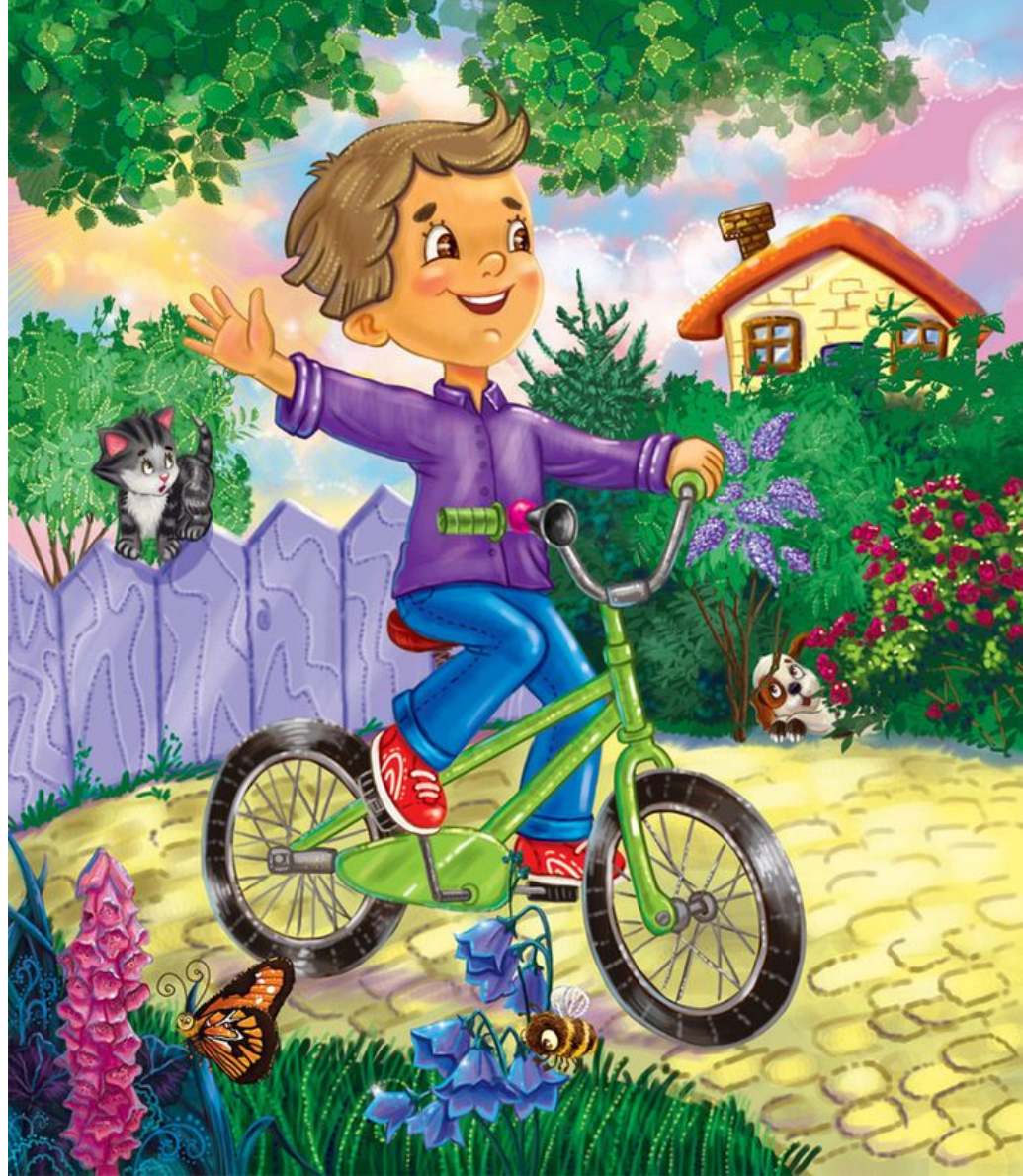
Look at the pictures and say
