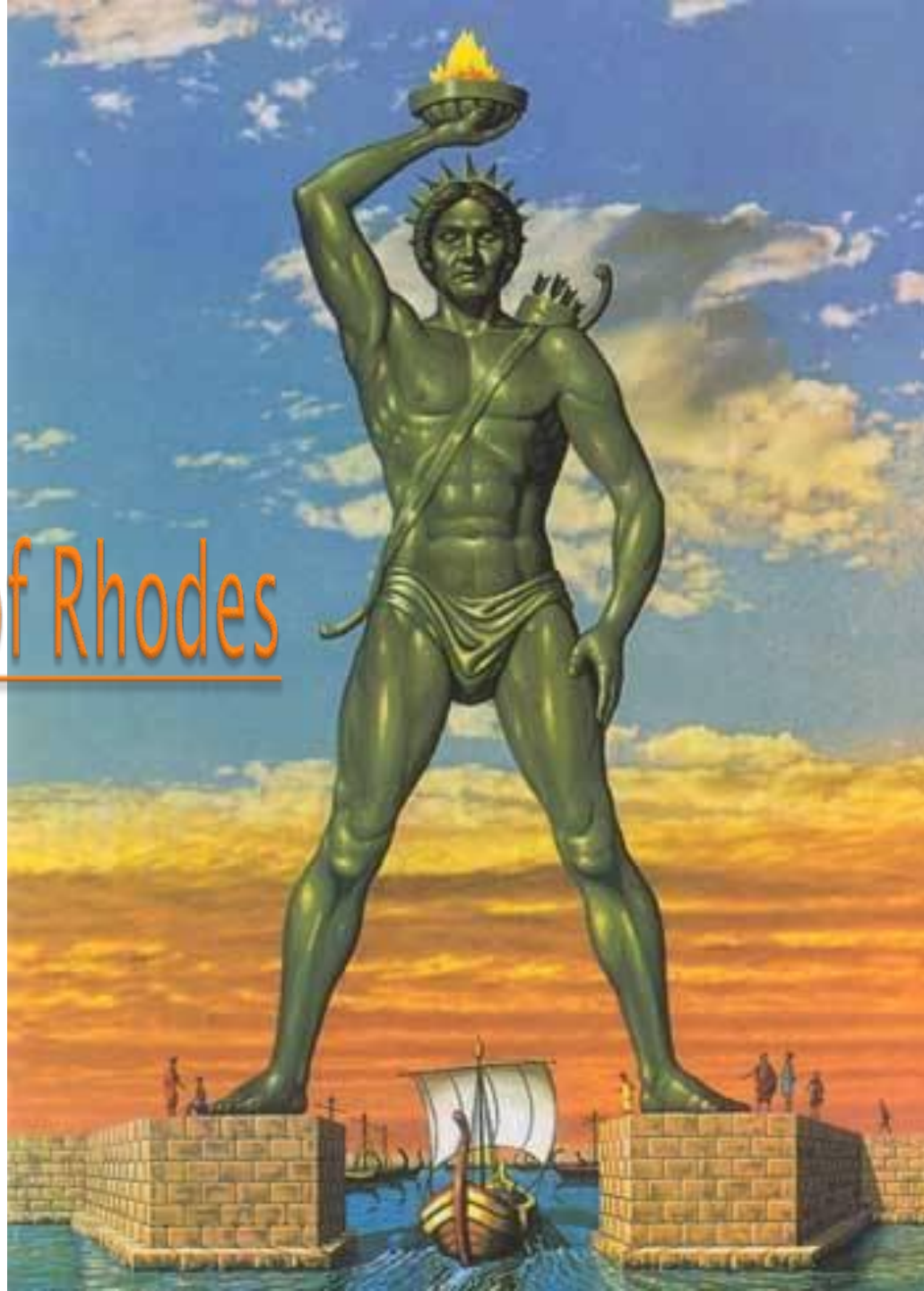

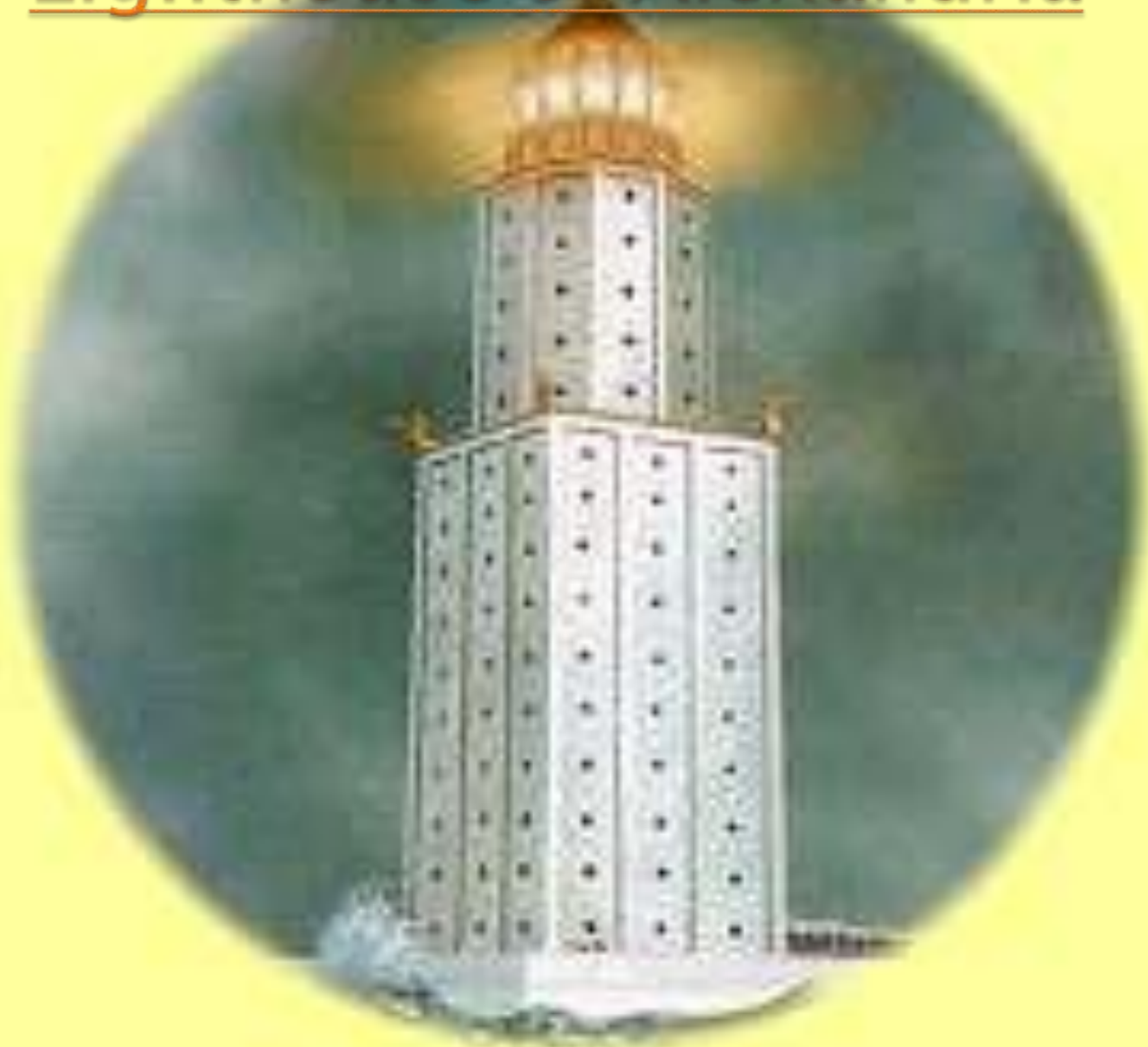

The Lighthouse of Alexandria

An aerial photograph of the Lighthouse of Alexandria, a massive ancient structure built on the island of Pharos. The lighthouse is a tall, cylindrical tower with a spiral staircase on the exterior, topped with a lantern room. It is surrounded by a complex of buildings and a harbor. The sea is visible in the foreground, and the sky is clear and blue.

On the island of Pharos, 1(guard) 2(enter) to the harbour of Alexandria, Ptolemy II of Egypt ordered the 3(construct) of one the 4(one) lighthouses in history.

Sostratus of Cnidus designed and 5(build) the 400-foot high tower, which 6(complete) about 270 B.C. Of white marble, in set back stories of 7(vary) shapes, the lighthouse kept a fire 8(burn) nightly. That fire could 9(see) many miles out on the Mediterranean.

This lighthouse, one of the 10(great) buildings of the ancient world, stood for almost 1,600 years. It 11(destroy) by an earthquake in 1303.

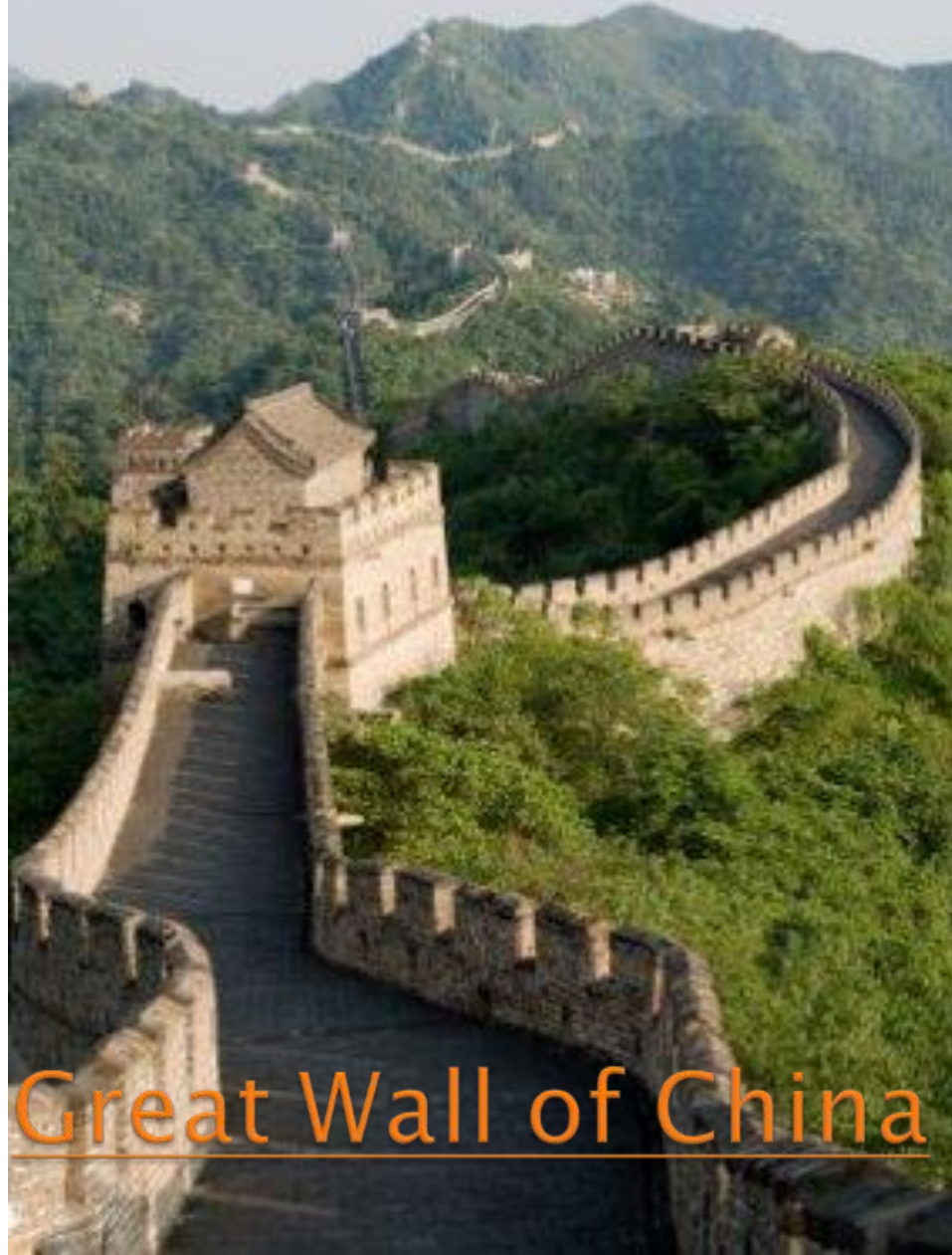
