

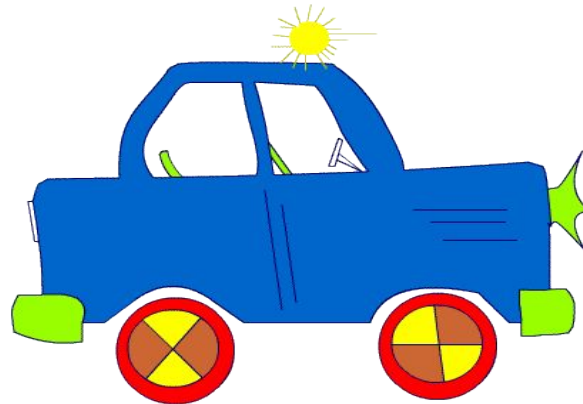


**Let's learn English

but it could have more.



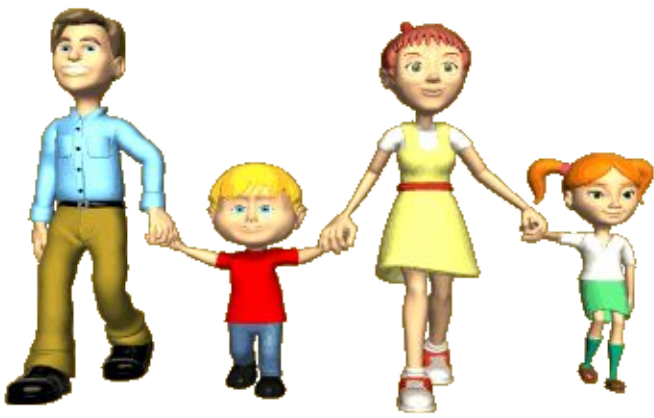


Transport
