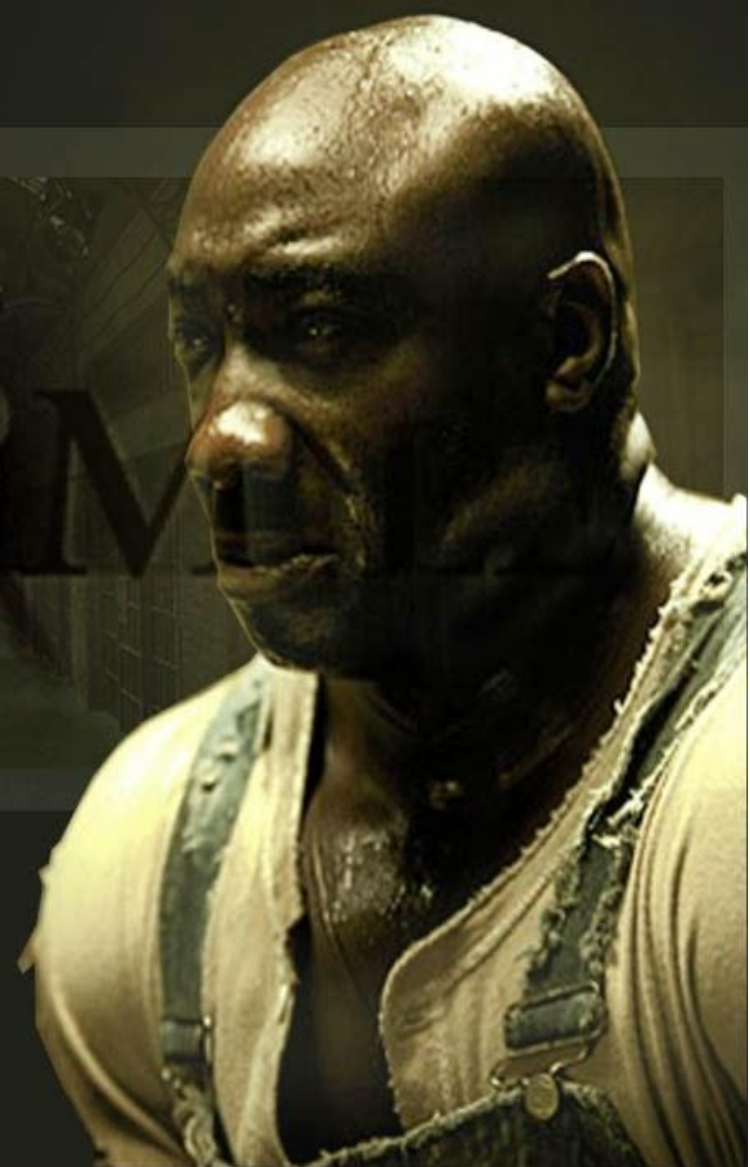
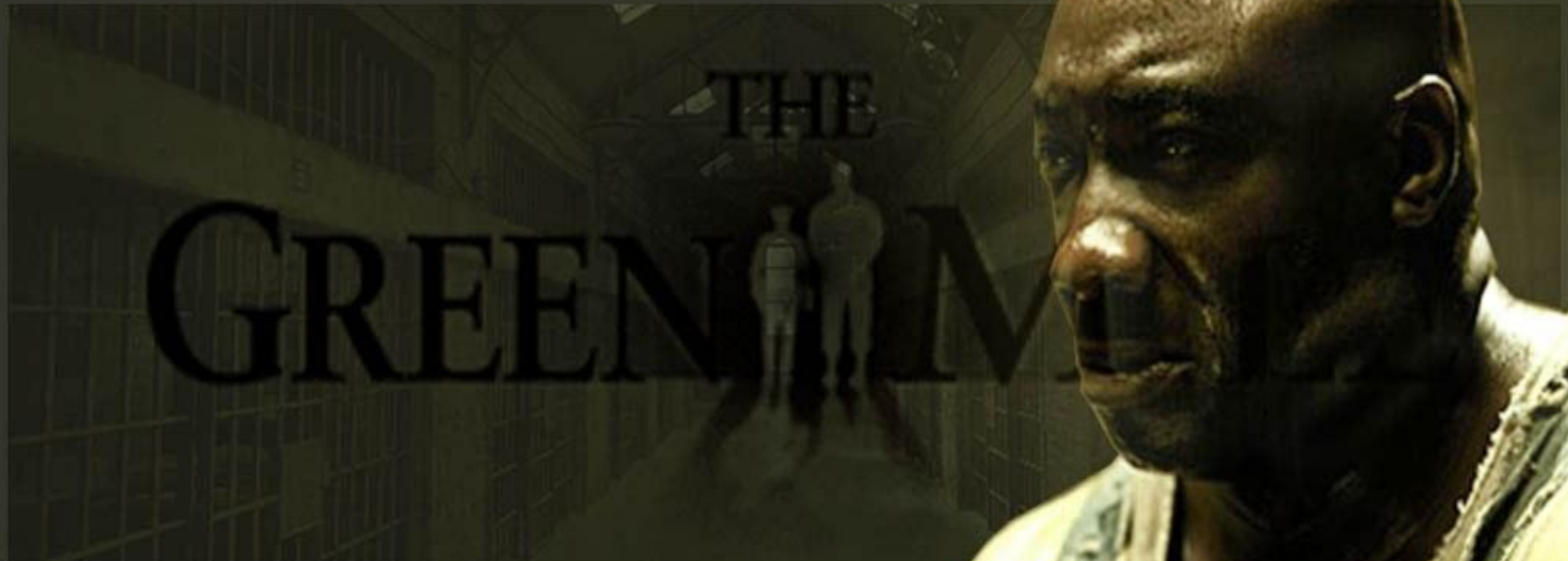






This is a story about a completely different people: good, kind and always ready to come to the rescue, and the bad, evil, all that hate. But all in good time =)

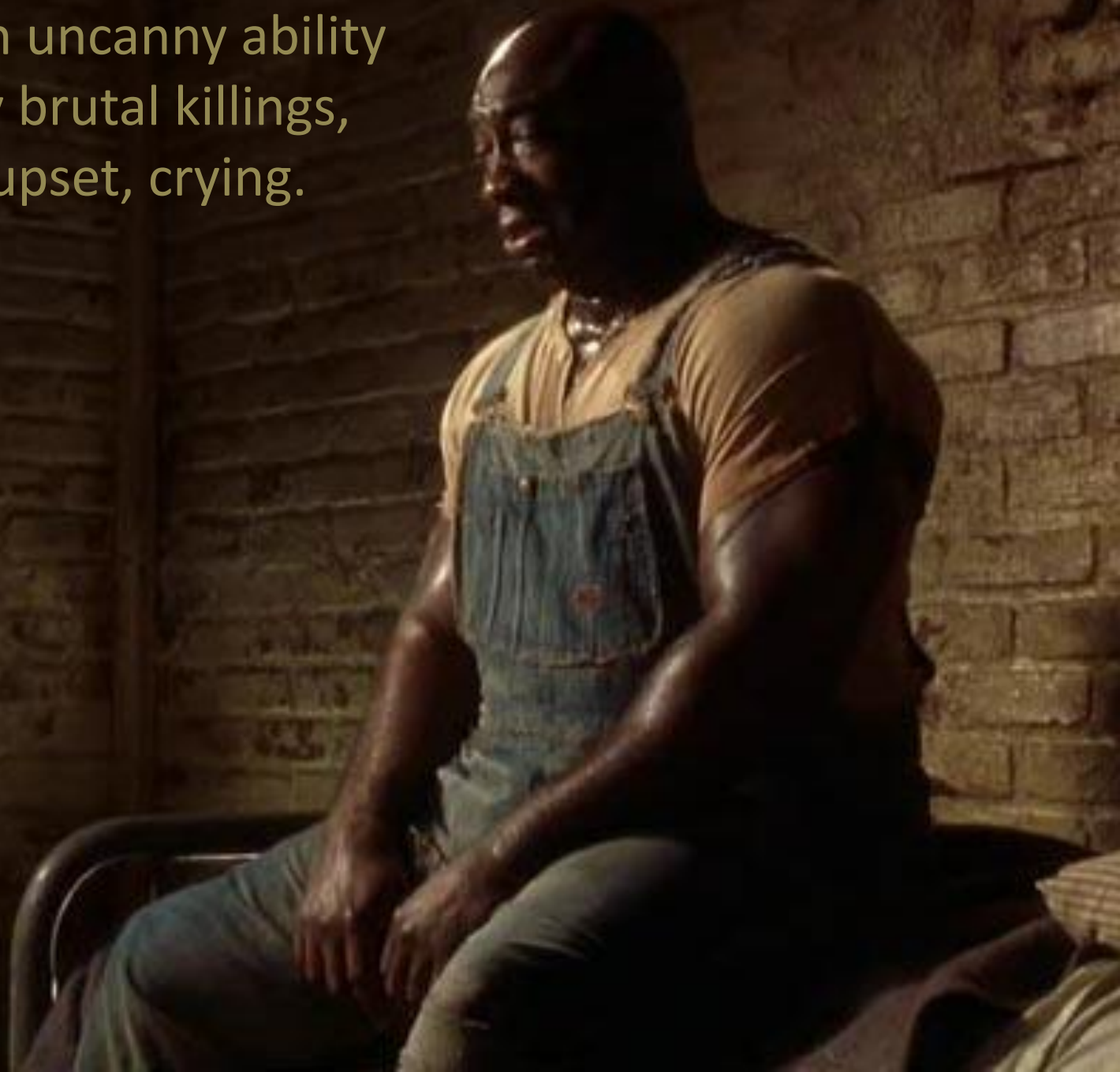
