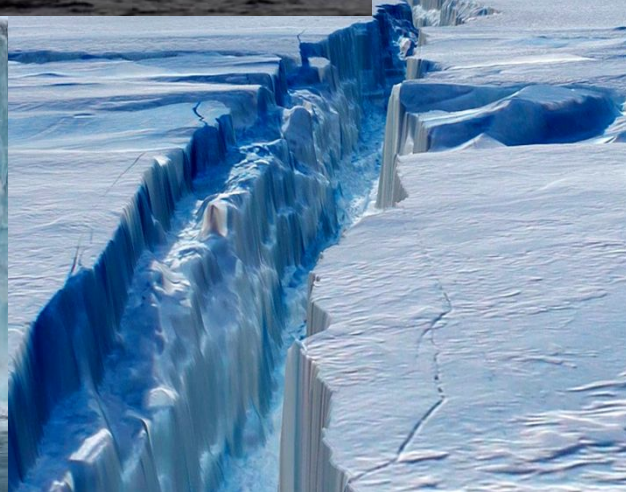

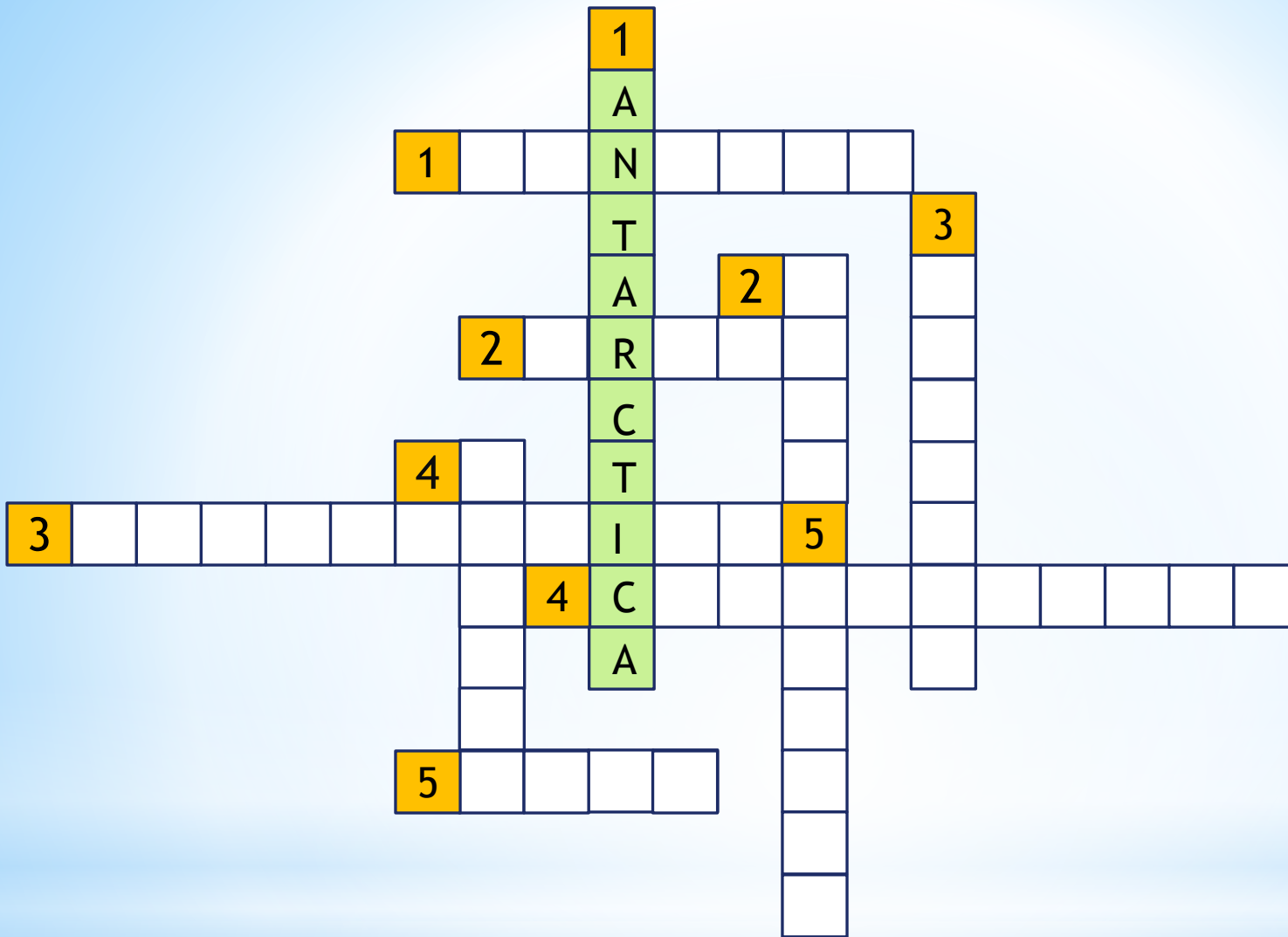

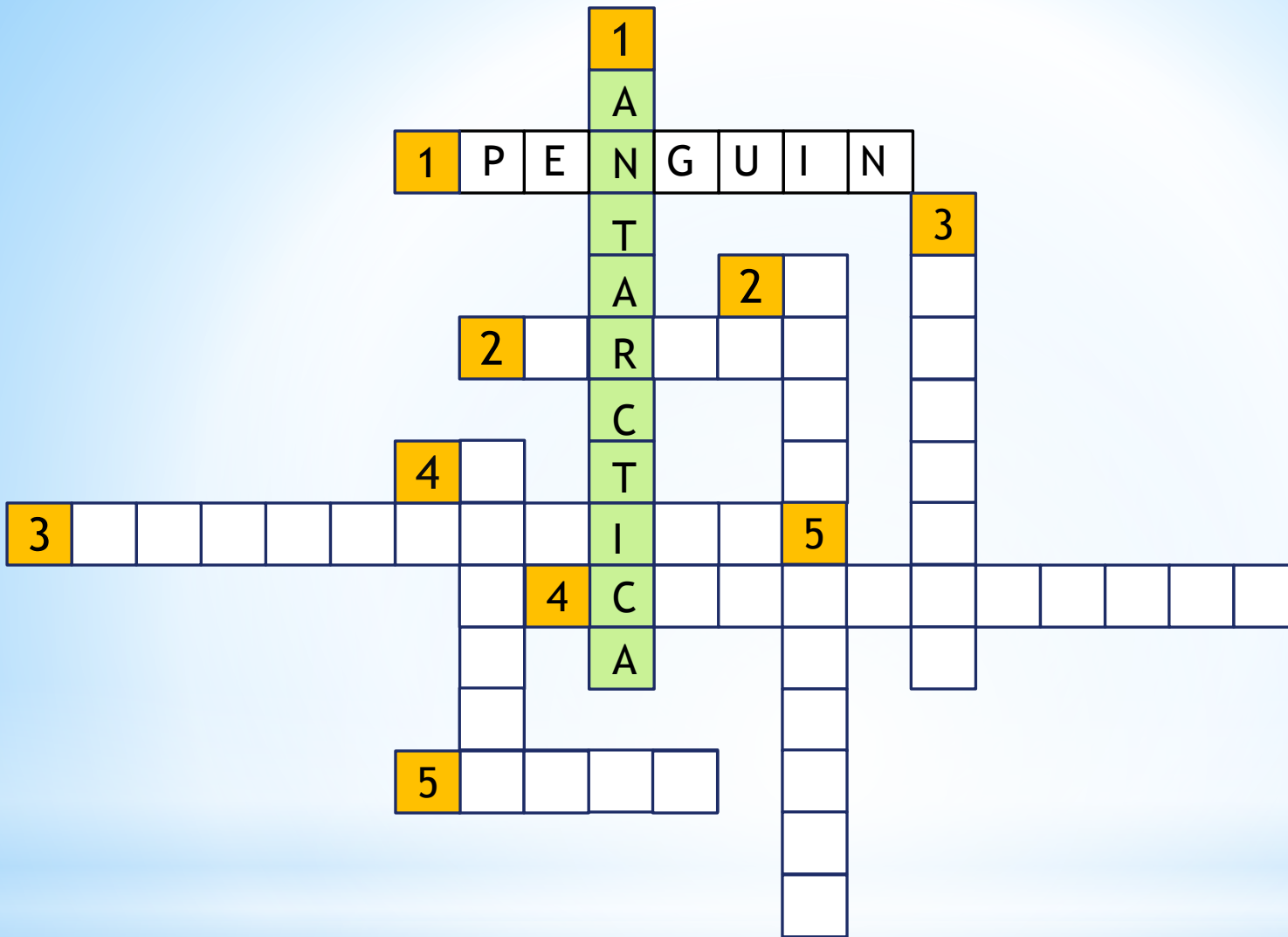

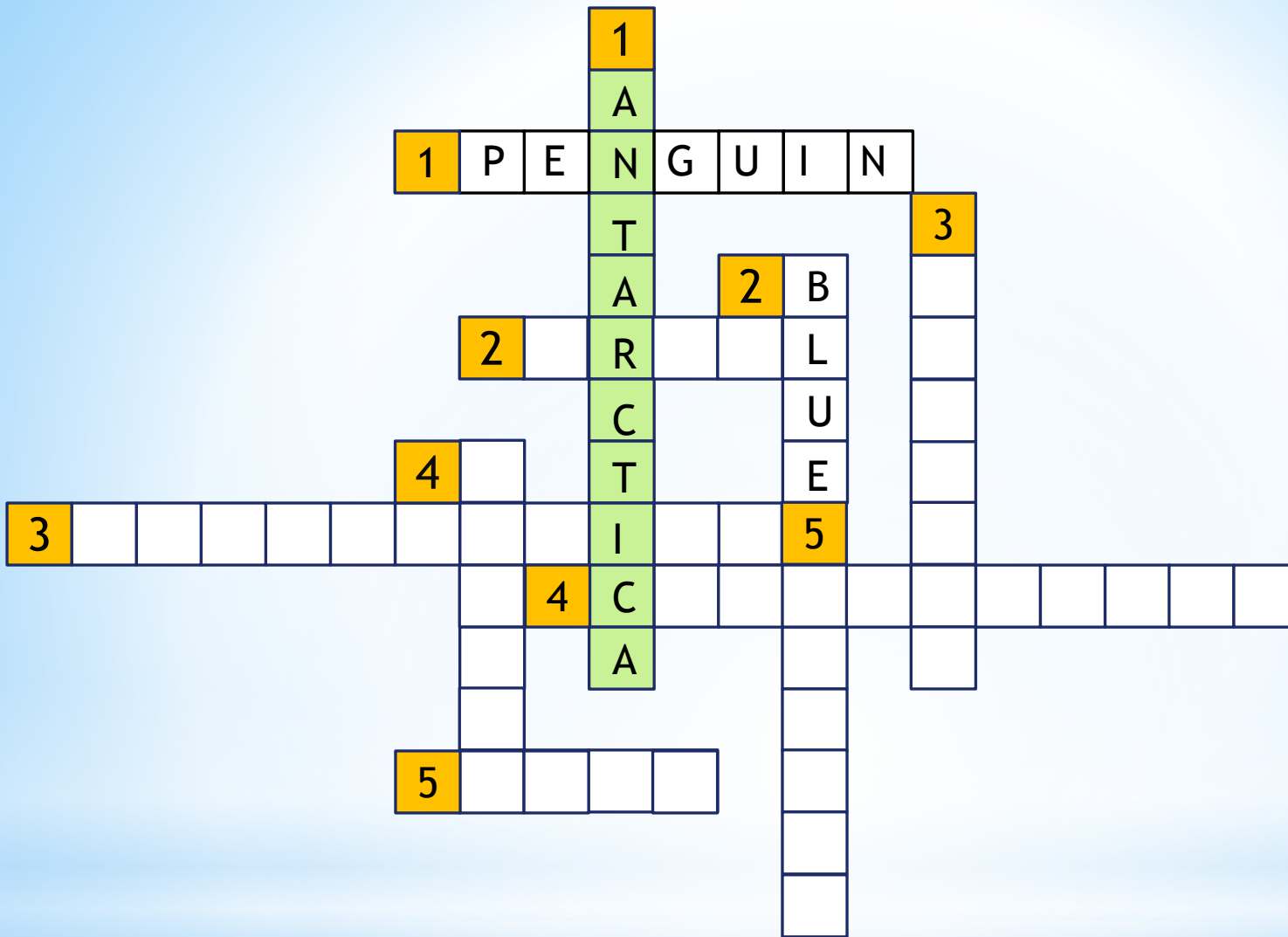

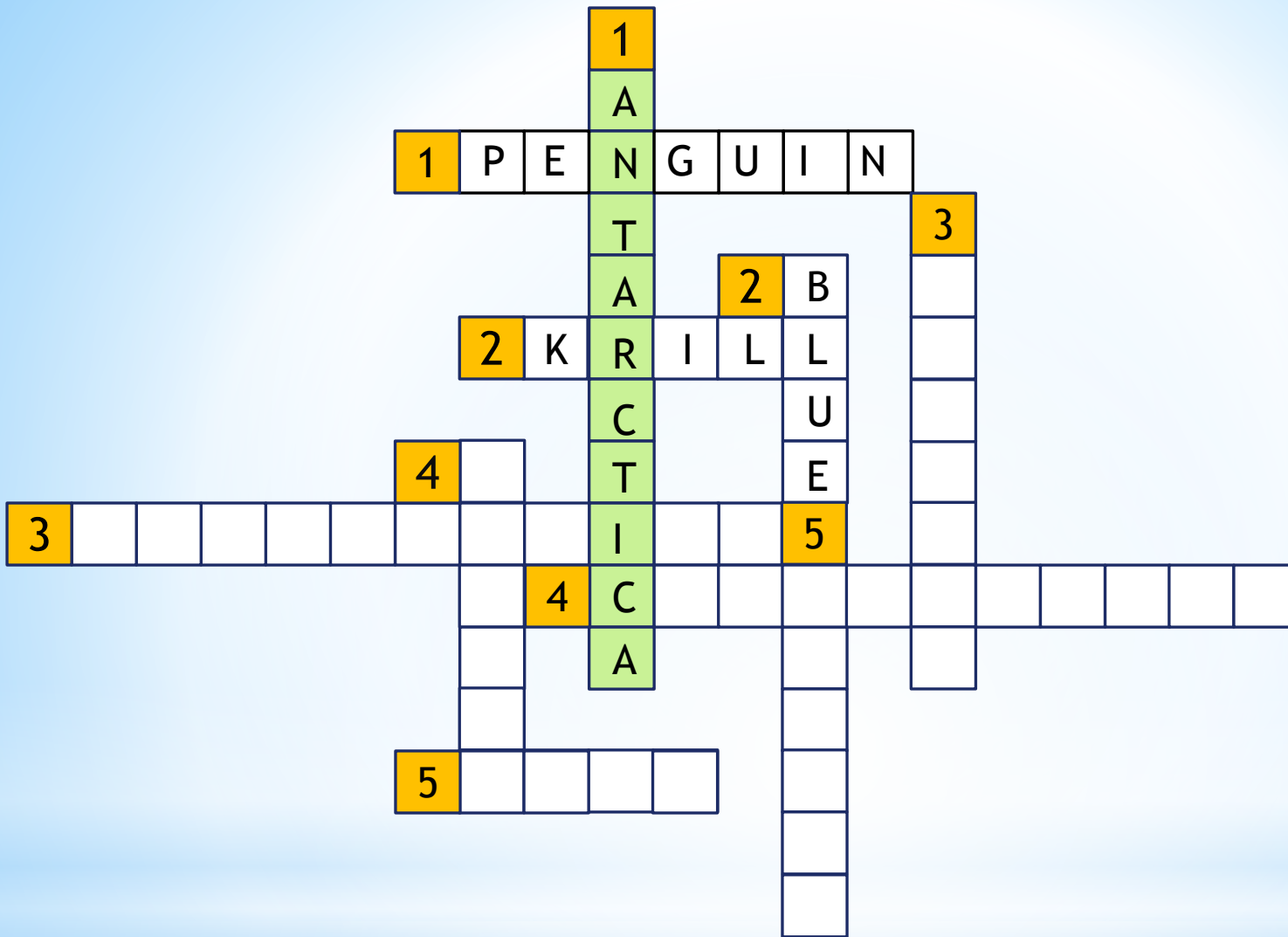

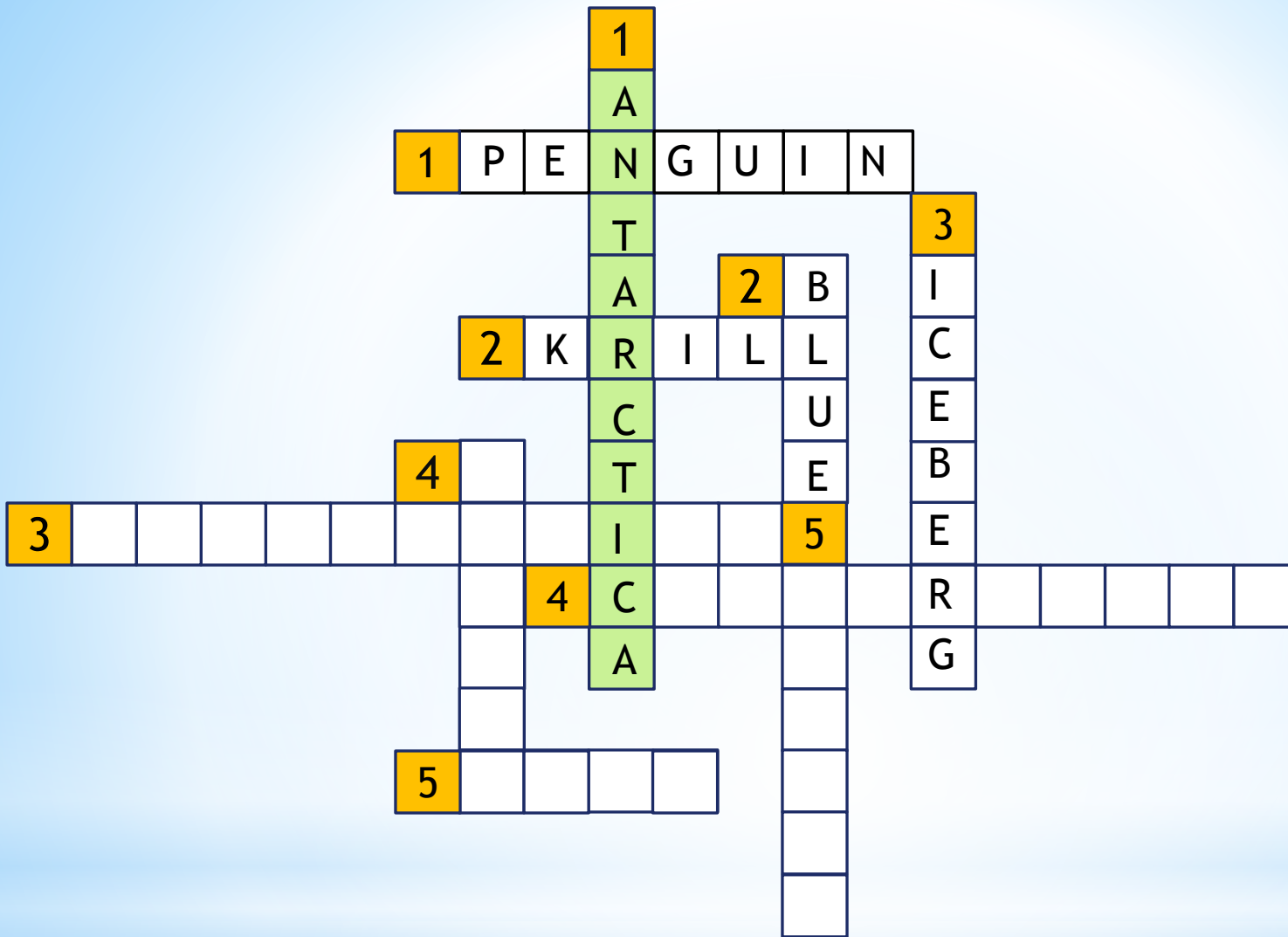

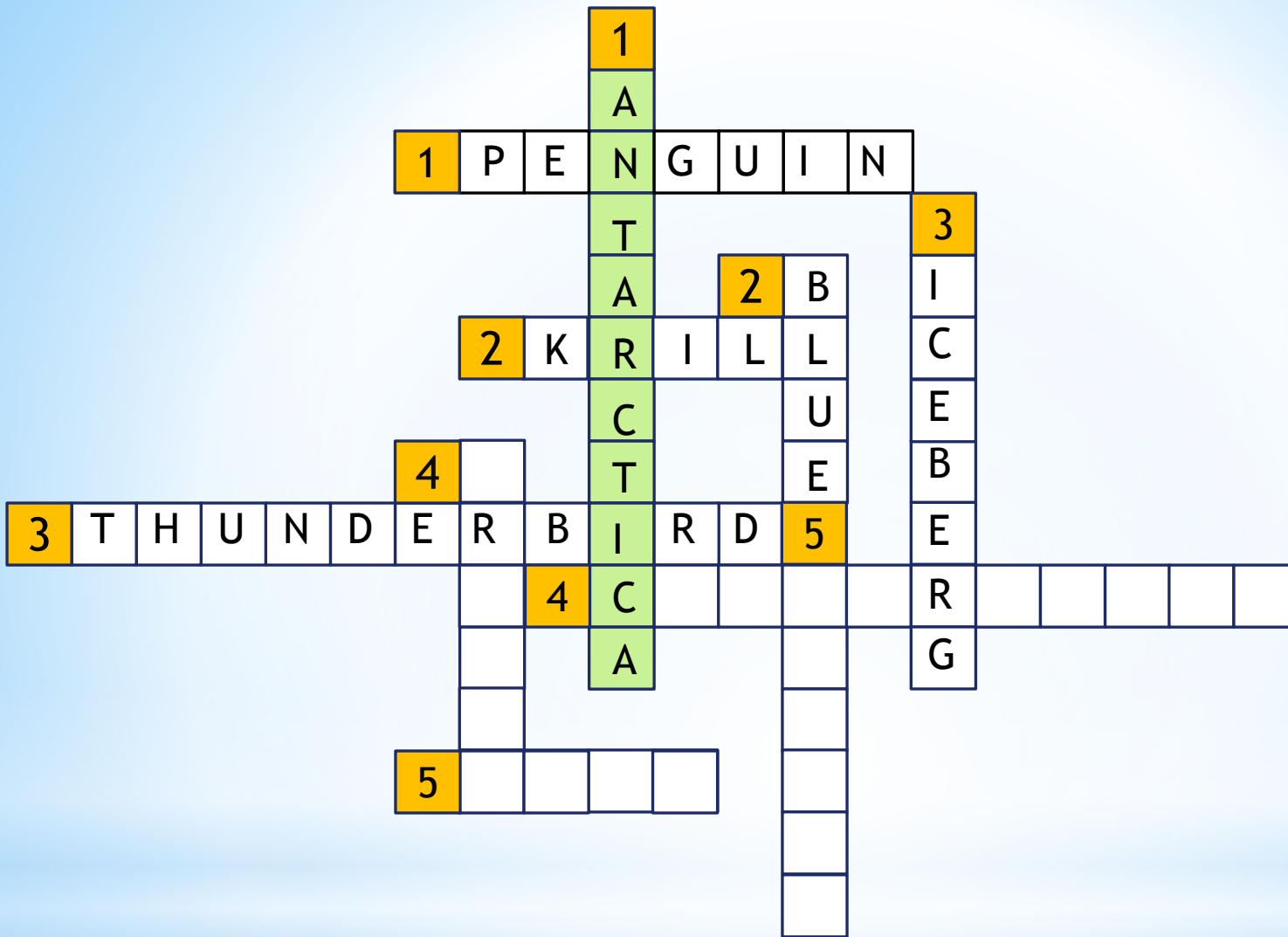

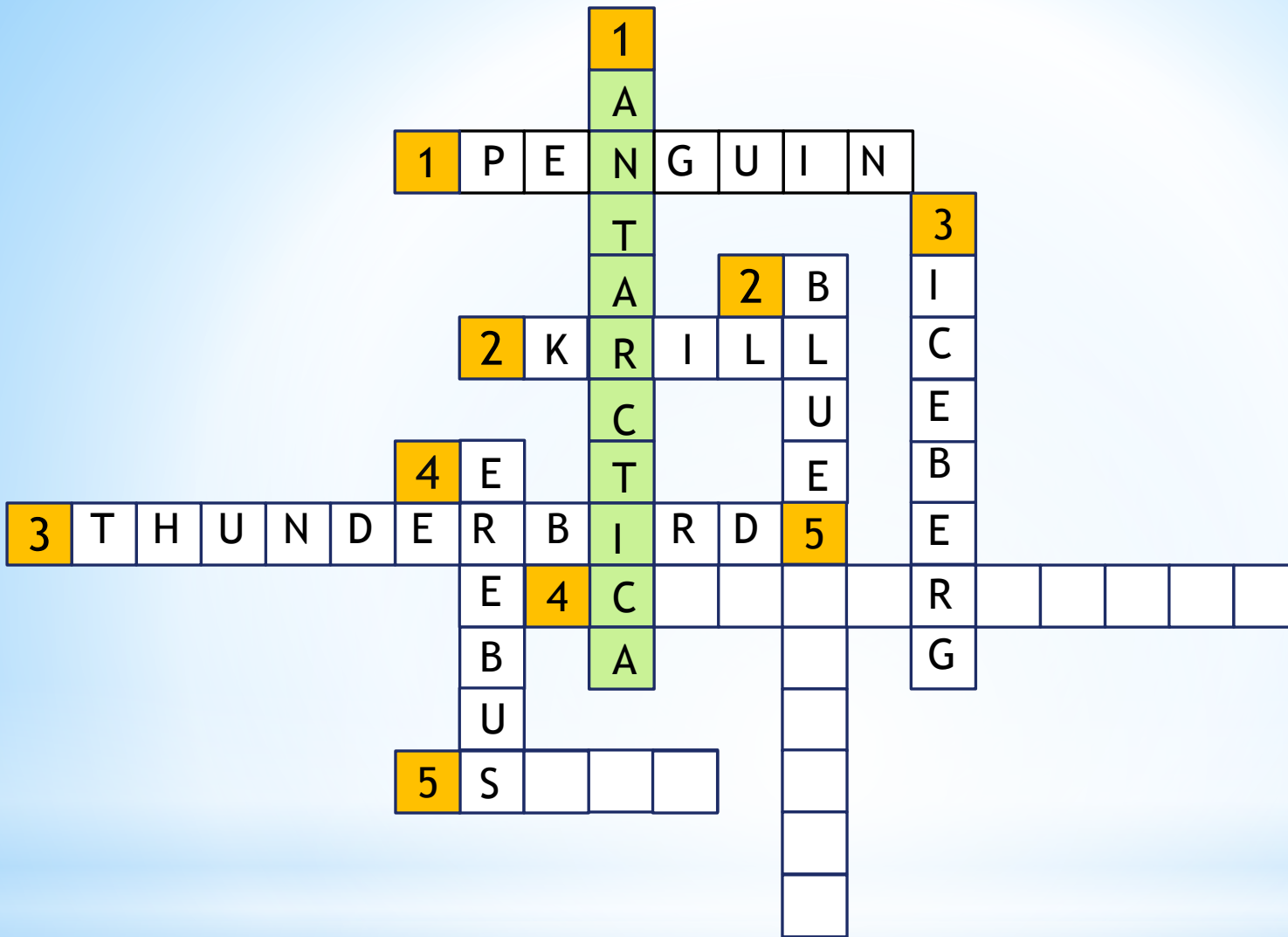

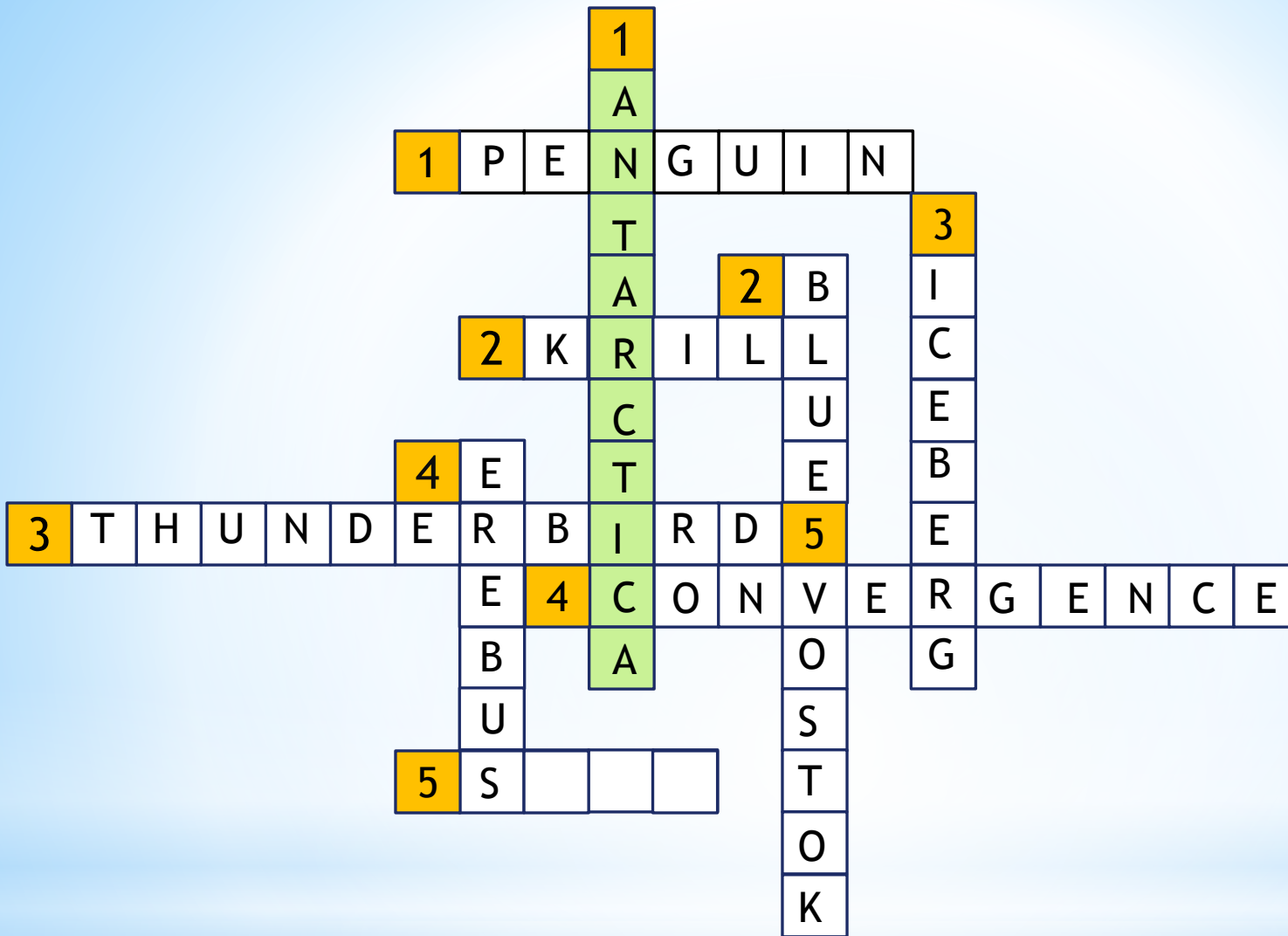

4. A zone of the Southern Ocean surrounding Antarctic waters

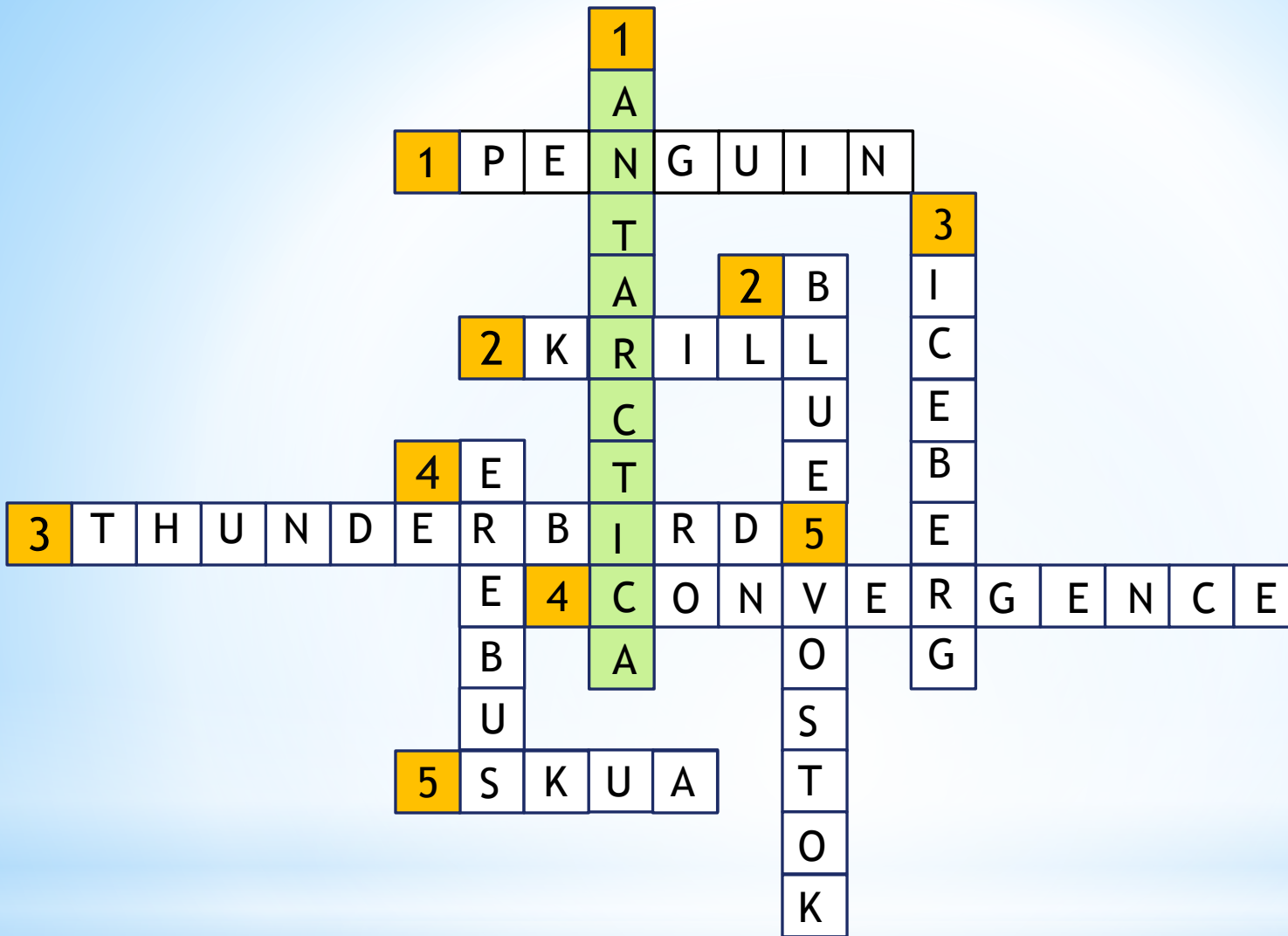
