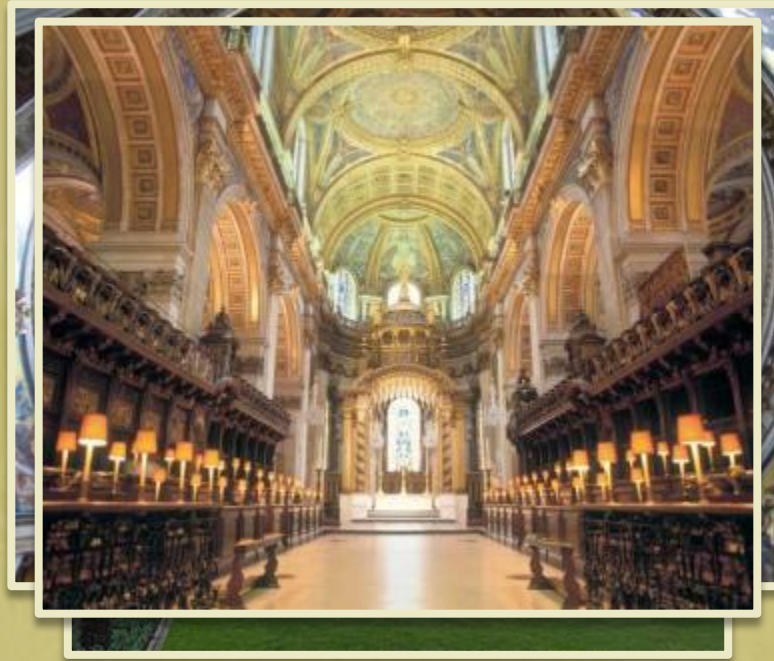
After the Great Fire people built a new city.

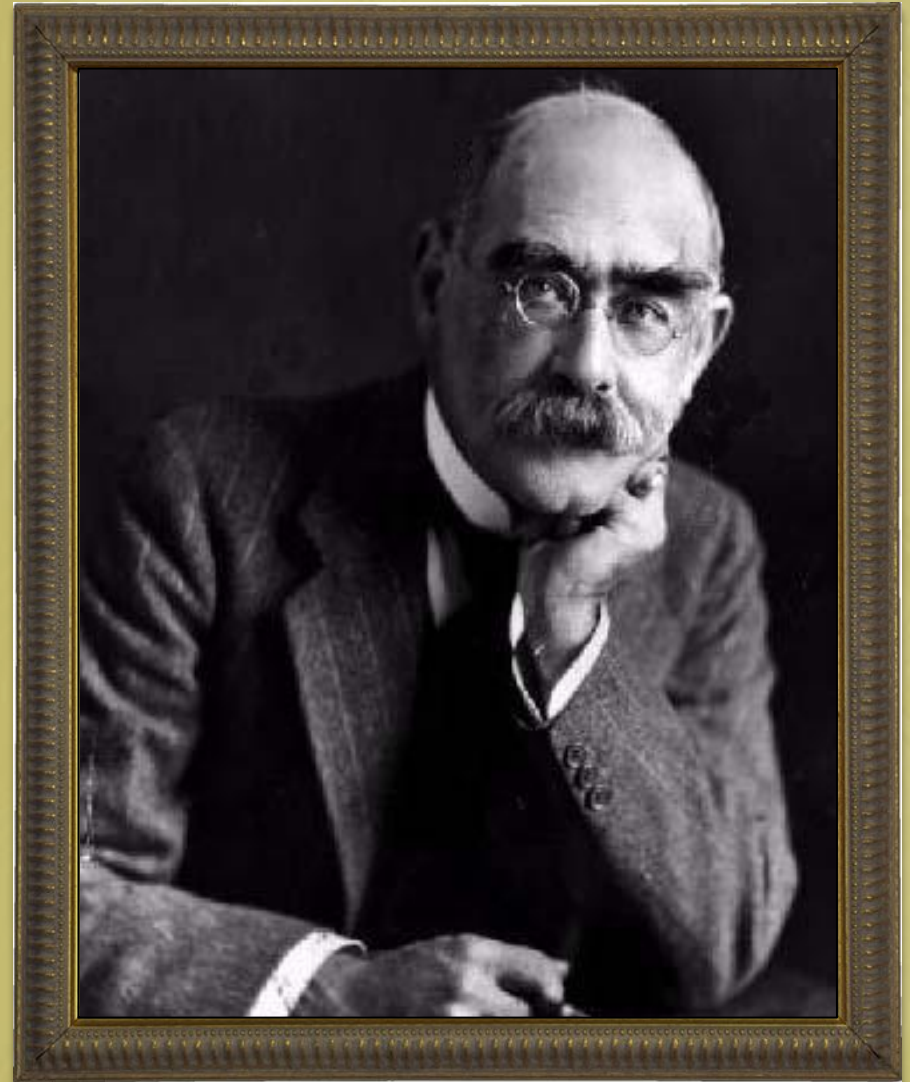

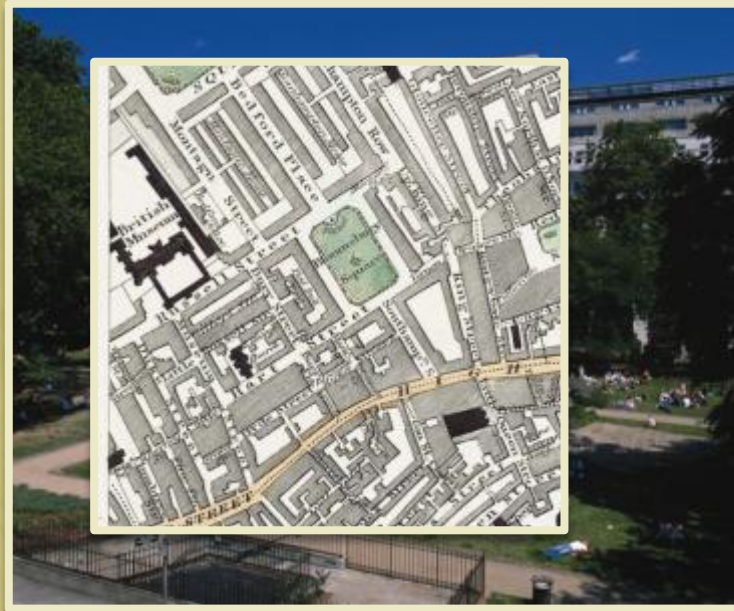
**There are about 10 thousand streets in London.
Oxford Street is London's main shopping centre.**



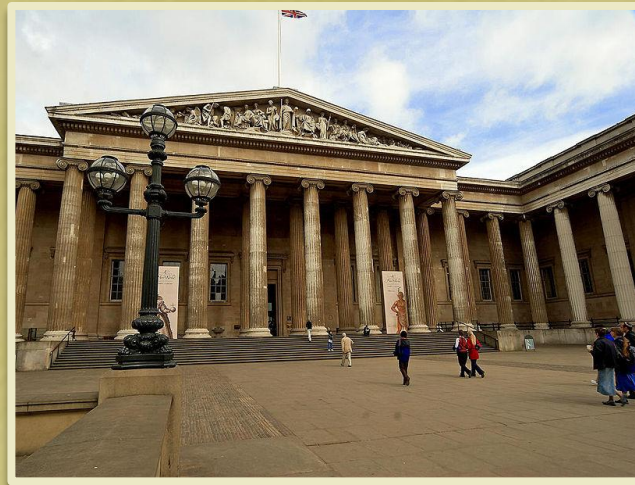
The largest park in London is Hyde Park.
