AFFIRMATIVE

I **am** Bart.

I **am** with my family.

I'**m** American.

AFFIRMATIVE

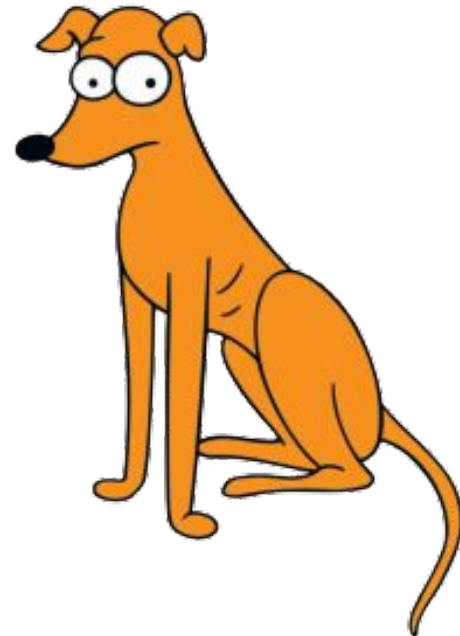
She **is** Marge.

We're at school.



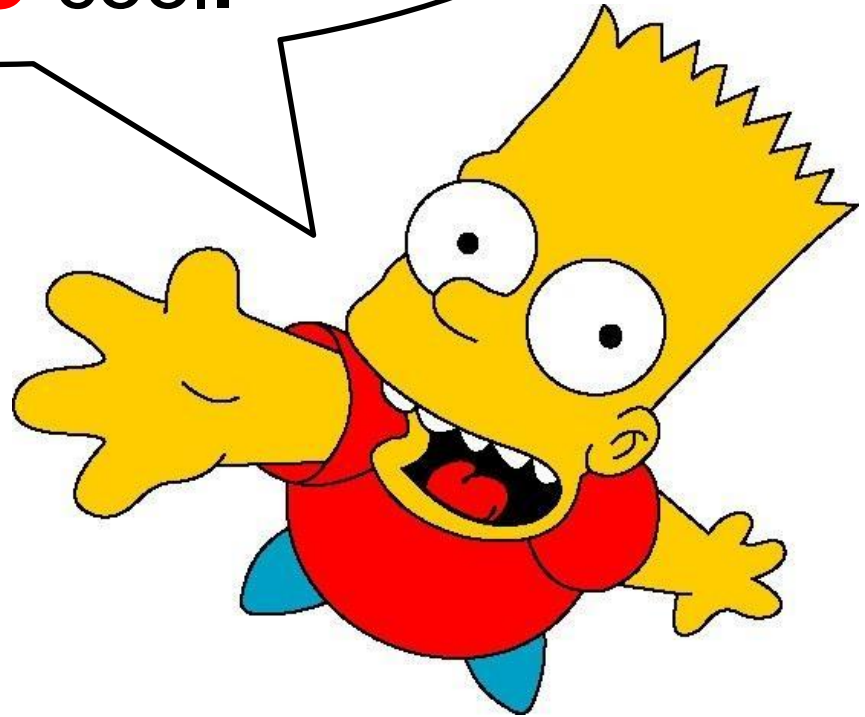

You're cool.

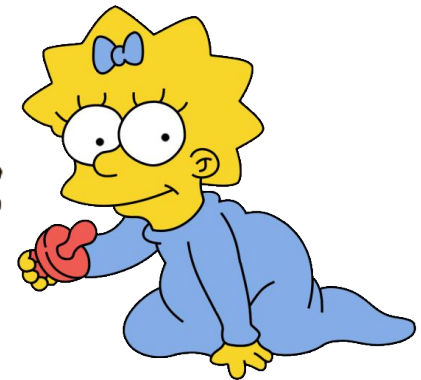

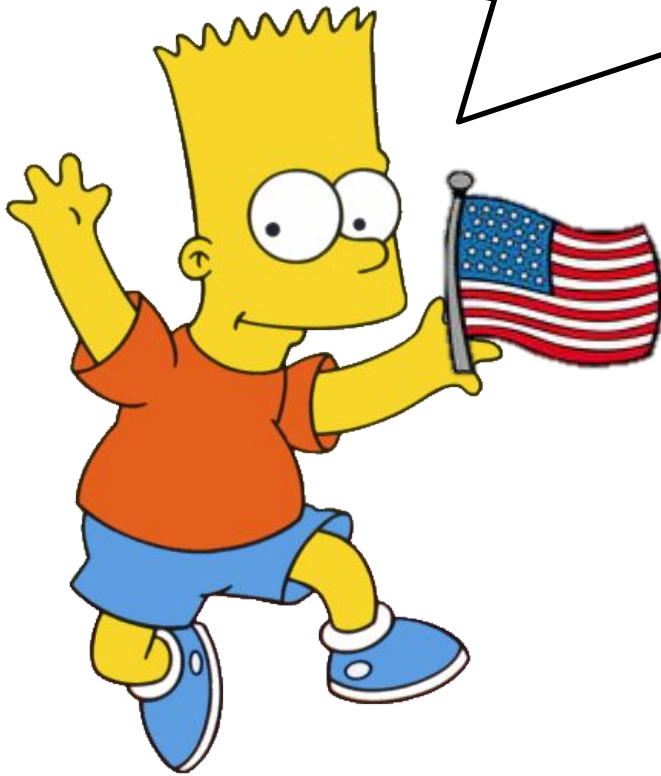

Verb TO BE NEGATIVE

We **are not** from Mexico.

We **aren't** Mexican.

NEGATIVE

I'm not

You aren't

He isn't

She isn't

It isn't

We aren't

You aren't

They aren't

Am I your best friend?

Yes, **you are**.



Verb TO BE INTERROGATIVE

Are you my teacher?



Yes, **I am**.

Is she your mom?

No, she **isn't**.

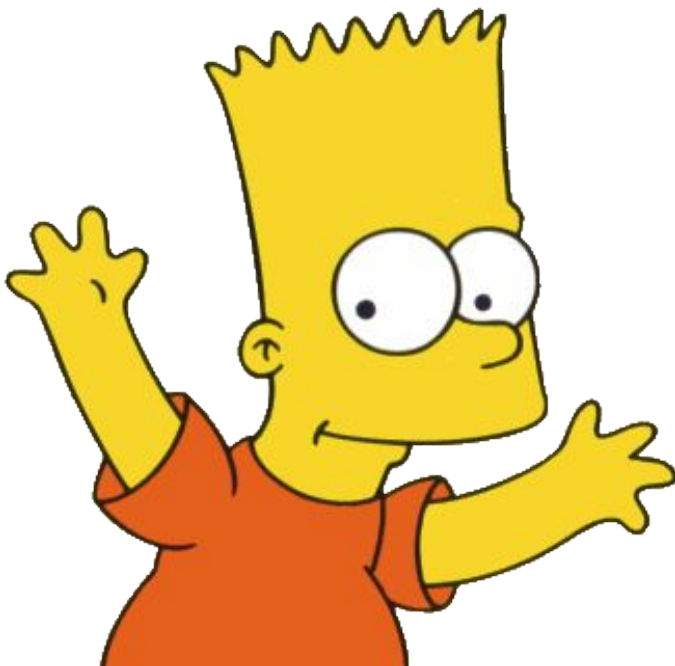

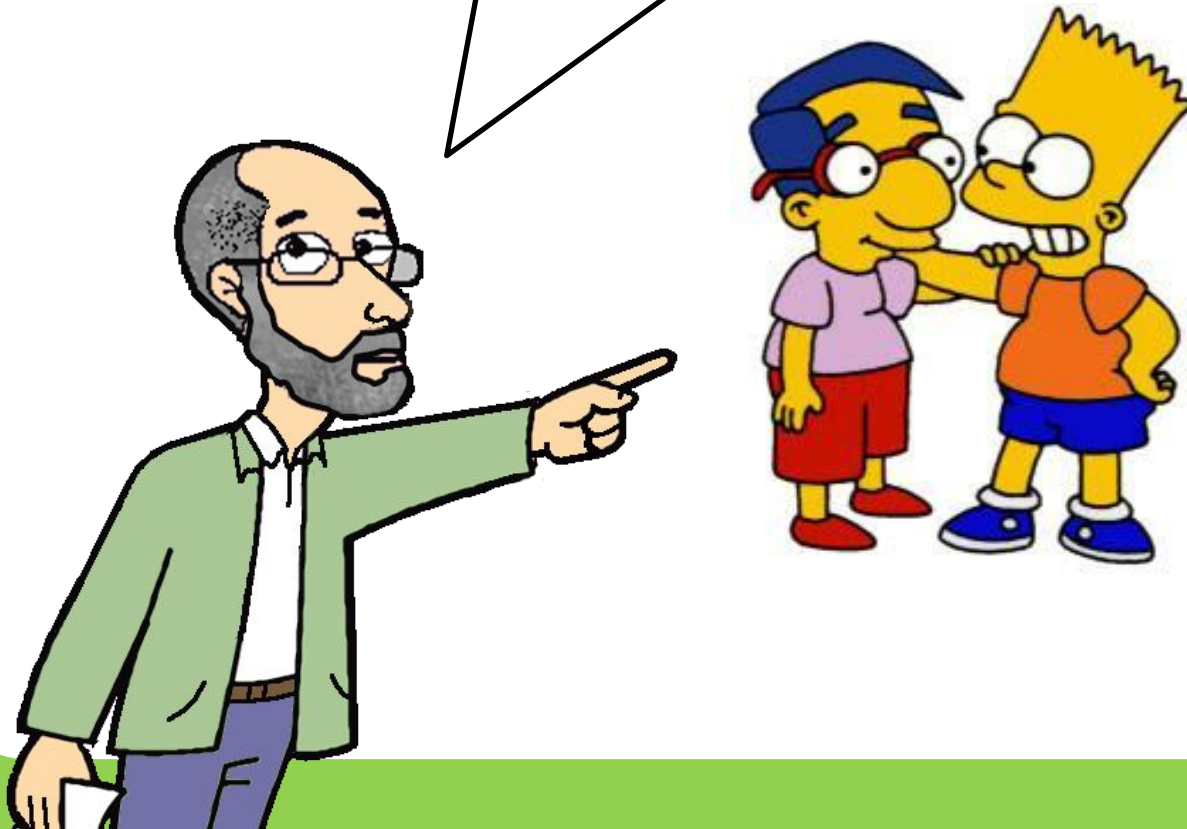
