## Past Simple – V<sub>2</sub>

yesterday, last week, 5 days ago

V<sub>2</sub>=V<sub>1</sub>+ed

- play-played
- help-helped

V<sub>2</sub>=V<sub>2</sub>

- go-went
- spend-spent
- get-got
