# The requirements and criteria of evaluation of a personal letter:

Limited amount of the text – 100-140 words. Acceptable variation - 10%.

You have 20 minutes to do the task.

- The content of the text (max - 2)
- The structure of the text (max - 2)
- Rich and correct vocabulary and grammar (max - 2)

# **The content must include:**

- Reference to the previous letter, gratitude
  - Answering the questions
  - Questions to the addressee
  - Proper amount of the text
  - Right form of address
  - Appropriate phrases for the end of the letter and signature


# **The text of the letter must:**

- be logical**
- have 4 main parts**
- have necessary  
conjunctions**
- start with an address and a  
date**



# As for vocabulary and grammar...

There must be:

- right usage of grammatical structures
  - rich vocabulary
  - no mistakes

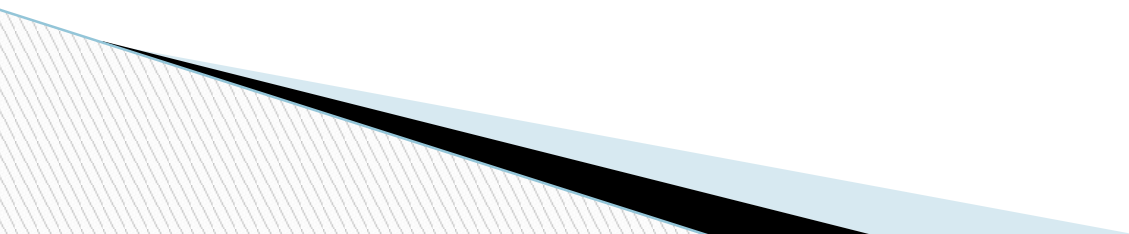
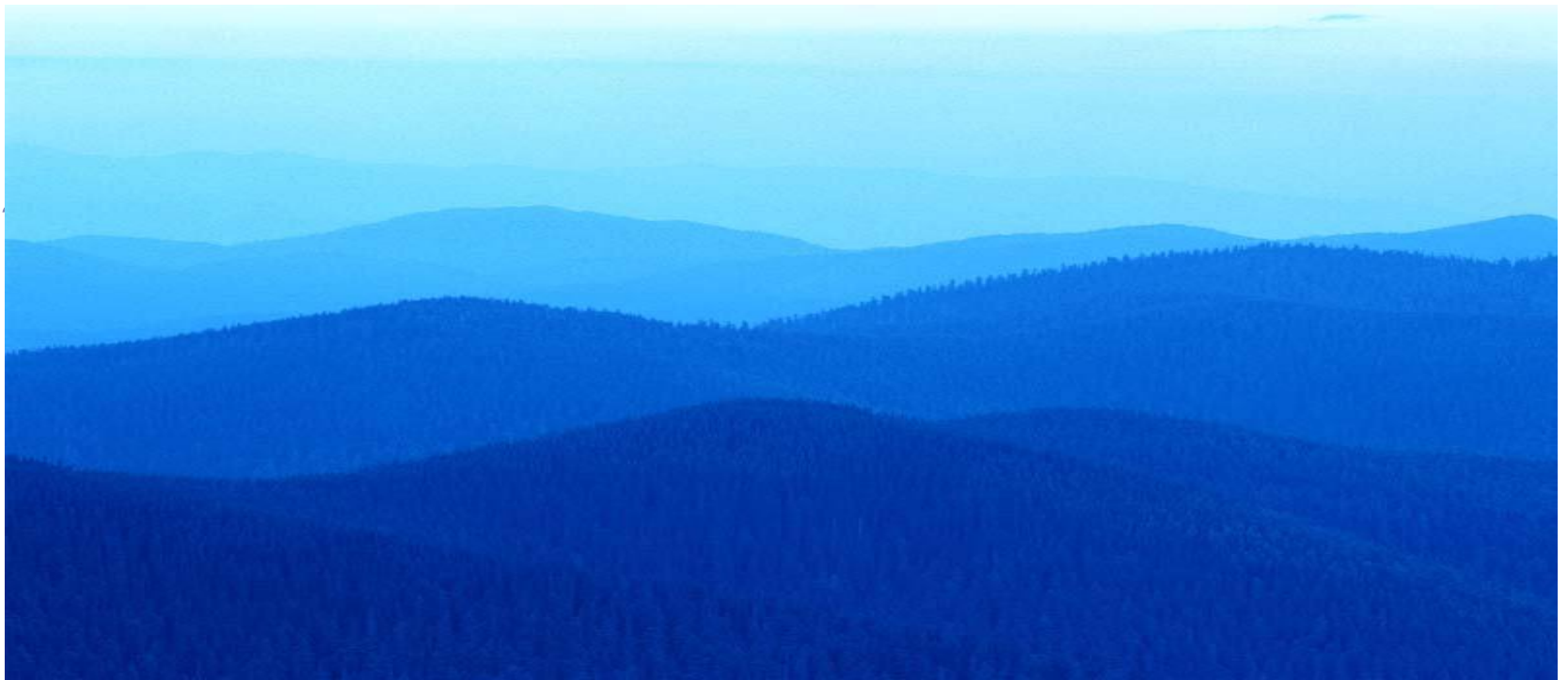

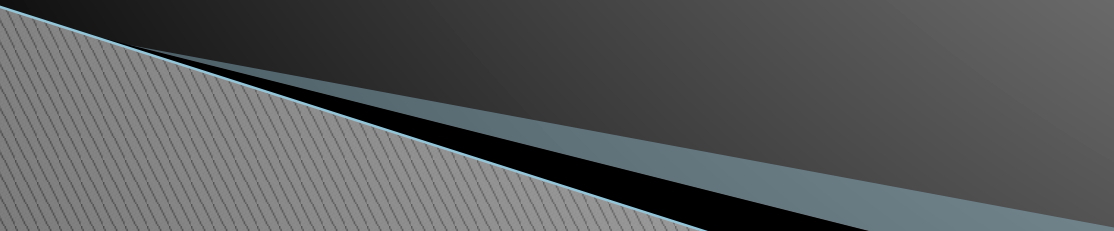
