



Task 1: Look at the picture of a farm and say what you can see. Use the constructions "There is ...", "There are...".





Present	Past
There is a cat on my bed.	There was a cat on my bed.
There isn't any milk.	There wasn't any milk.
Is there an orange in the fridge?	Was there an orange in the fridge?
No, there isn't.	No, there wasn't.
There are several pens in my bag.	There were several pens in my bag.
There aren't any children in the room.	There weren't any children in the room.
How many people are there?	How many people were there?
Yes, there are.	Yes, there were.
