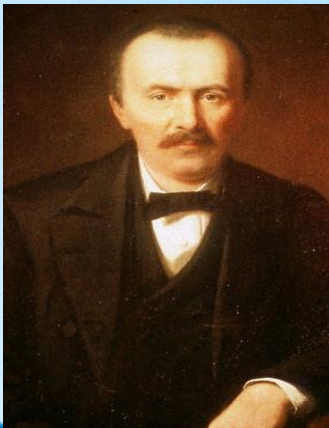
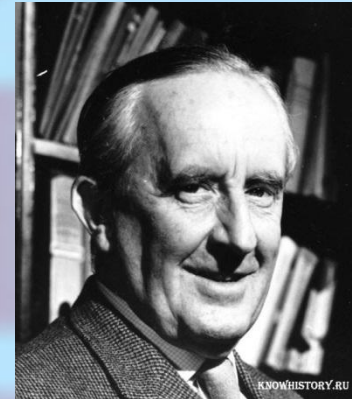


# The 13<sup>th</sup> Question

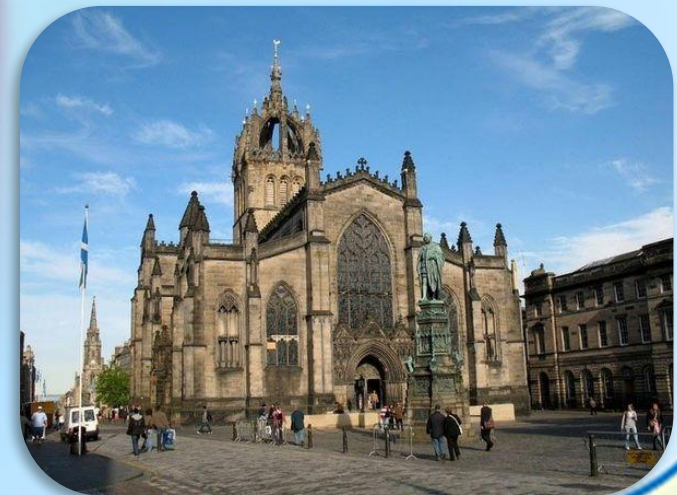
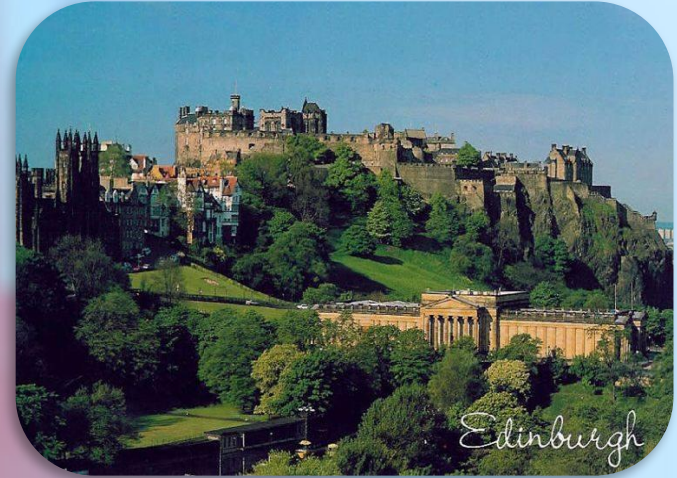
