-traditional Slavic holiday celebrated during the week (sometimes three days) before lent, preserved in its rituals the number of elements of Slavic mythology.

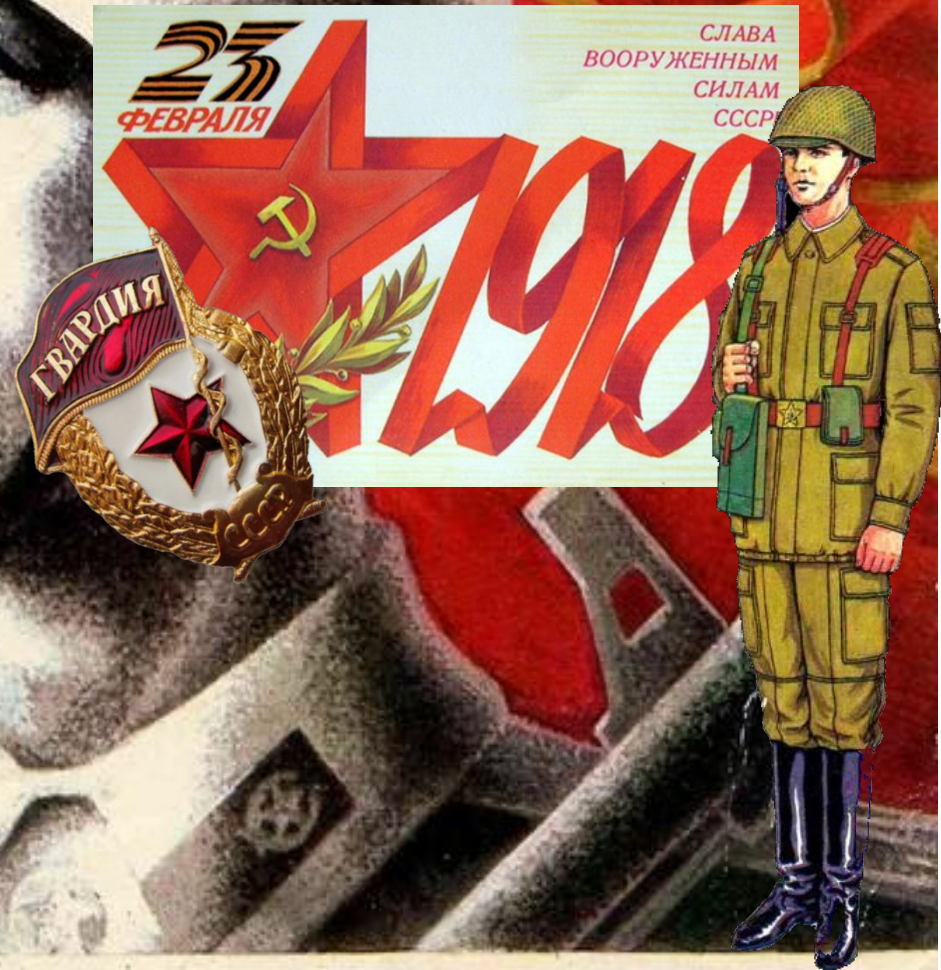




Defender of the Fatherland day

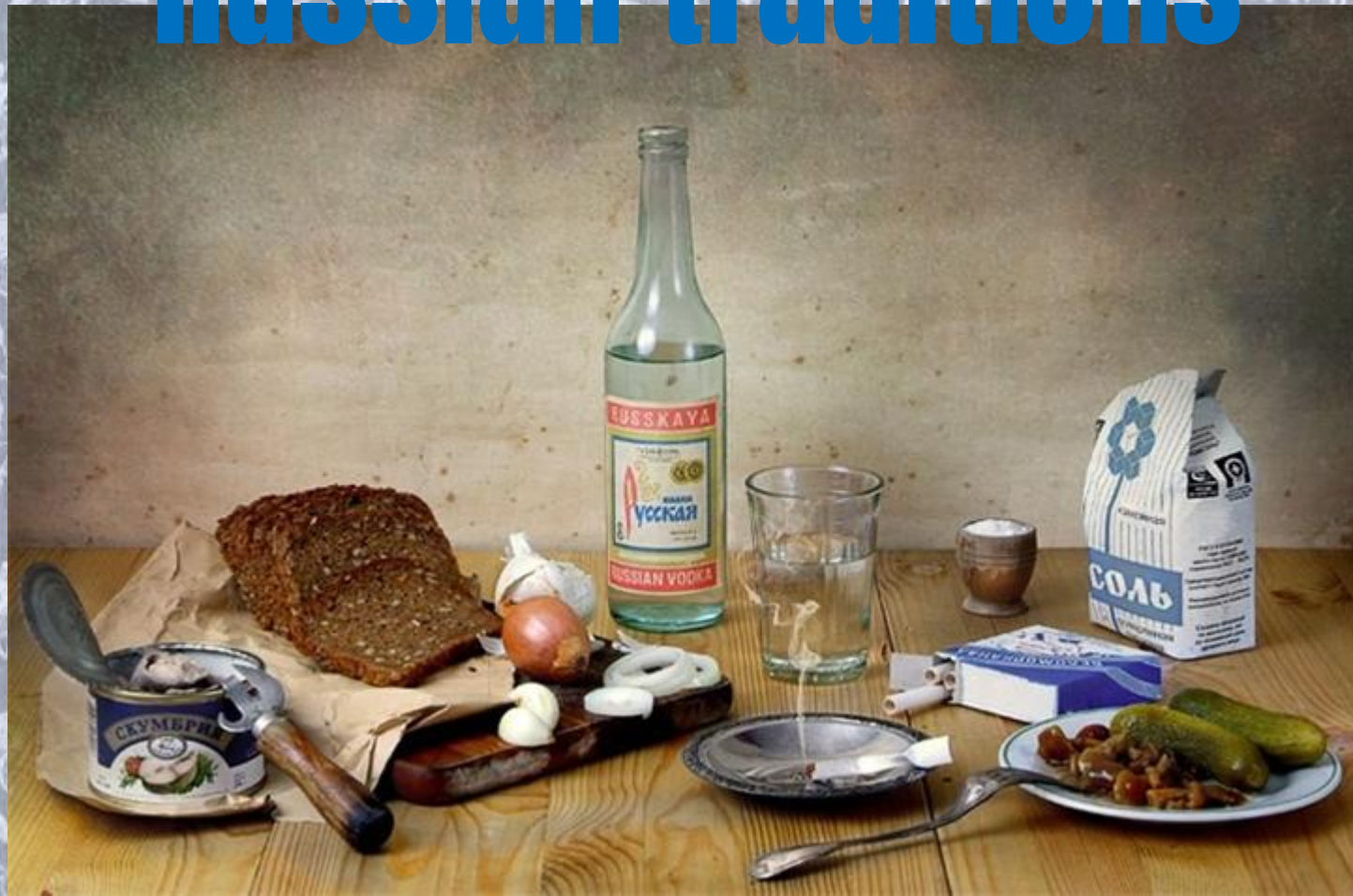
