
State Symbols California

State Capital




 California's state capital is Sacramento.

Senators of California






 California's United States Senators are Diane Feinstein and Barbara Boxer.

 Both women are Democrats.


State Nickname

 Eureka is a Greek word and it means "I have found it!"


State Animal



 California's state animal is the grizzly bear.


 There are no more wild grizzly bears in California.
