


Факты из биографии Антти Ловага



Antti Lovag is a living legend. He is a Hungarian architect and the author of bubble housing.


He was born on the 10th of April in Budapest. His mother was Finnish and his father was Russian. He didn't have any degrees in architecture.

Lovag didn't Antti like corners or straight lines, only streamlined surfaces. This also explains his interest in spherical and round shapes, which are the main ones in his projects. According to Antti Lovag a straight line is aggressive and it is against nature. So he built houses in the form of soap bubbles as experimental models.



The structure of houses are made of reinforced concrete. The entire space seems to be outlined with a compass: a minimum of angles, only soft shapes and roundness.

The most important aspect for the architect was to create convenience and comfort through natural forms.

Antti Lovag thinks that modern people are often locked in spaces in the form of cubes. the architect chose forms as close to natural as possible. Maybe because of his beliefs he doesn't like being called an architect.




It is worth noting that Antti Lovag was not the only one who had the idea of a bubble house at that time. Such houses were often depicted by the English artist Roger Dean. Perhaps a source of inspiration for Antti Lovag were Roger Dean's paintings.



Roger Dean (August 31, 1944, Ashford, Kent, England) is an English artist, a designer, an architect and a publisher. He is best known for his work on music album covers, which he began drawing in the late 1960s.




Roger Dean, along with his brother Martin, created an entire concept of "organic housing". The series included a house-plant, a sea house, an air house.




Roger became famous for developing the concept of a "sustainable development village", which looks very similar to a hobbit village. And the photos show the interiors of his own home, made in accordance with this concept.

The mansion was originally owned by Pierre Bernard, but later t was bought by the fashion designer Pierre Cardin, so it is also known as "the Pierre Cardin House". The designer himself rarely appears here, so most of the year the house is rented out.

All the rooms are in the form of soap bubbles. All the furniture is round. There are many fluffy carpets from wall to wall. Specially designed lamps change the color of light and it depends on the time of the day.
