1337 - 1453


War between England and France

Despite initial successes, **England** never achieved its goal in the war, and as a result of the war on the continent it had only the port of Kale, which it held until 1558.

War of the Roses



1455 - 1487

War for authority between the two branches of the Plantagenet dynasty - Lancasters on Yorkes.

The war ended in the victory of Henry Tudor from the side branch of the Lancaster House, which founded a dynasty that ruled **England and Wales** for 117 years.

1642 - 1645

Transition in England from absolute monarchy to constitutional

The revolution ended in 1645, when Cromwell created the "Army of a new pattern", which won a decisive victory in the battle of Naseby.
