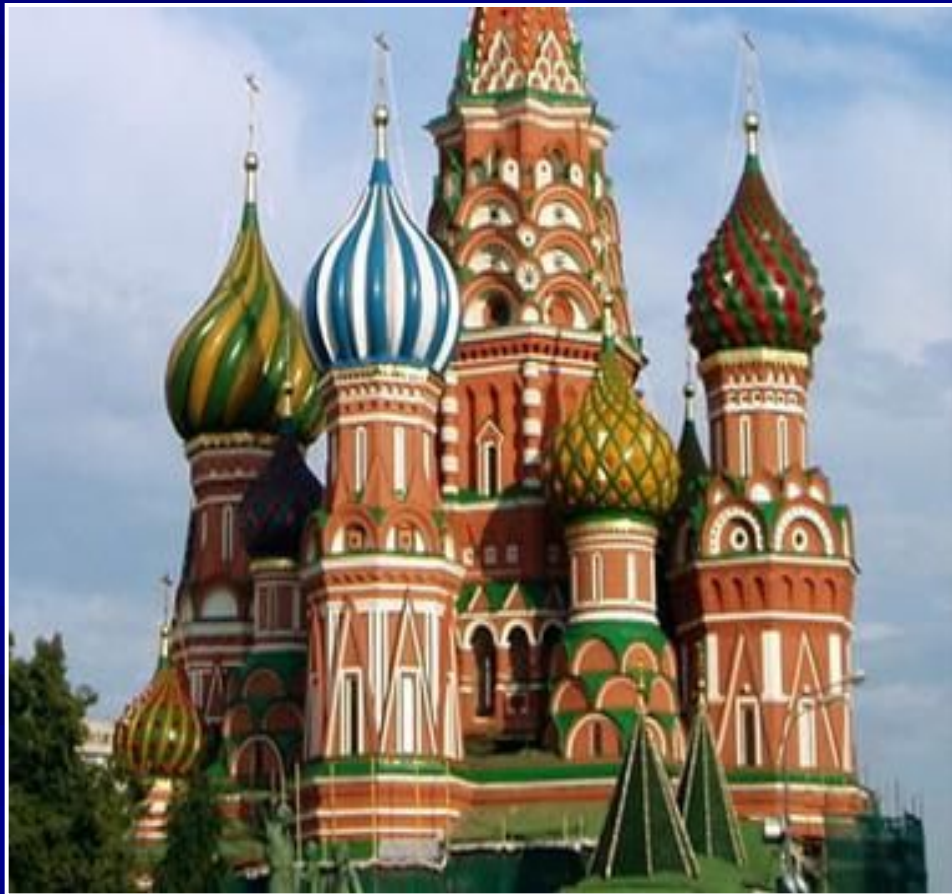

# St Basil's Cathedral



It has graced Red Square for more than four centuries. It was built to celebrate the final liberation of the Russian state from the Tartar dependency.

There is a monument to Citizen Minin and Prince Pozharsky next to the Cathedral. It was the first monument built in Moscow.

The Mamayev Kurgan Museum Complex is dedicated to the Heroes of Stalingrad battle. It was opened October, 15, 1967.

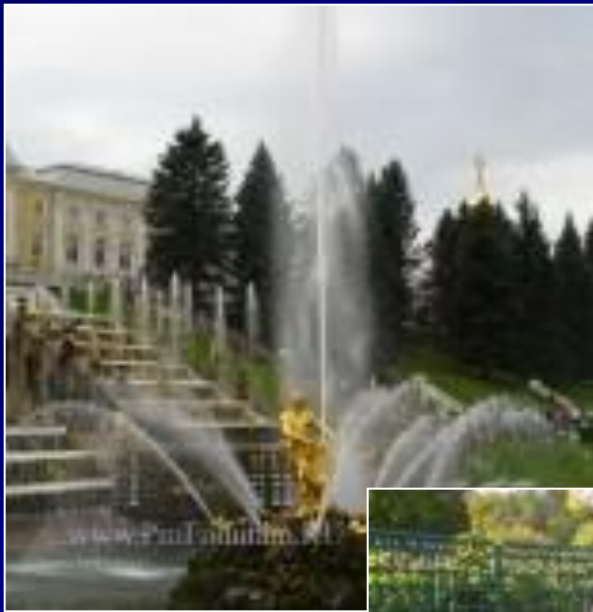


# Peterhof

# Geyser Valley



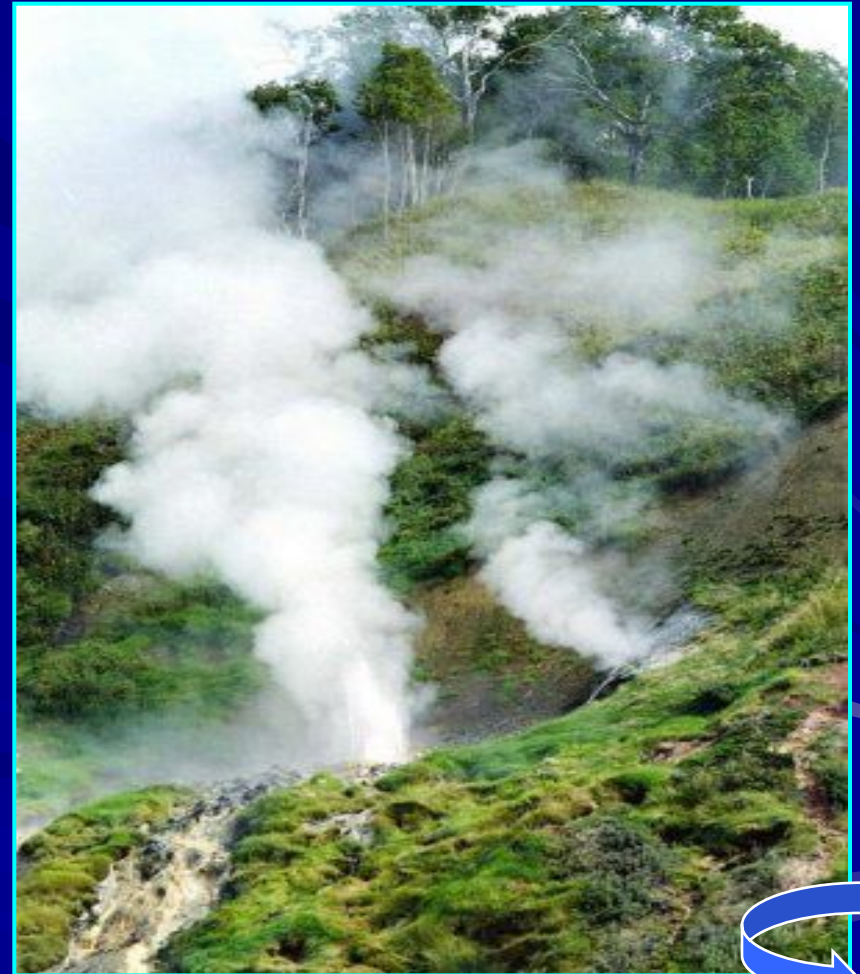
Kamchatka is a peninsula, a spectacular region of ice, fire, wild life and the Geyser Valley.
