History of the Italian Language

Many of them are not picky and are recognized by linguists as separate languages. But official status, they have not received. For example, in the northeast of Italy about 600,000 people speak the "Friuli".

The Italian language has developed based on the Romance dialects of Italy, going back to Vulgar Latin. Phonetics and phonology
