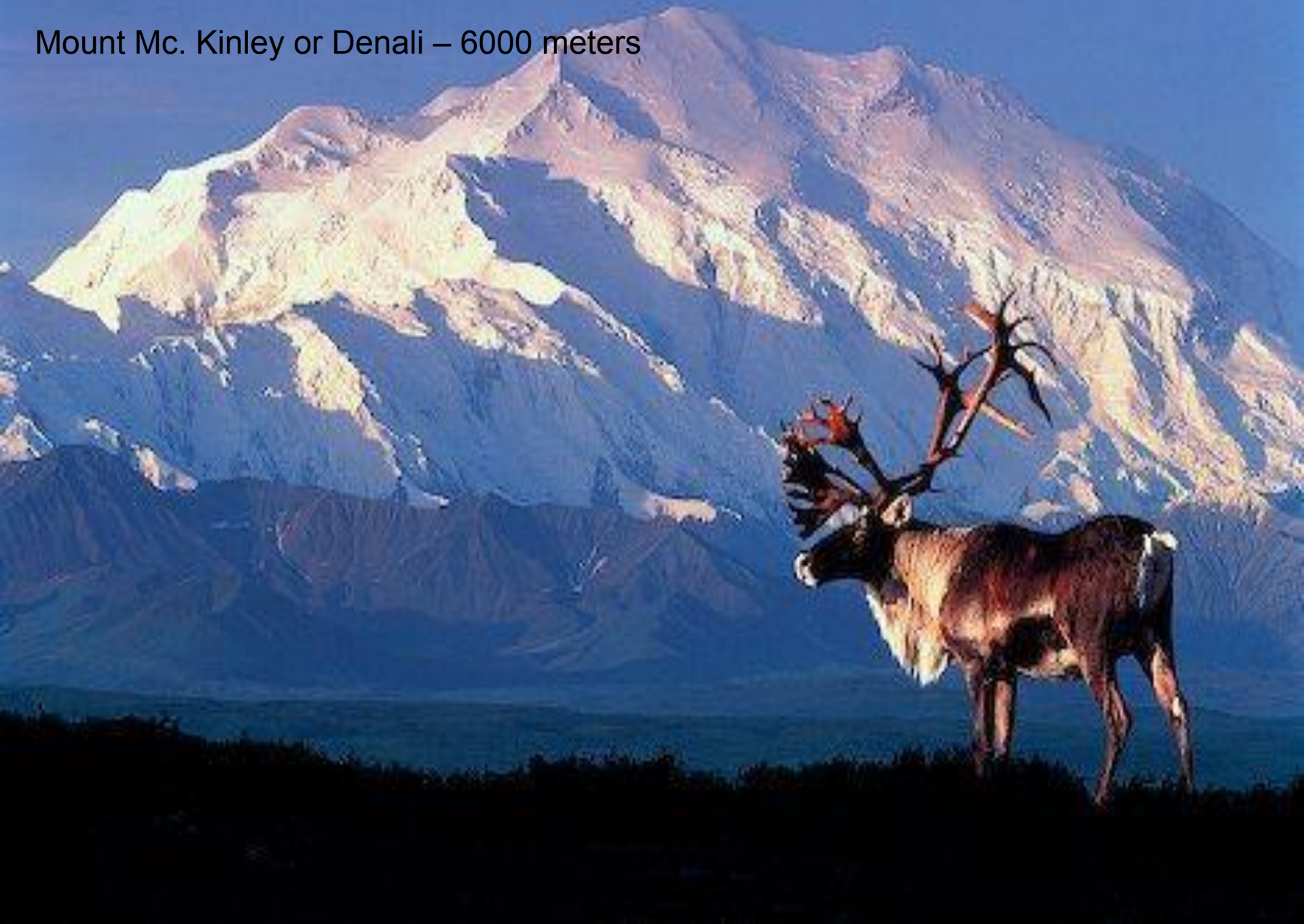

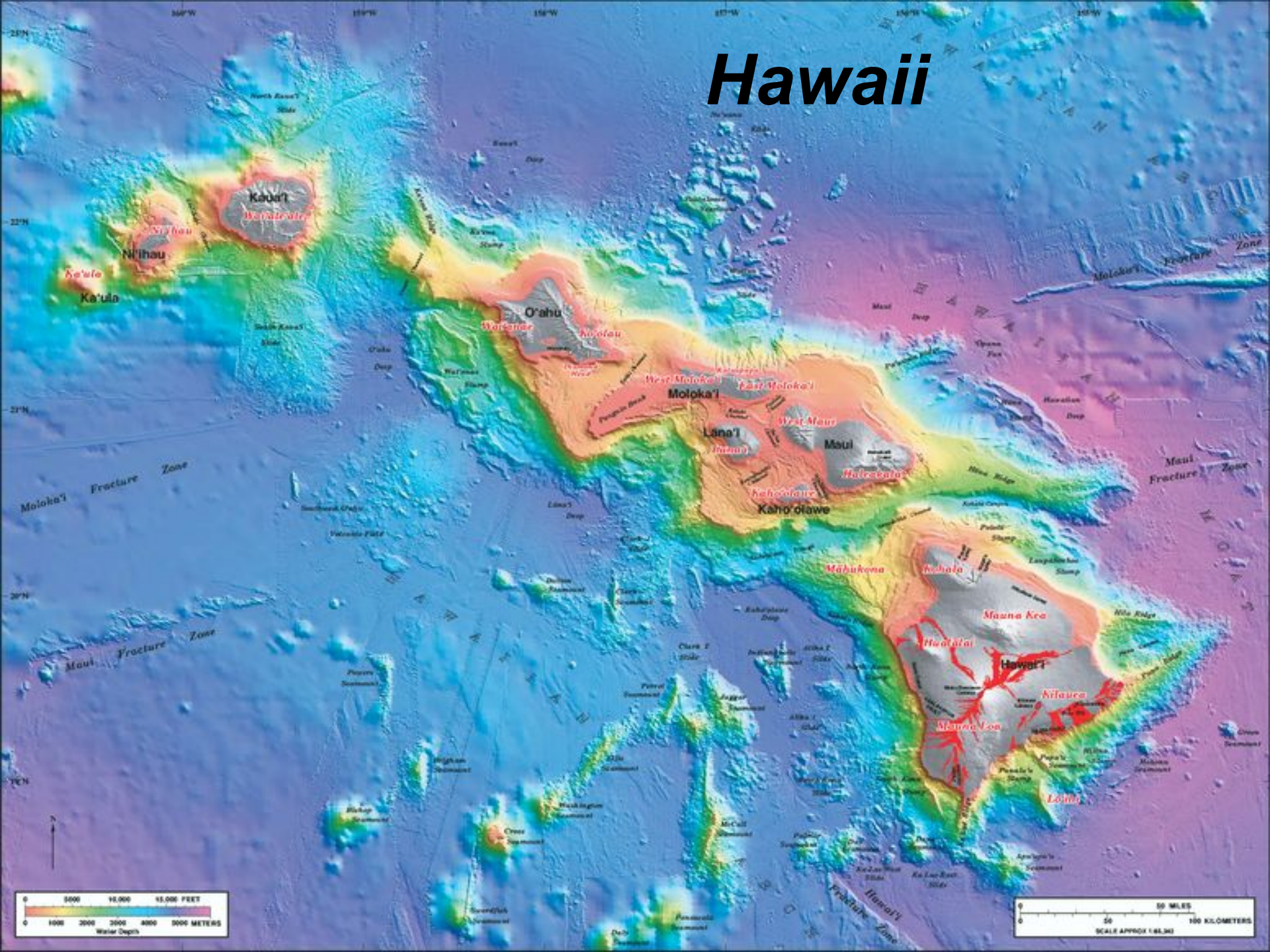

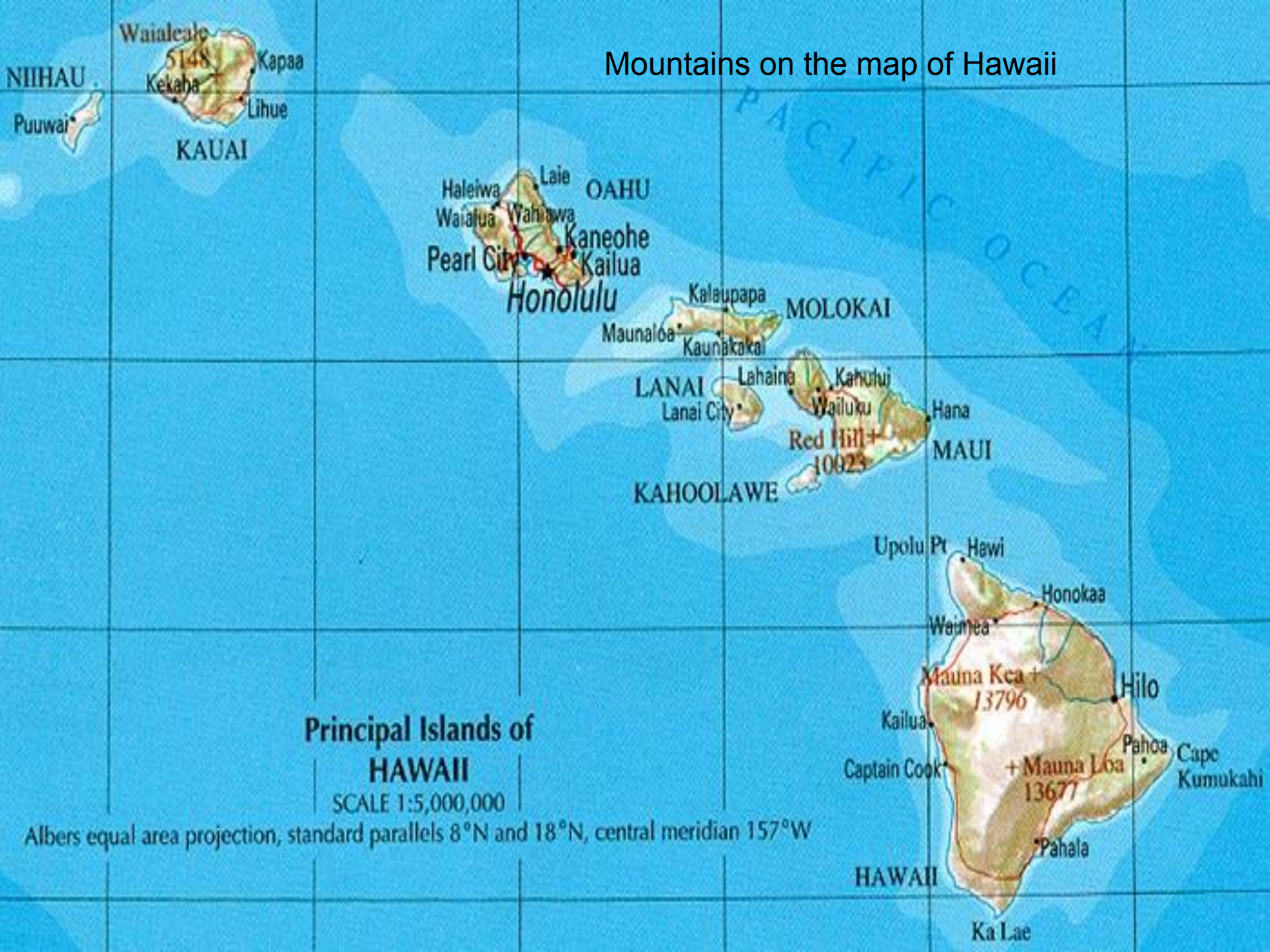
Mount Mc. Kinley or Denali – 6000 meters

Mauna Kea – the highest peak in Hawaii, over 4000 meters

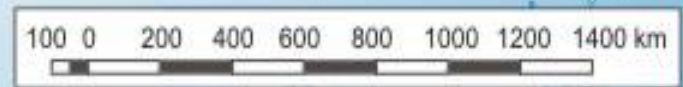

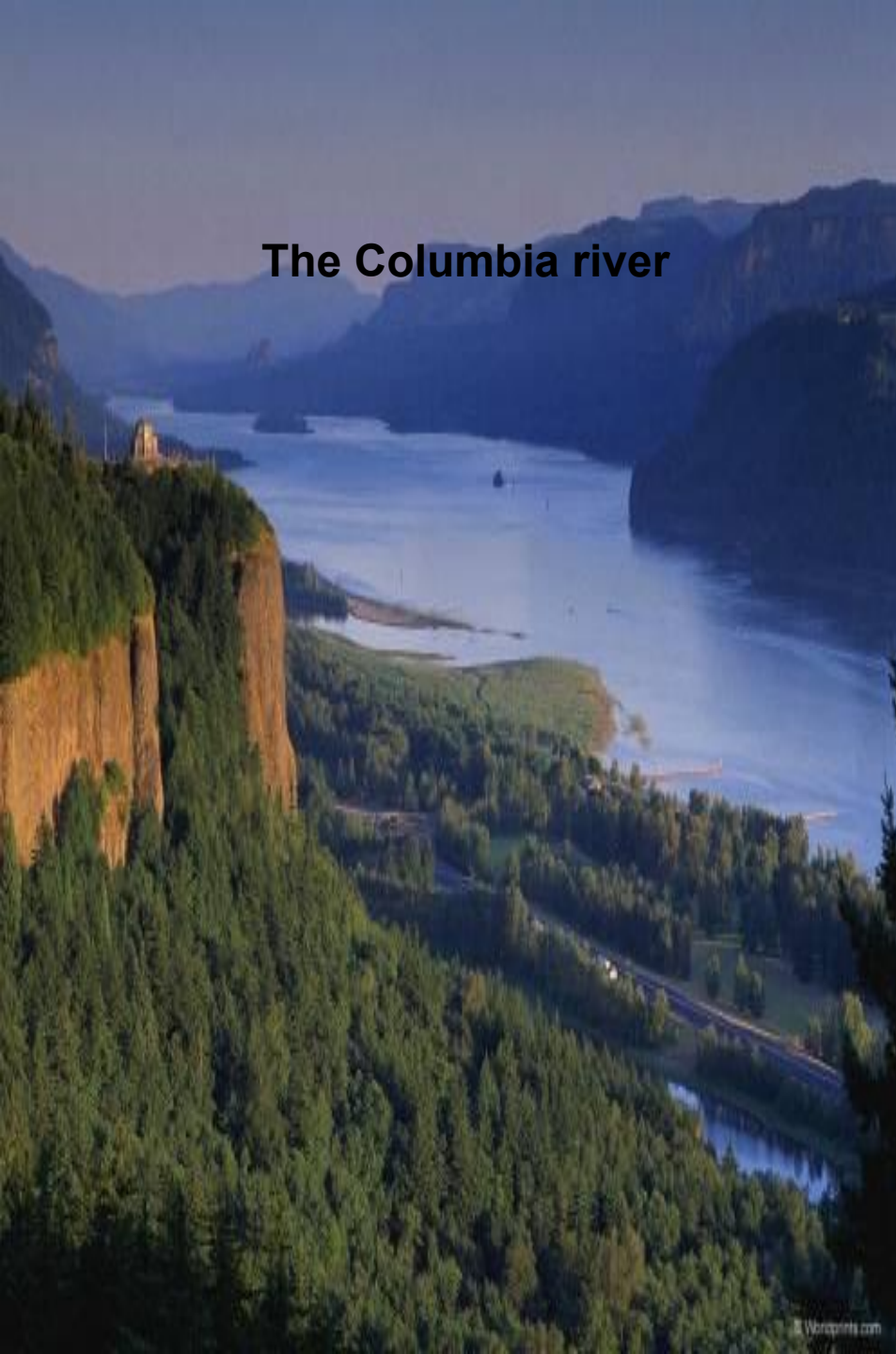

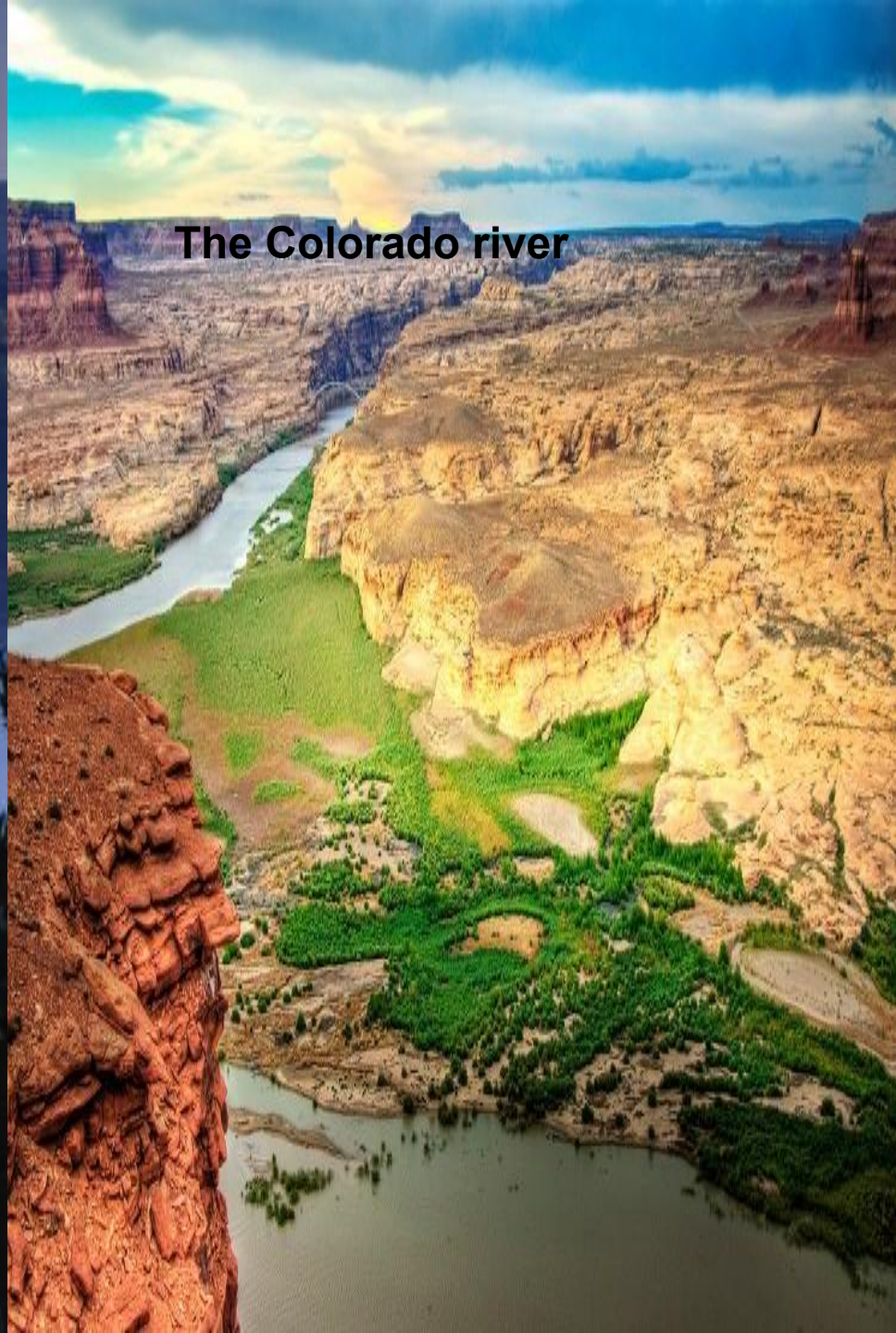

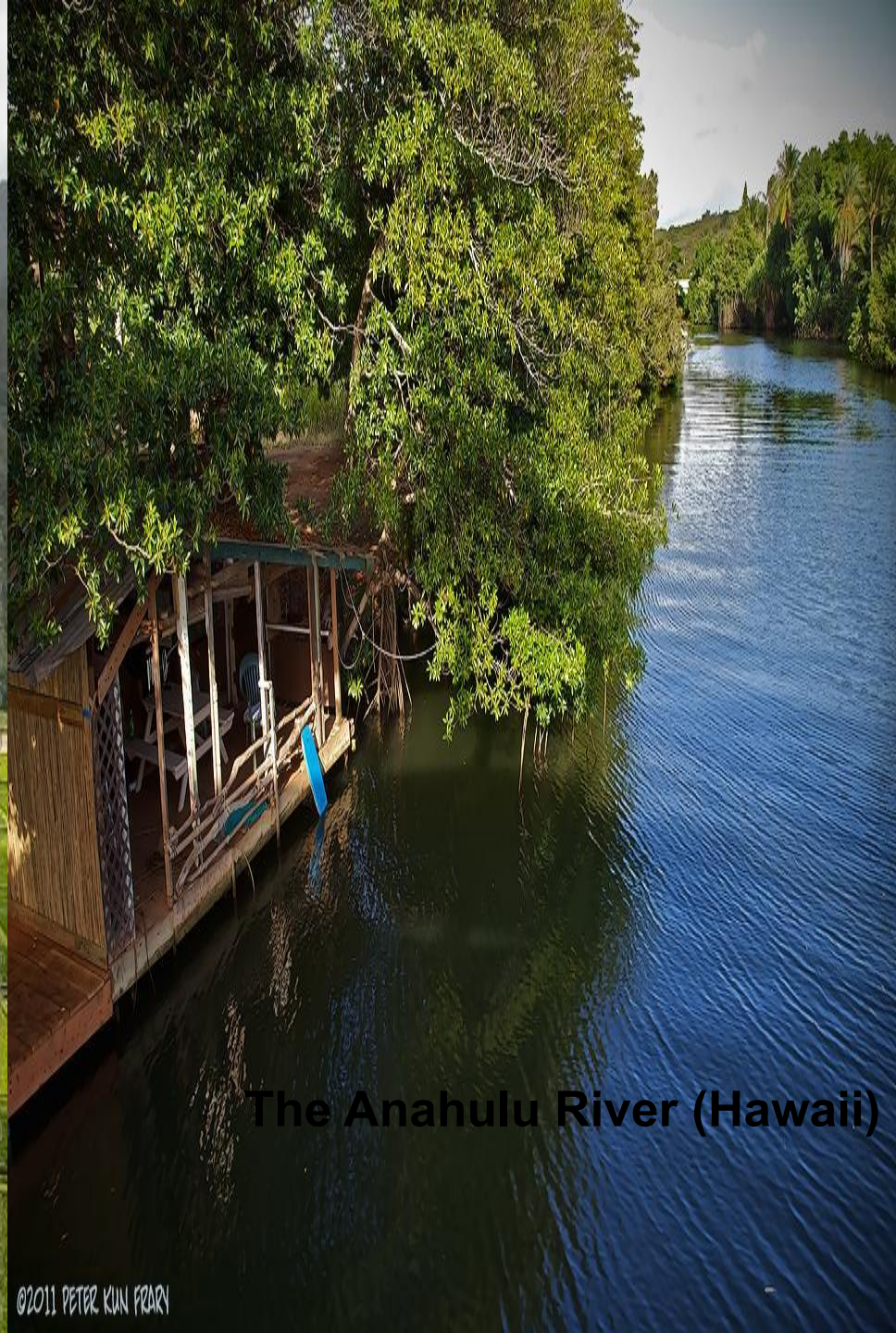

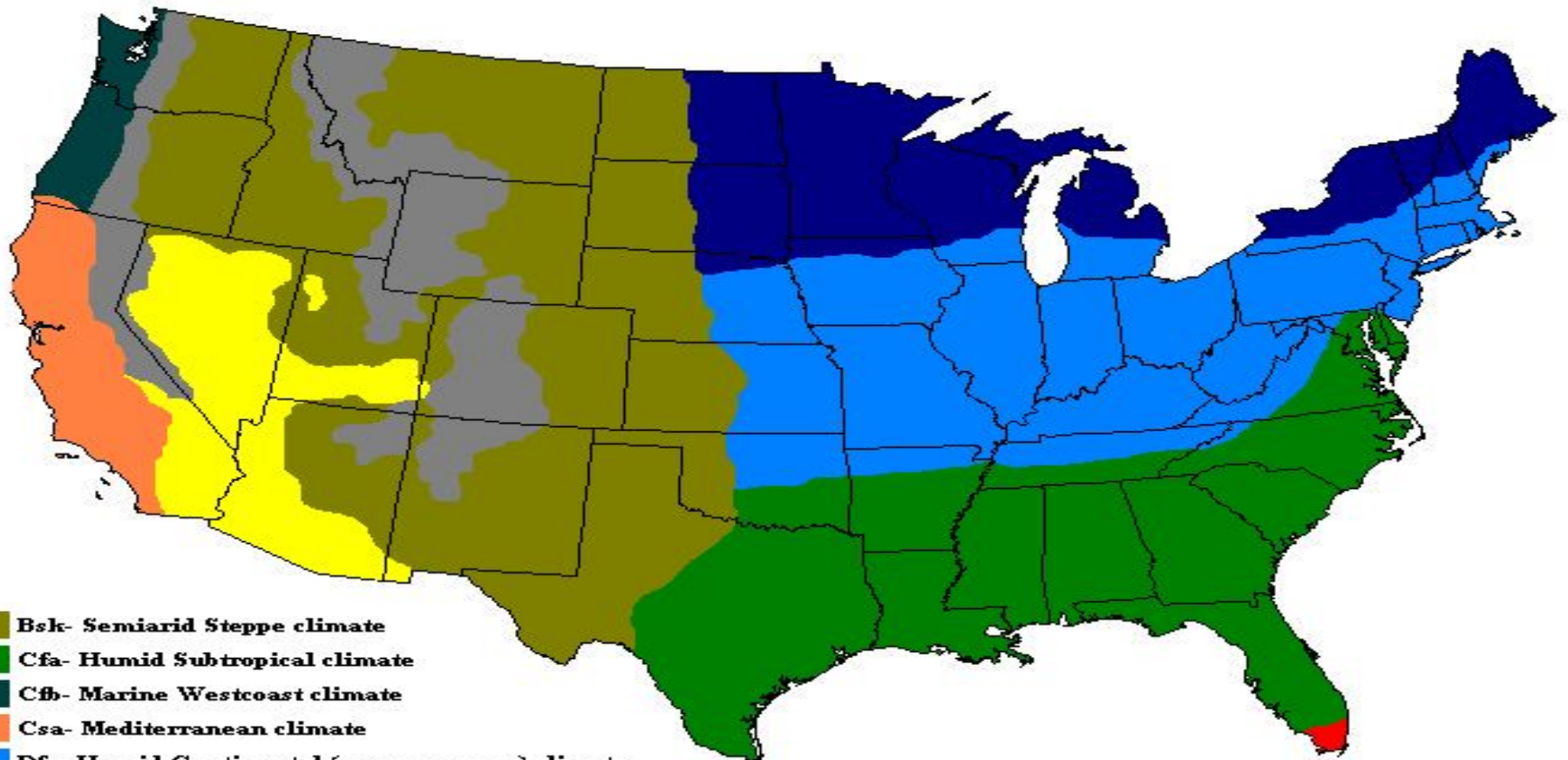

Bsk- Semi-arid Steppe climate

Cfa- Humid Subtropical climate

Cfb- Marine Westcoast climate

Csa- Mediterranean climate

Dfa- Humid Continental (warm summer) climate

Dfb- Humid Continental (cool summer) climate

H- Highland (alpine) climate

Aw- Tropical Wet/Dry Season climate

Bwh- Midlatitude Desert climate
