

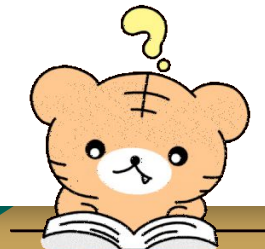

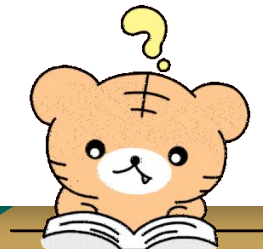

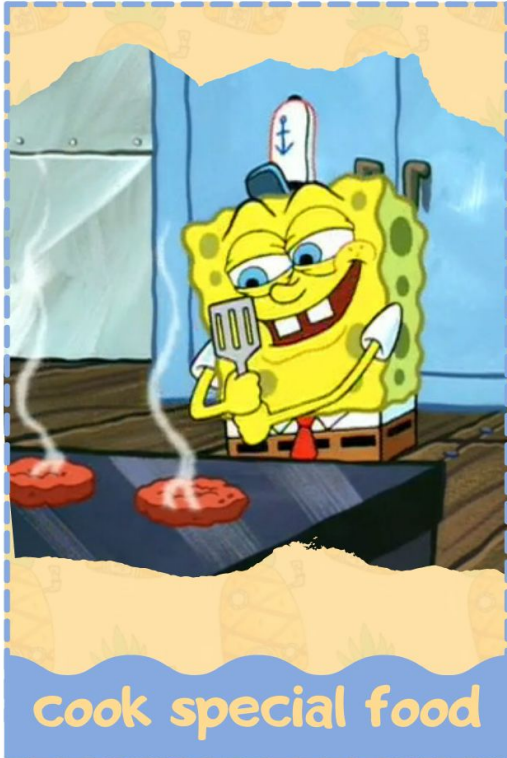

Easter

Пасха

Easter is the **celebration of the death and coming to life again of Jesus Christ**. Easter day **moves around on the calendar each year**, but is always on a Sunday. Easter is the time for holidays and festivals. At Easter, people cook special food and **also paint Easter boiled eggs**.

- **celebration of the death and coming to life again of Jesus Christ** - празднование смерти и воскресения Иисуса Христа
- **moves around on the calendar each year** - каждый год празднуется в разный день календаря
- **also paint Easter boiled eggs** - также красят пасхальные варёные яйца



Birthday

День рождения

Your birthday is **the day on which you were born**. It is a special day just for you. The tradition of celebrating a birthday **happens in all countries**. Usually on a birthday people dress up in beautiful clothes and **receive presents**. There is also a tradition to have a family dinner and **eat a cake**.

- **the day on which you were born** - день, когда ты родился
- **happens in all countries** - празднуется по всему миру
- **receive presents** - получать подарки
- **eat a cake** - есть торт



Women's day

Международный женский день

On the 8th of March we **celebrate** Women's Day. Men and young boys **try to make women happy** - they cook a good dinner, congratulate mothers and grandmas and give them flowers. It is also a tradition to **give presents** such as chocolate, **candies and other sweets**.

- **celebrate** - праздновать
- **try to make women happy** - пытаются сделать женщин счастливыми
- **give presents** - дарить подарки
- **candies and other sweets** - конфетки и прочие сладости



Victory Day

День победы

In Russia people **celebrate** Victory Day on the 9th of May. Some cities have parades and people have family dinners. Most people **watch the Moscow parade on TV**. It's a great day, a **national holiday**. We celebrate **victory over fascism**. We watch concerts in the evening on TV and set off fireworks in the streets and **squares of big cities**.

- **celebrate** - праздновать
- **watch the Moscow parade on TV** - смотреть по телевизору московский парад
- **national holiday** - национальный праздник
- **victory over fascism** - победа над фашизмом
- **squares of big cities** - площади больших городов

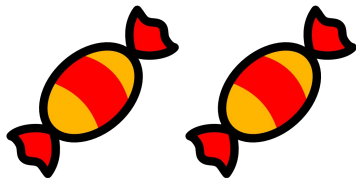
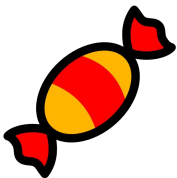

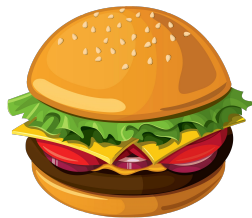
