

 - The lack of high-quality, competitive, best-selling consumer goods.

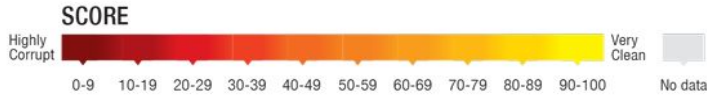
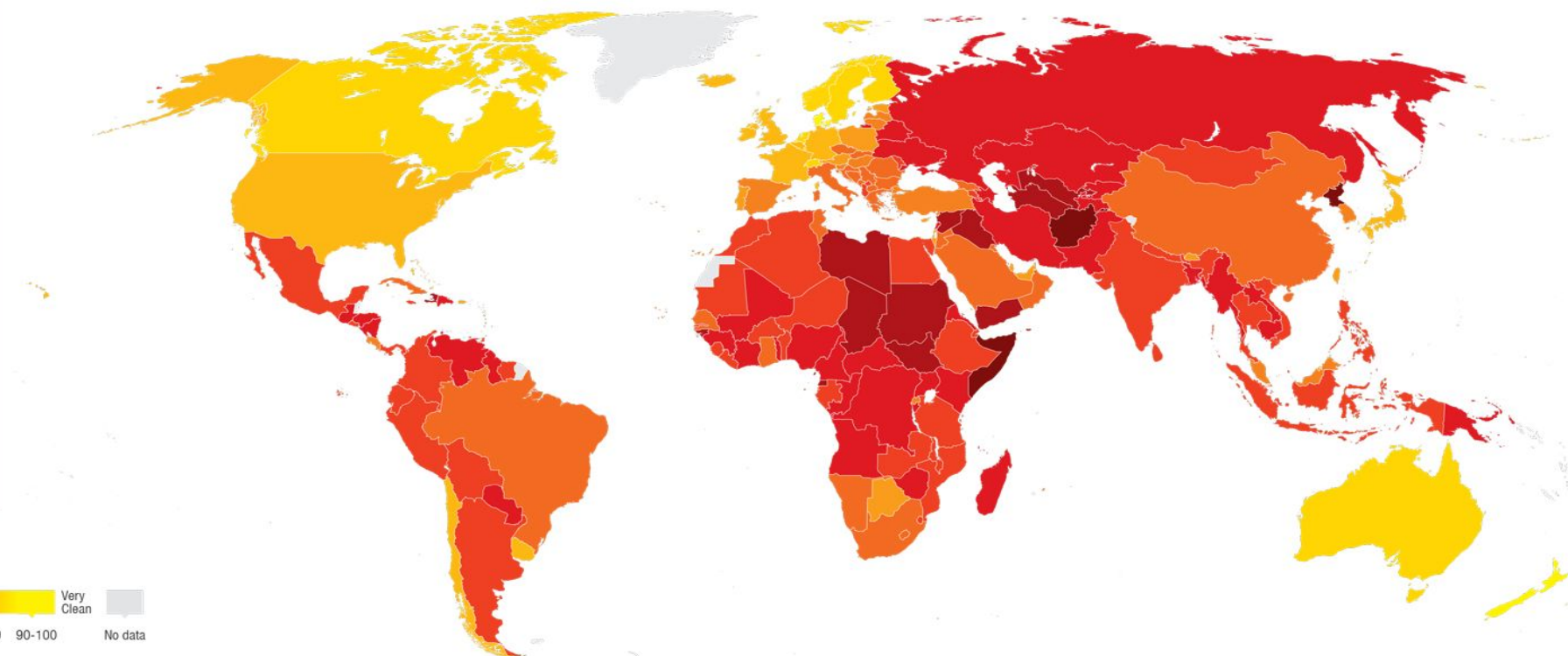


Corruption and shadow economy interfere to democracy in Kyrgyzstan
