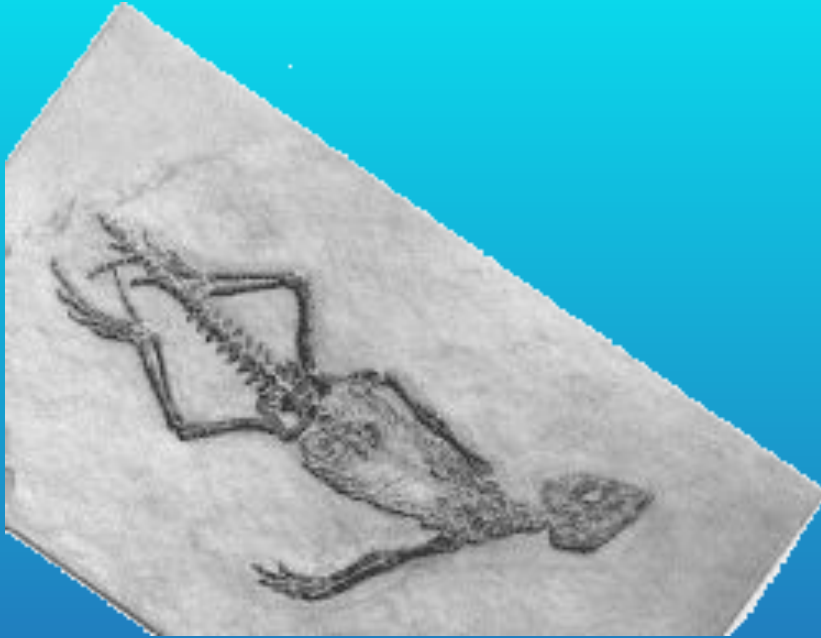

I had the most queer looking specimen brought to notice yesterday. The Capt of the trawler told me about it so I immediately set off to see the specimen which I had removed to our Museum as soon as I could. I however have drawn a very rough sketch and so do hope that you may be able to assist me in classifying it. It was trawled off Oullins coast at about 40 fathoms. It is coated in heavy scales, almost armor like, the fins resemble those, and are set right up to a fringe of filaments. The dorsal dorsal, has tiny white spines from each filament. 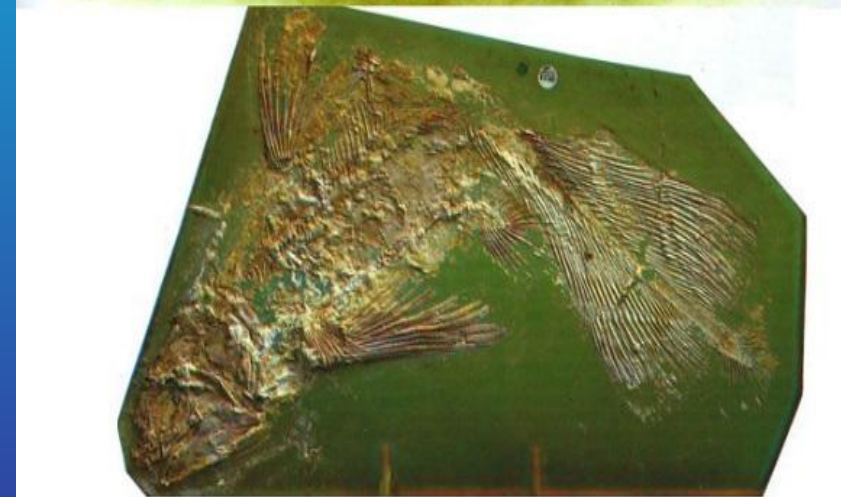
I would be so pleased if you could let me know what you think, though I know just how difficult it is from a description of this kind.

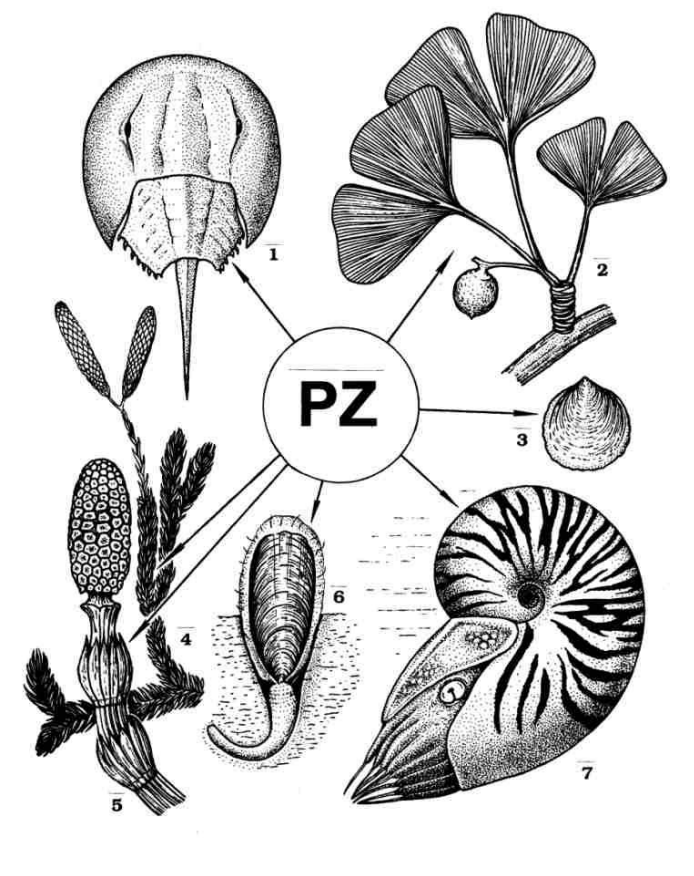
