Man-beatniks looked as young English teachers. The clothes of women reminded an easy gothic style.

In article «History of the Beat movement» Christal Hillner noted the interesting fact: style of beatniks was inspired of clothes of the famous jazz musician Dizzy Gillespie which was putting on in black trousers, sweaters and wearing dark glasses.



Typical man-beatniks look: beret. dark glasses, beard, sweater and bongo.

"Beat Generation" sold books, sold black turtleneck sweaters and bongos, berets and dark glasses, sold a way of life that seemed like dangerous fun—thus to be either condemned or imitated. Suburban couples could have beatnik parties on Saturday nights and drink too much and fondle each other's wives

long dress.

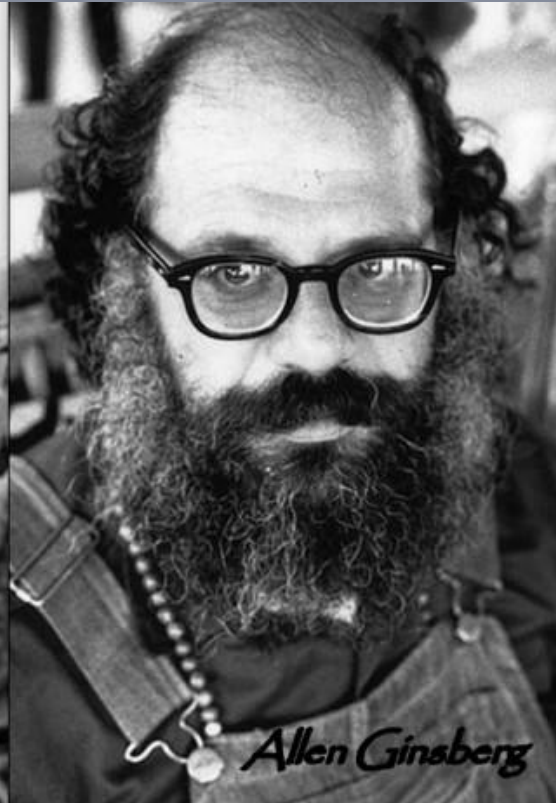

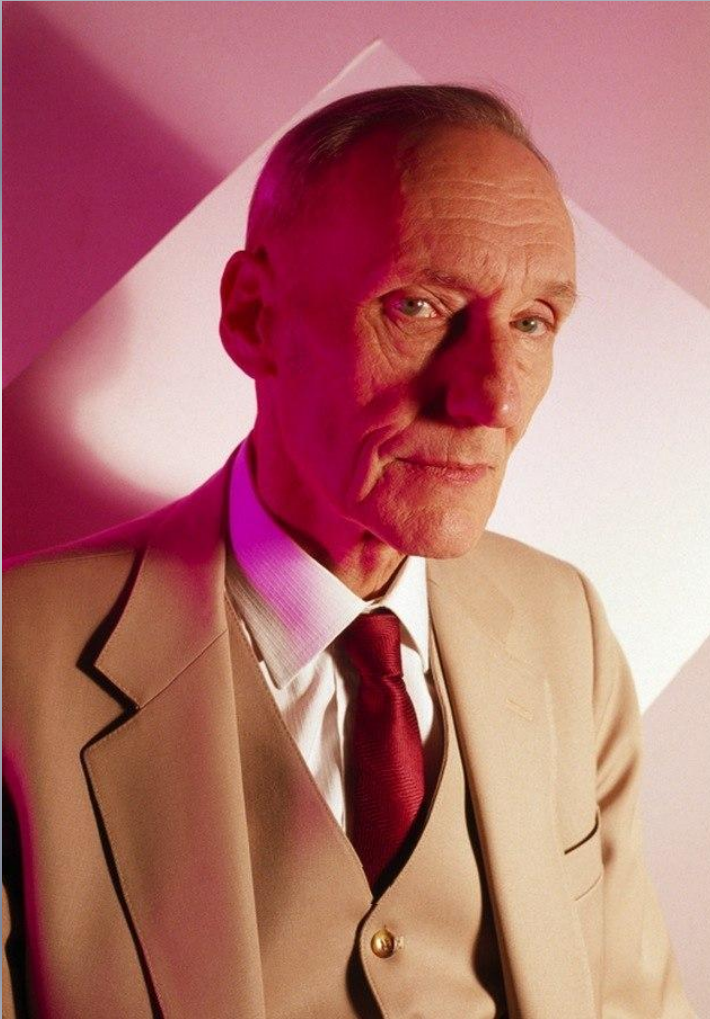

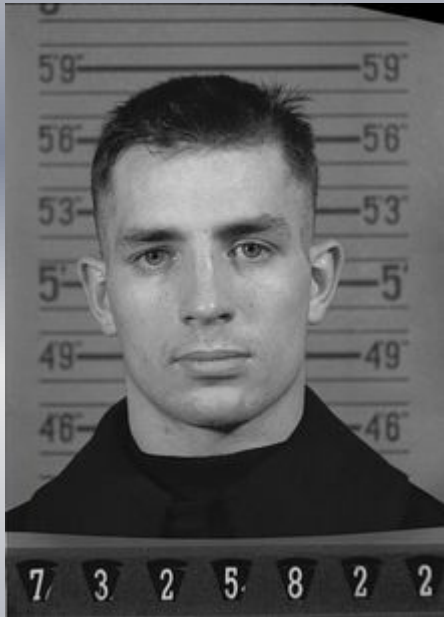
