



# **Conditional Sentences**

# express possible or desired action.

- I think I left my watch at your house.
  - Ok, if I find it, I shall tell you.
- If I <u>knew</u> his number, I <u>would call</u> him. (but the real situation is that she doesn't know his number **now**).
- If I were you, I wouldn't do it.

 If I <u>had known</u> you were in hospital, I <u>would have</u> <u>gone</u> to visit you. (The real situation was that he **didn't know** that he was in hospital).

# E.g.: - I think I left my watch at your house. - Ok, if I find it, I shall tell you.

#### Second Conditional.

| Second Conditional | expresses unreal<br>or imagined<br>action related to<br>present or<br>future. | If(Past Simple),<br>I<br>(Future-in-the-past). |  |

# Second Conditional

*E.g.: If I <u>knew</u> his number, I <u>would call</u> <i>him.* 

(but the real situation is that she doesn't know his number **now**).

*E.g.: If I <u>were</u> you, I <u>wouldn't do</u> it.* (were is used for all person).


#### **Third Conditional.**

| Type of the<br>conditional<br>sentence | What kind of possibility expresses?                     | Formula   |
|--|---|---|
| Third Conditional                      | expresses unreal<br>possibility related<br>to the past. | If(Past Perfect),<br>I (Future<br>Perfect-in-the-past). |

# **Third conditional**

E.g.: If I <u>had known</u> you were in hospital,
I <u>would have gone</u> to visit you.
(The real situation was that he didn't know that he was in hospital).


