# YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK



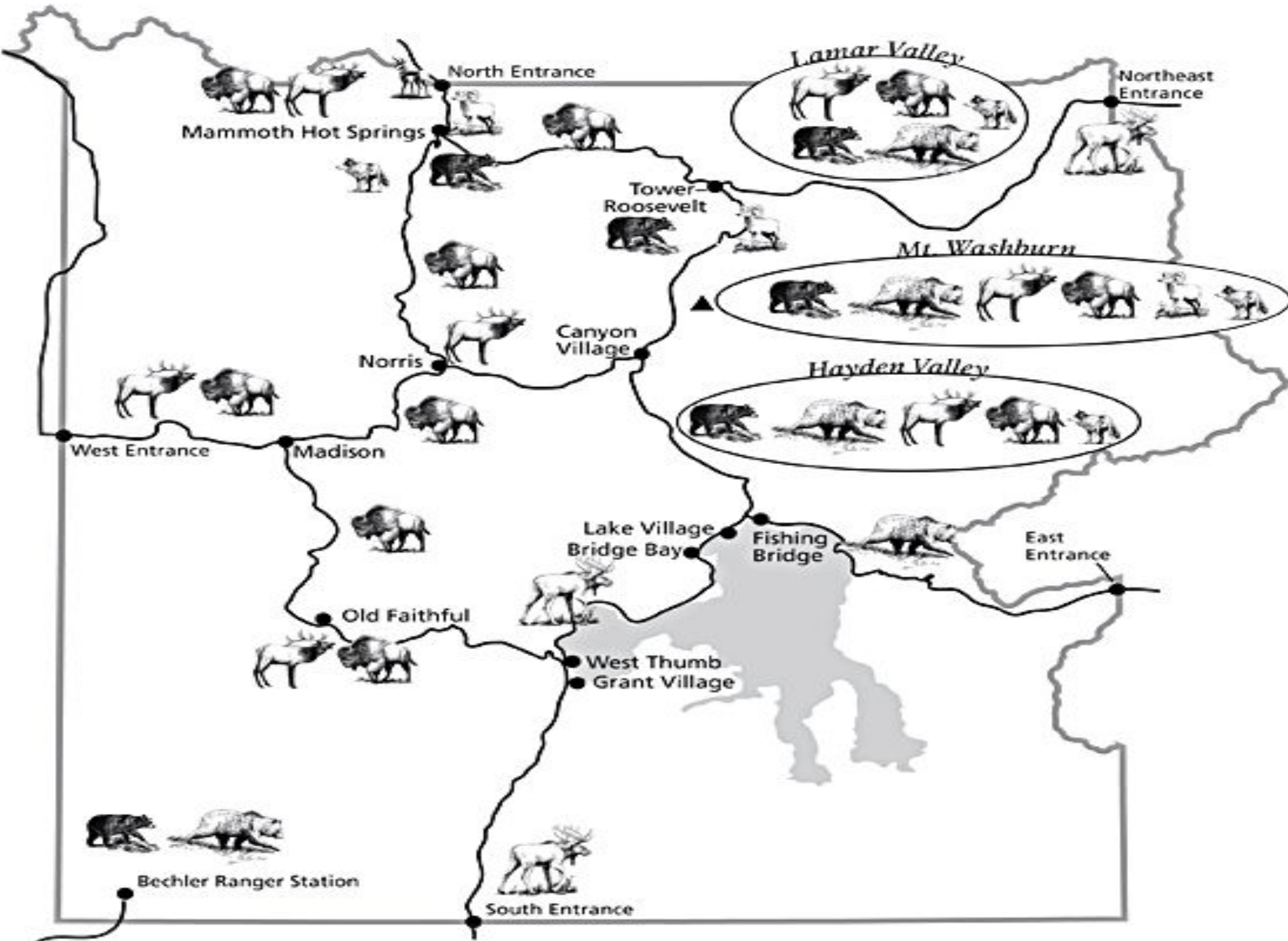
*Yellowstone National Park is one of the most popular in America, is located in the North of the country, on the territory of the three States of Wyoming, Montana and Idaho.*

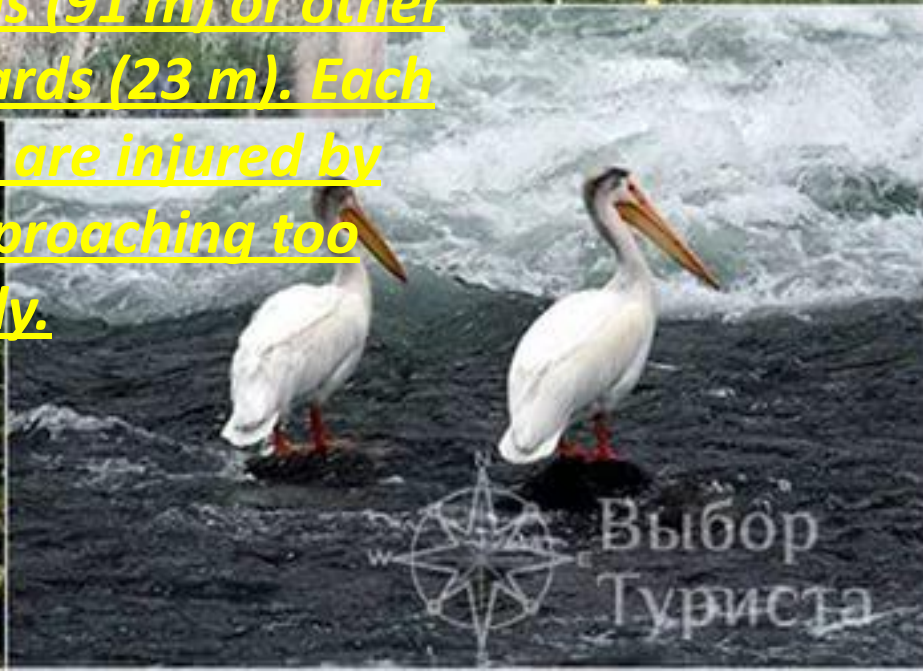
