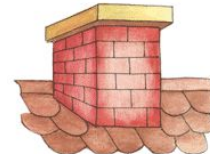
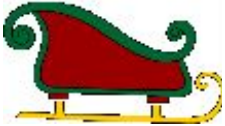
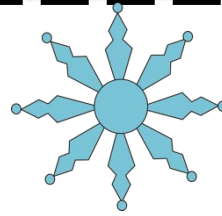
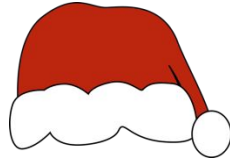
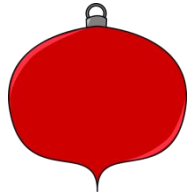
The aim of the lesson:
