BIOGRAPHY

- Karl Briullov was born in St. Petersburg in the family craftsman. From 1809 to 1821 painted at the St. Petersburg Academy of Arts. Masterpieces been extremely successful student, he received the Gold Medal of the class of historical painting.



The first work - "Narcissus" (1820).

INTERESTING FACT

- Portrait of the poet Vasily Zhukovsky played the lottery and rescued 2,500 rubles for which bought from serfdom Taras Shevchenko.



LAST DAY OF POMPEII

The picture was painted in 1833. It depicts the eruption of Vesuvius that destroyed the city of Pompeii in Naples. Style - romanticism. Today the picture is in Russian State Museum in St. Petersburg.
