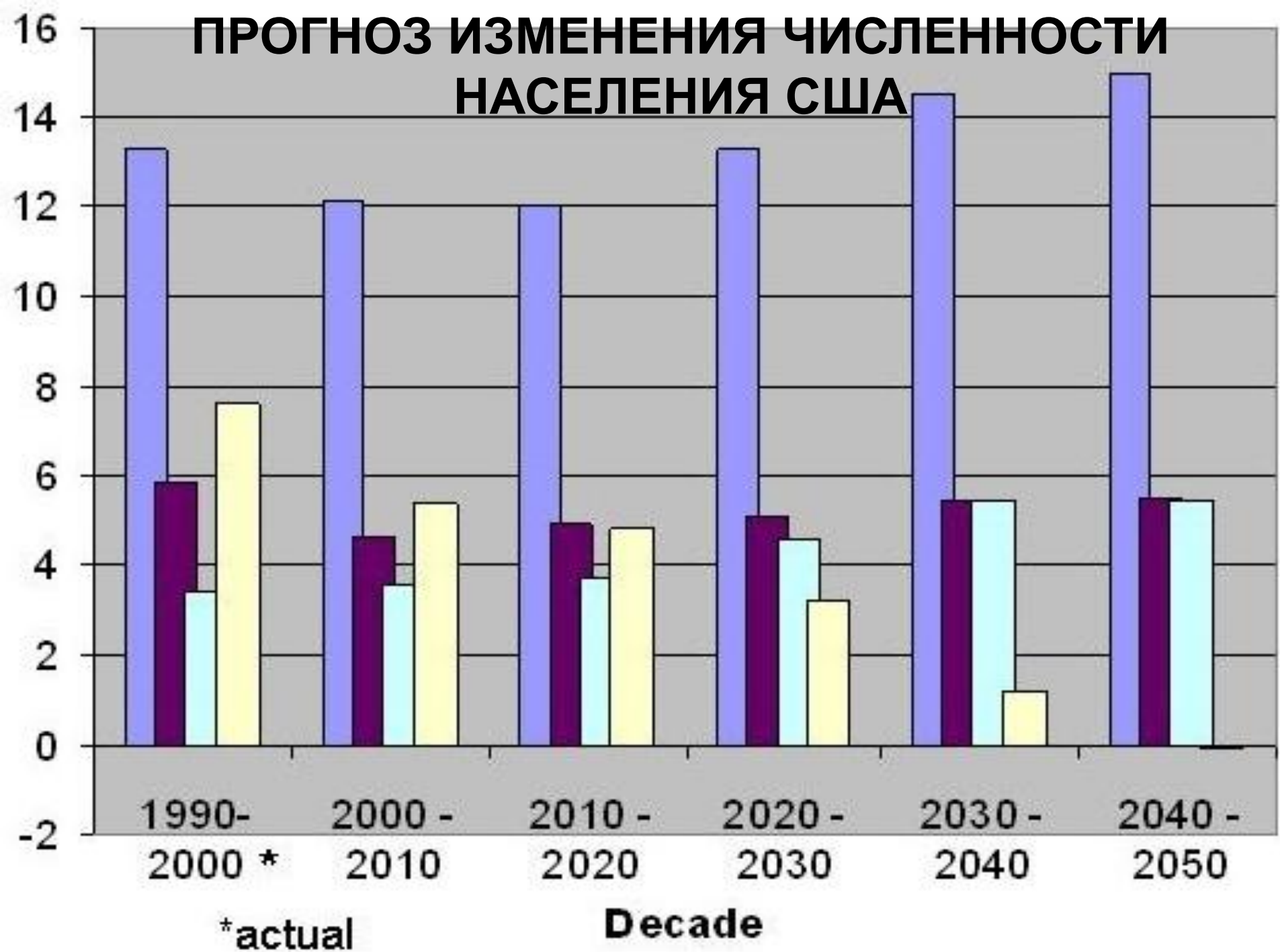

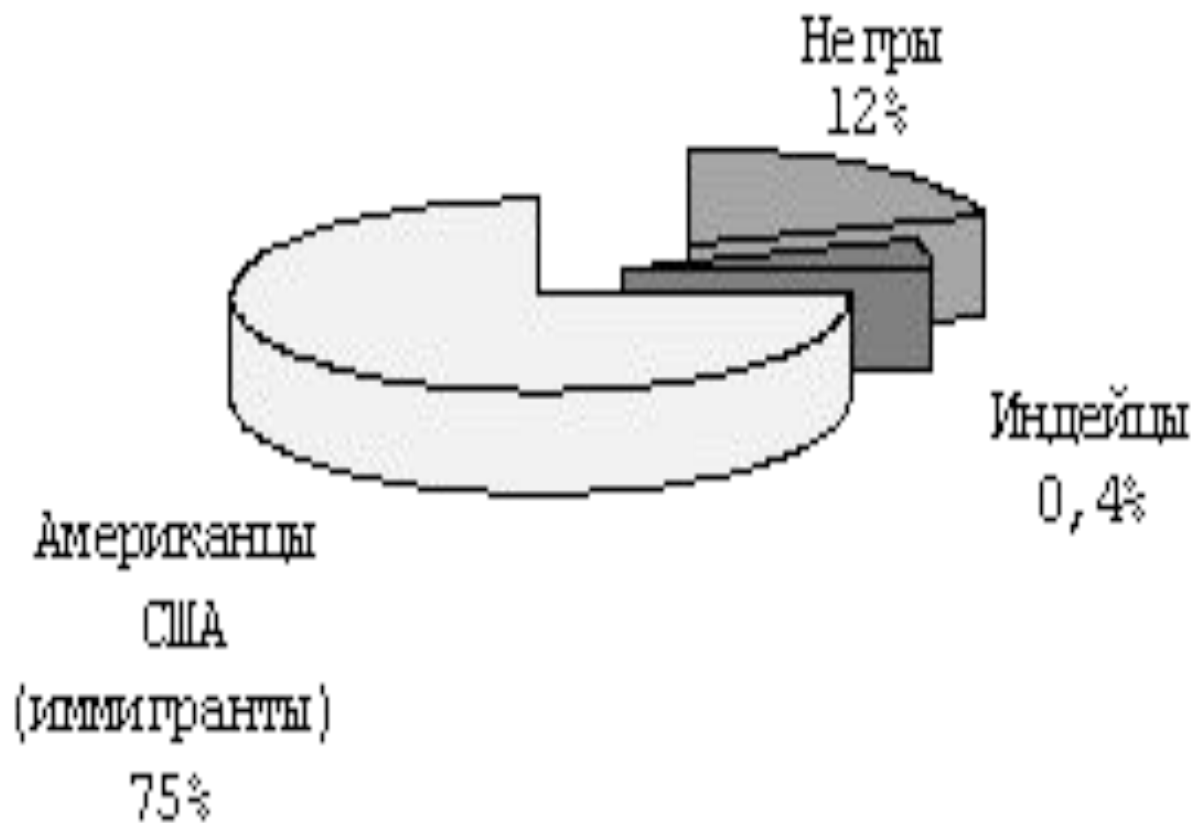

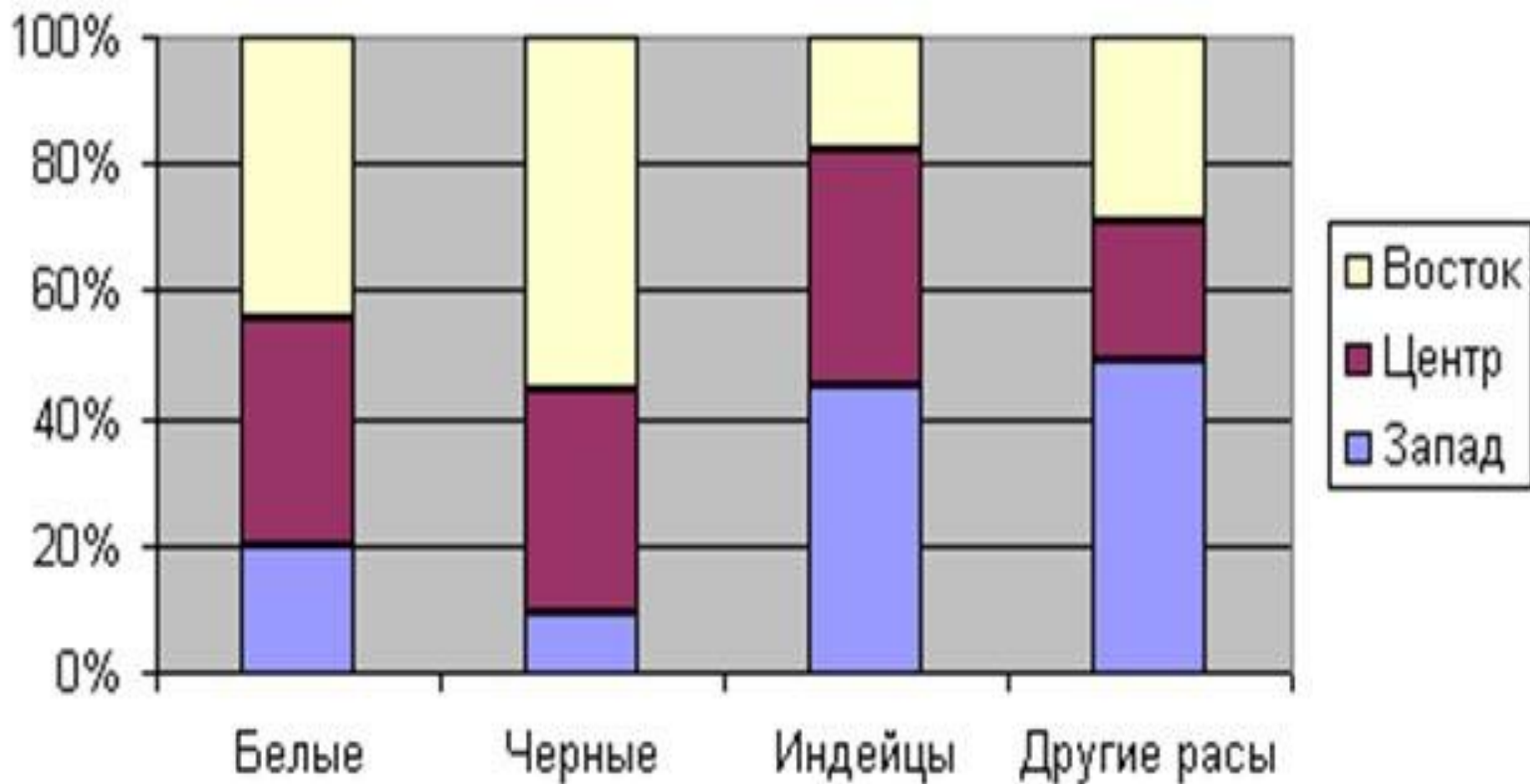

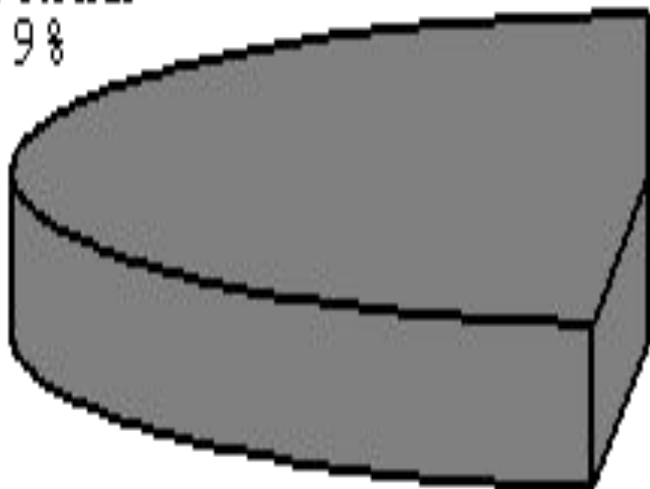

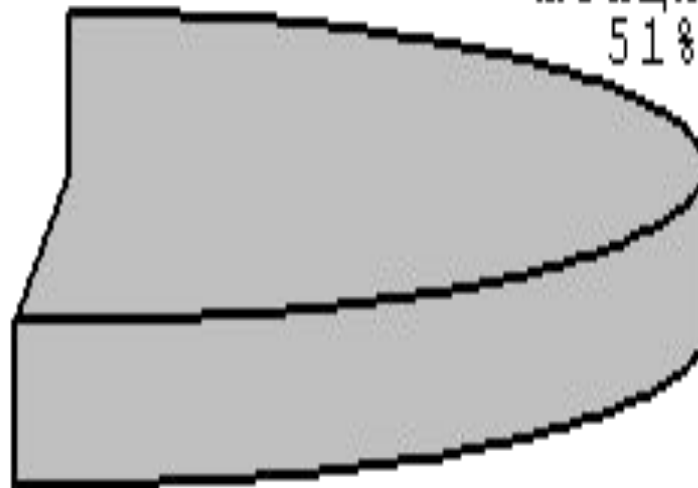

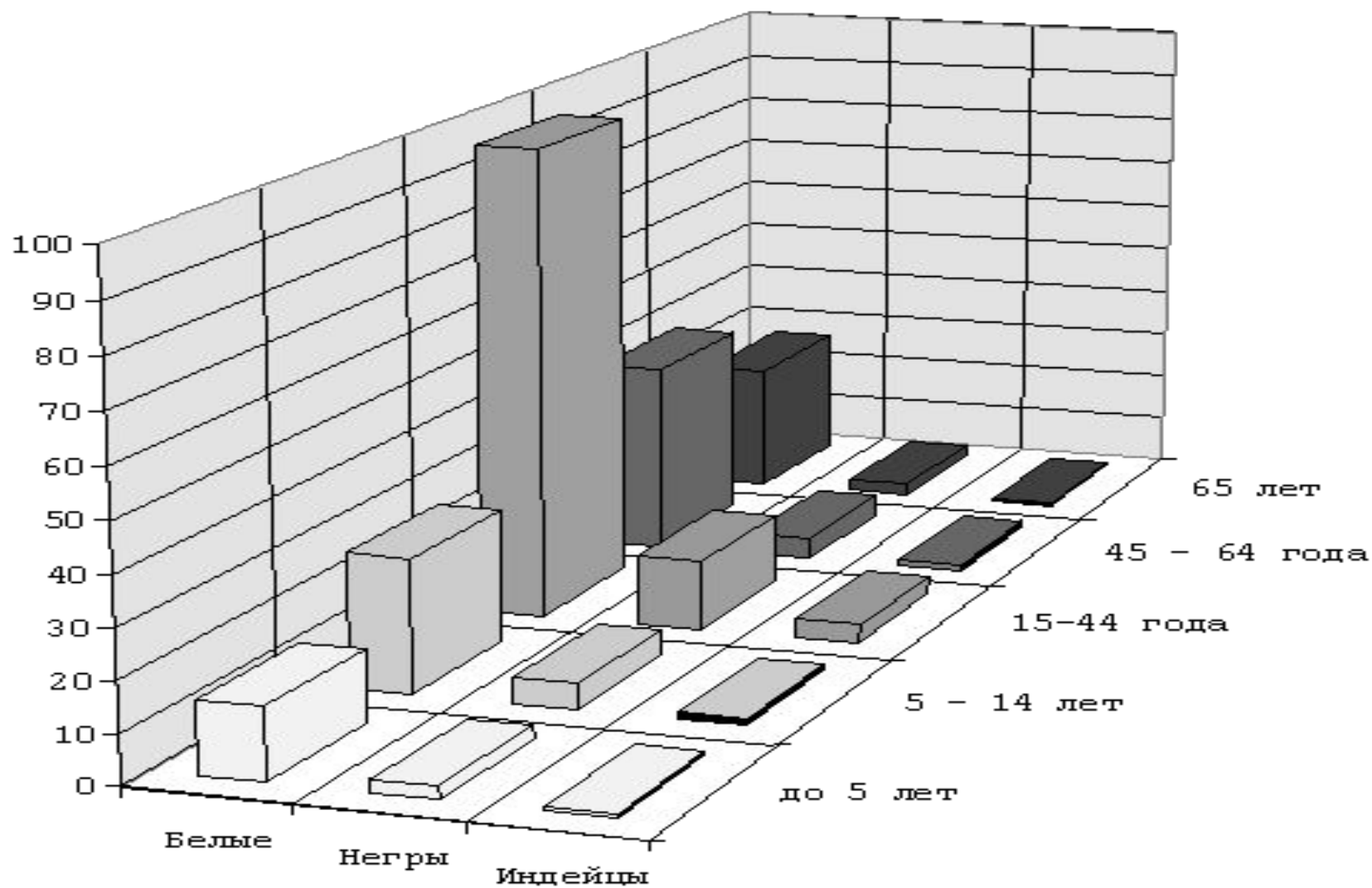

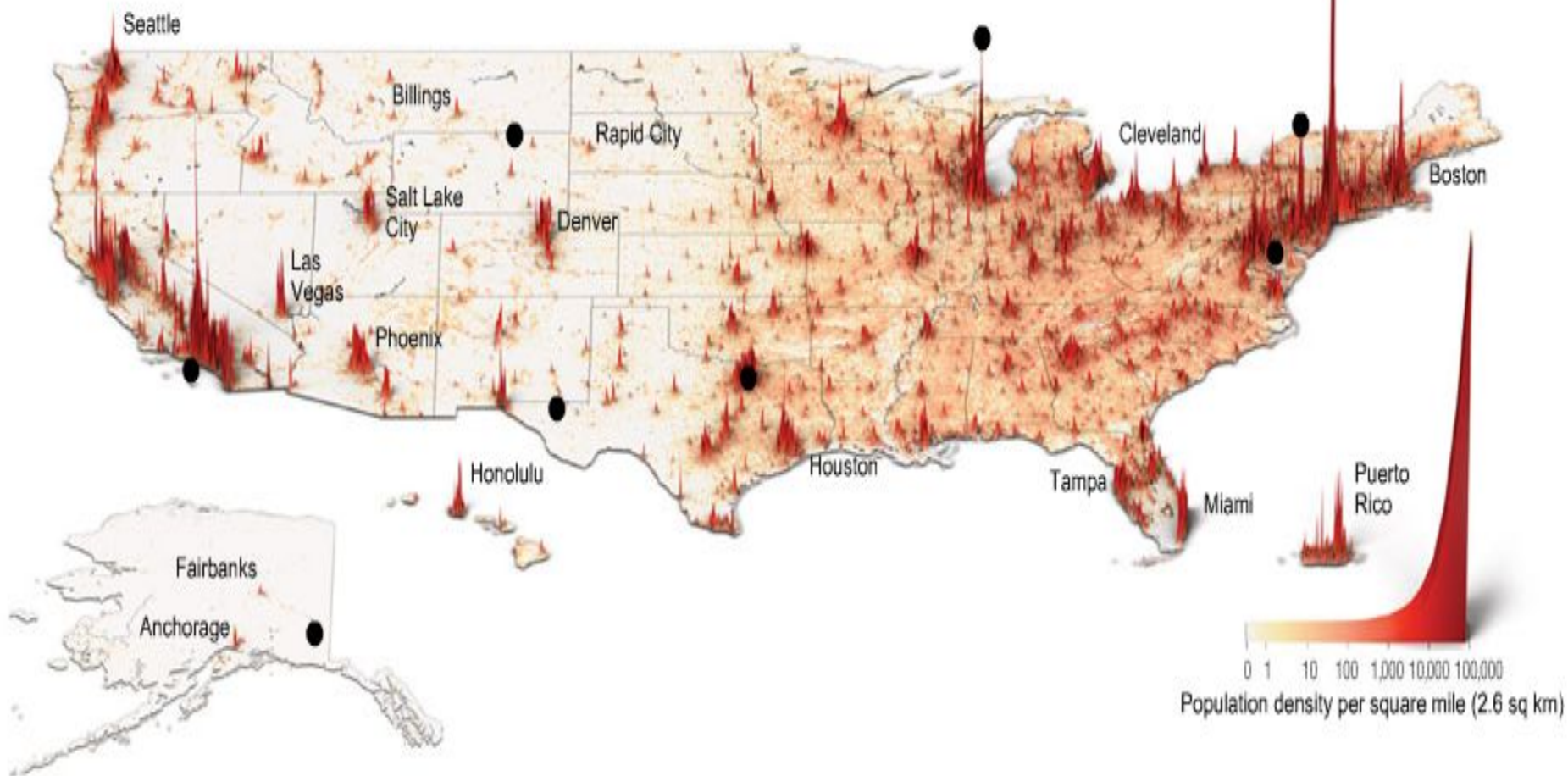

**The White House is the President's residence.**

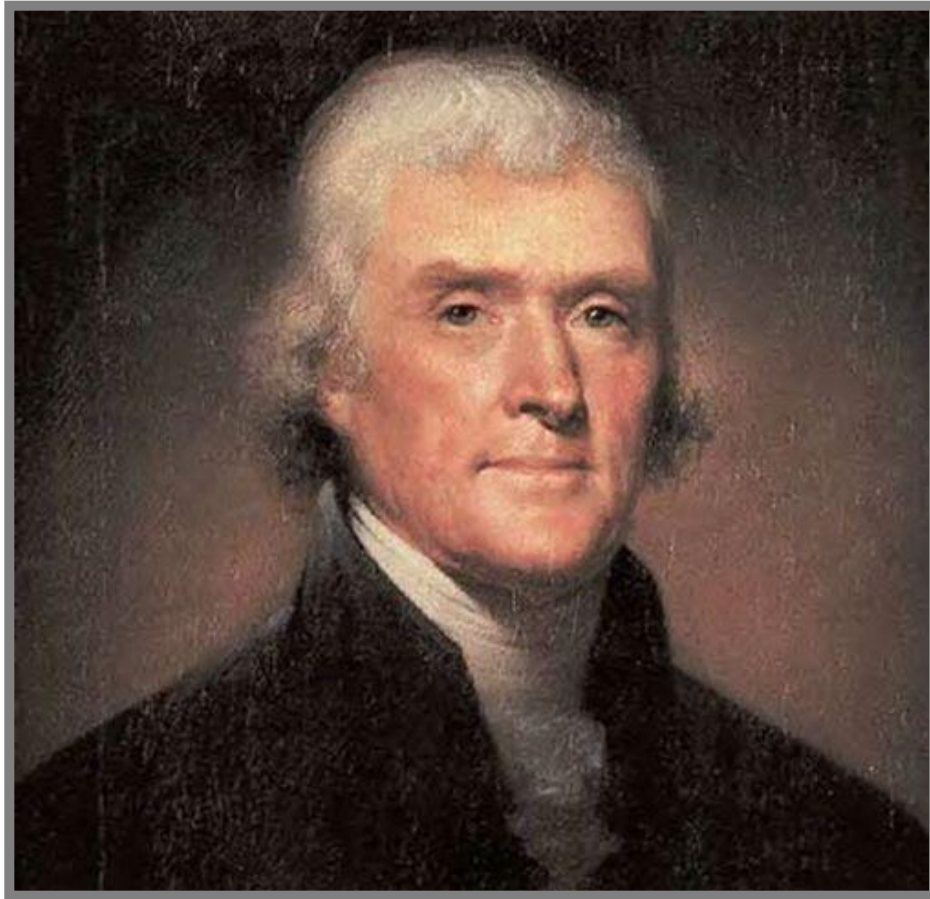
