




Present Perfect (настоящее совершенное время)


обозначает действие, которое завершилось к настоящему моменту. Используется для того, чтобы показать **результат** действия.



- to write a letter -I have written the letter. You have written the letter. He has written the letter. She has written the letter. We have written the letter. They have written the letter.

- to visit London -I have visited London. You have visited London. He has visited London. She has visited London. We have visited London. They have visited London.





He is cleaning his shoes.




He has cleaned his shoes. (= his shoes are clean *now*)



They are at home.




They are going out.






