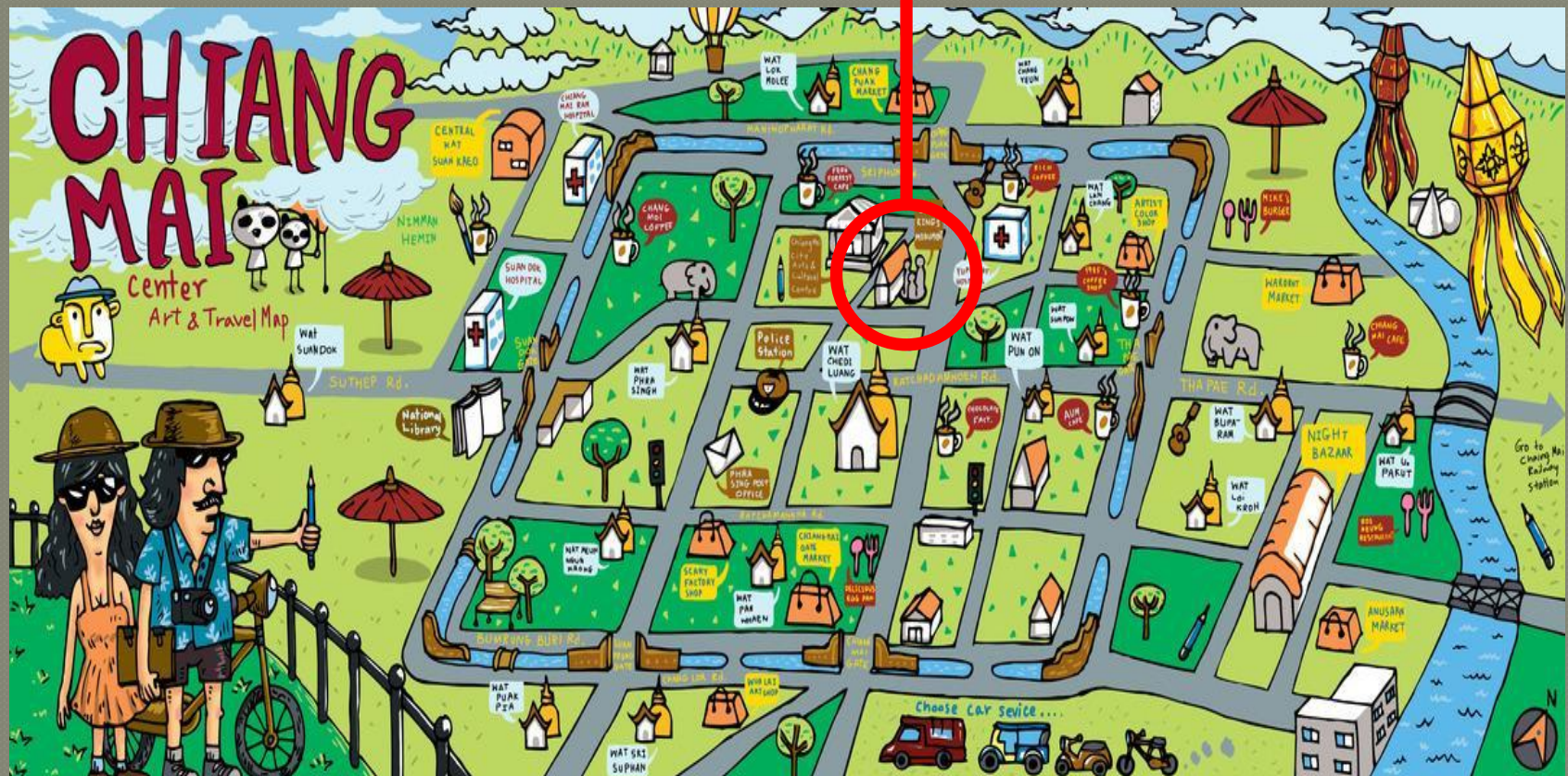


The Three Kings Monument is one of the most famous monuments in Chiang Mai

the moment Chiang Mai, was found.



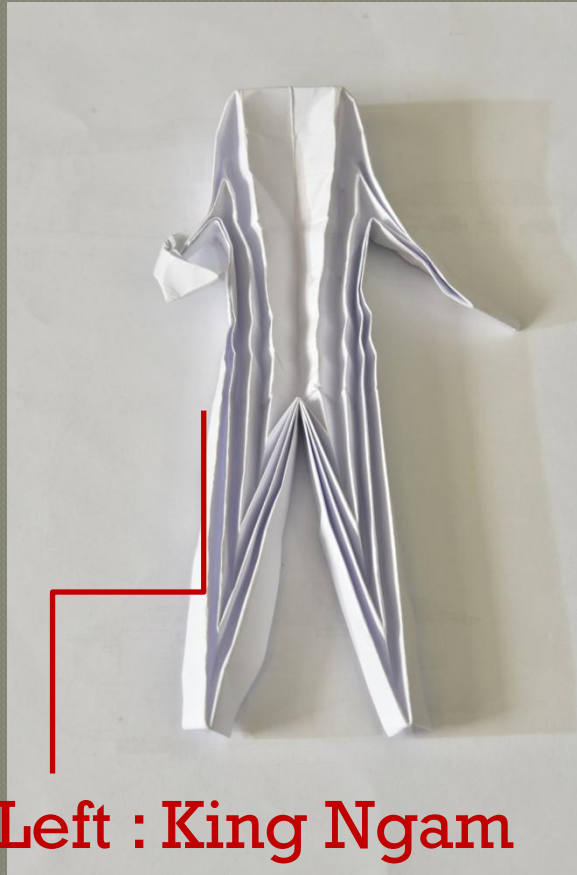
The statue was made in 1983

The Three Kings were best friends.

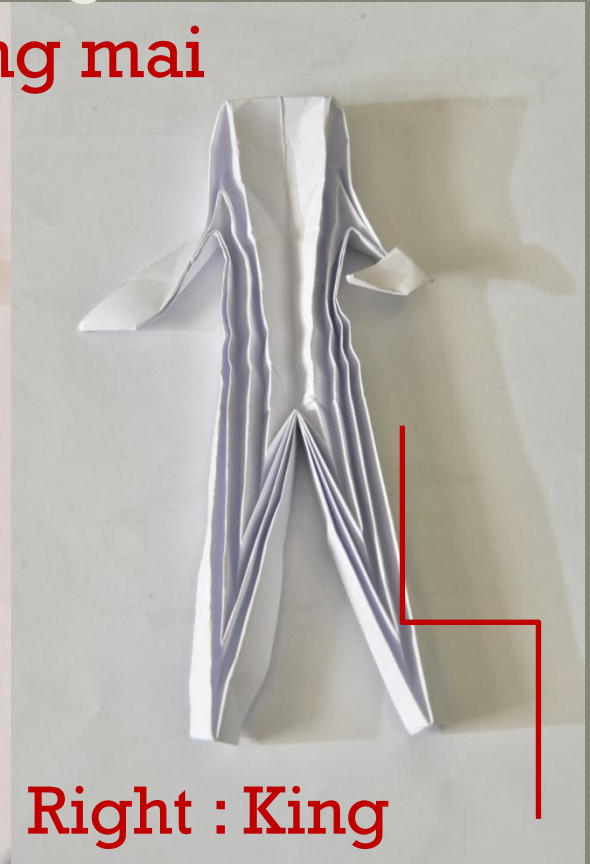
They worked together to layout the city of Chiang Mai

founder of Chiang mai

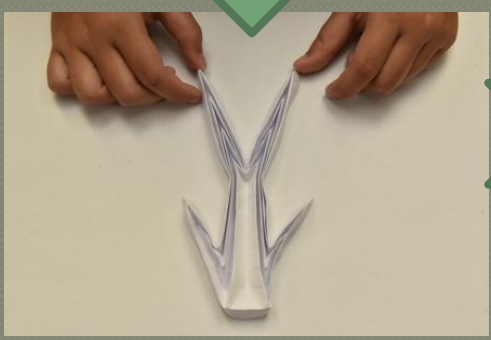
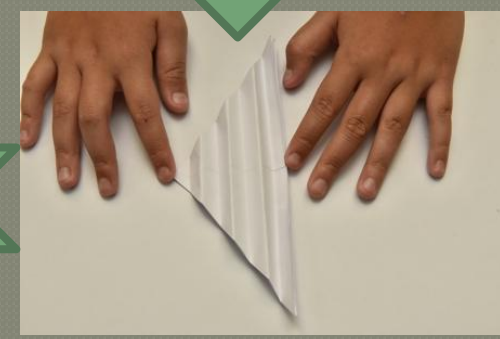
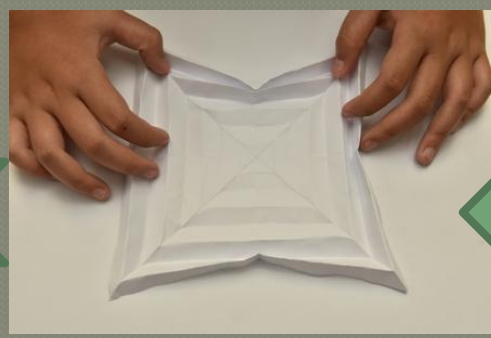
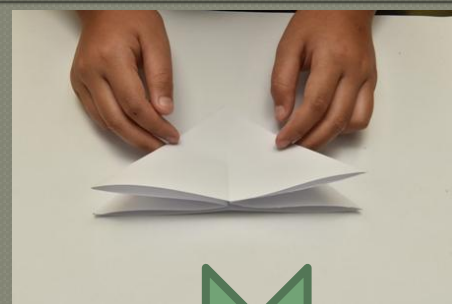
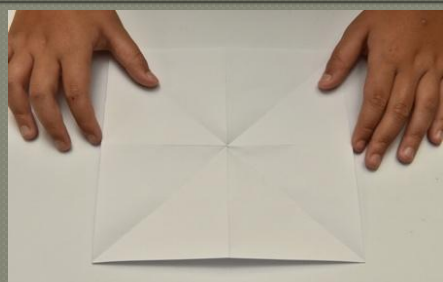
