Formal Informal Neutral



Formal language

This type of speech may be used ,for example, at official functions, and debates and ceremonies.



Formal language

- I wonder if you could tell me...
- I should be interested to know...
- I wonder if you could let me know...



Neutral language

This type of speech is used neither in very formal nor very informal situations.



Neutral language

- Could you tell me..., please?
- Excuse me, do you know...?
- Can you tell me..., please?
- Do you know where...?



Informal language

 This type of speech is used in informal situations with friends, fellow workers and members of the family.



Informal language

(Happen to) know...?
(Got) any idea...?

I wonder if you can tell me your country's climate in different seasons? Where is this situation happening? What language is used in this situation? Whose words are these?




