# Formal language

- This type of speech may be used ,for example, at official functions, and debates and ceremonies.



# Formal language

- I wonder if you could tell me...
- I should be interested to know...
- I wonder if you could let me know...



# Neutral language

This type of speech is used neither in very formal nor very informal situations.



# Neutral language

- Could you tell me..., please?
- Excuse me, do you know...?
- Can you tell me..., please?
- Do you know where...?



# Informal language

- ◎ This type of speech is used in informal situations with friends, fellow workers and members of the family.



# Informal language

- ( Happen to ) know...?
- ( Got ) any idea...?

	<b>SLANG</b>	Переписка с близкими друзьями
<b>INFORMAL</b>	<b>VULGAR</b>	Использование нецензурных выражений, оскорбительных высказываний
