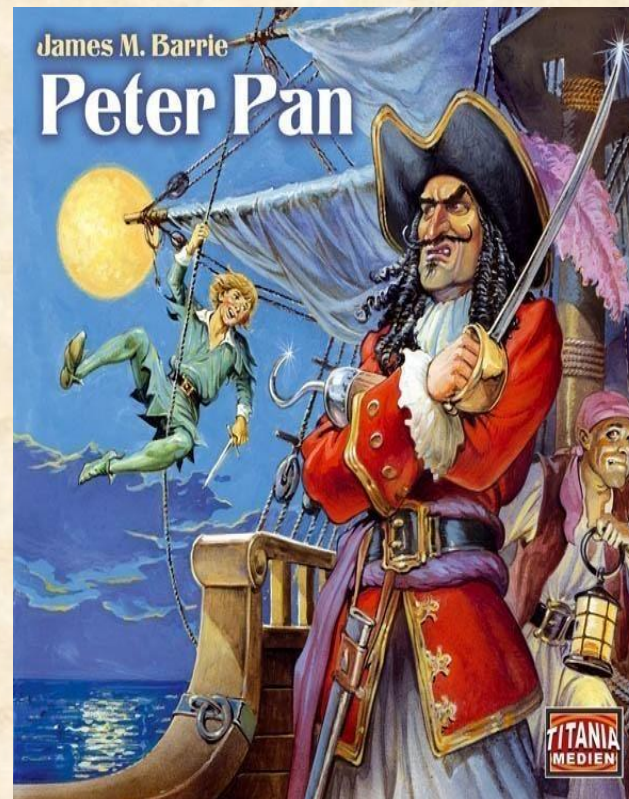
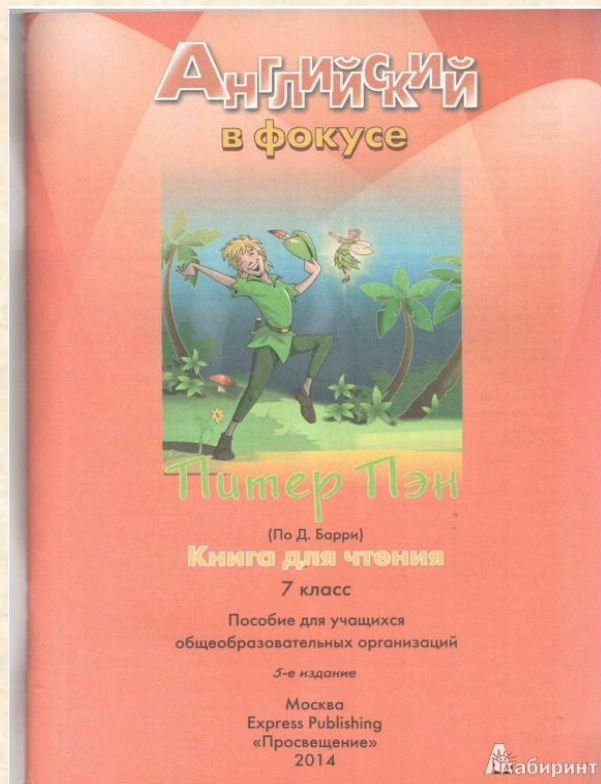

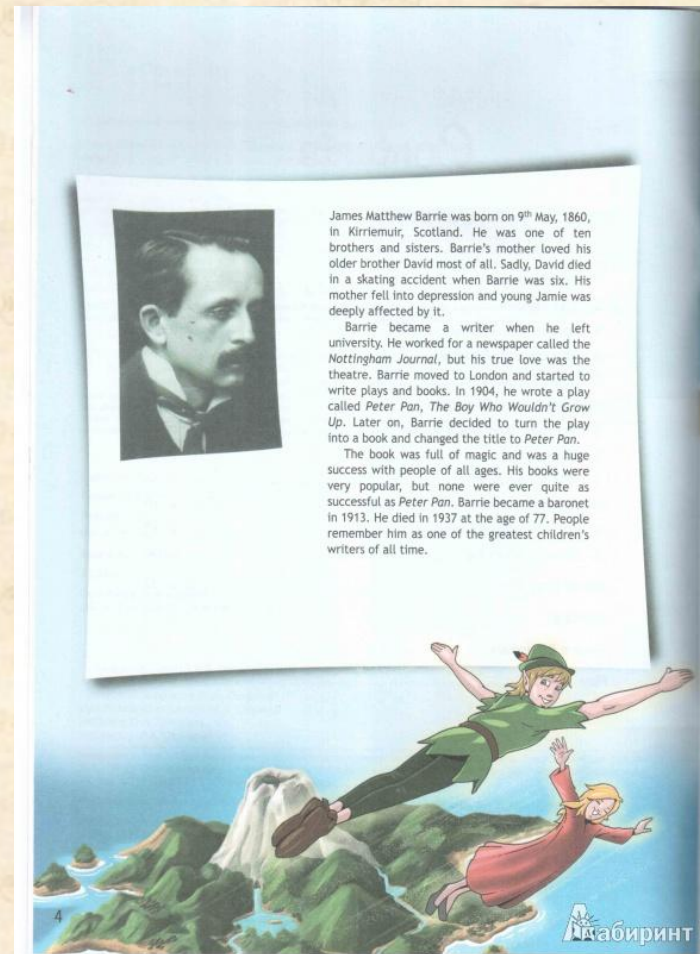

James Mathew Barrie and his famous book "Peter Pan"

- (9 May 1860 – 19 June 1937) was a Scottish author and dramatist, best remembered today as the creator of [Peter Pan](#). The child of a family of small-town weavers, he was educated in Scotland. He moved to London, where he developed a career as a novelist and playwright.

THE DARLINGS

MR DARLING

... is the father of Wendy, John, and Michael and the husband of Mrs Darling. Mr Darling is a strict man. However, he loves his children and he only wants what is best for them.



MRS DARLING

... is the mother of the three children. Mrs Darling is loving and imaginative and loves her family more than anything in the world.

JOHN

... is the middle Darling child. He enjoys playing games and having adventures. He is quite a brave boy. He loves his brother and sister, but he sometimes teases Michael.



MICHAEL

... is the youngest Darling child. Michael likes games, too, and he often pretends to travel to exciting places.

WENDY

... is the oldest of the Darling children. She becomes good friends with Pete. Wendy also becomes a mother for the Lost Boys, and she enjoys her job very much. She is kind and loving.



NANA

... is a loving nanny. She looks after the Darling children. She is kind and good, and she loves the children very much. There is something a little bit strange about her ... Nana is a large dog!



PETER PAN

... is a magical little boy. He never wanted to grow up, so he ran away when he was born. He now lives in the Neverland, and he is the leader of the Lost Boys. He can be gentle and kind, but he is usually naughty, and a little bit uncaring.

TINKER BELL

... is a tiny, pretty fairy. She is Peter Pan's friend, and she goes everywhere with him. Tinker Bell loves Peter, and she is very jealous of Wendy.



THE PIRATES



CAPTAIN HOOK

... is the captain of the pirates and an evil man. Hook hates Peter Pan. He is afraid of the crocodile, because it wants to eat him.

STARKEY

... is a pirate and he lives in the Neverland. The children are afraid of Starkey, because he is a very strict and unkind man.



SMEE



... works for Captain Hook. He is not very clever. He is very afraid of his captain so he always does what Hook tells him to do. Smee is not really a bad man.

THE LOST BOYS

The Lost Boys are young boys who used to live in the real world. Sadly, their parents lost them when they were babies and no one ever found them. The Lost Boys came to live in the Neverland. Peter looks after them, but they really need a mother, because they have never had one.
