If there is no dark place, shade 2 ropes on the objects on top of them, put a rag on them.

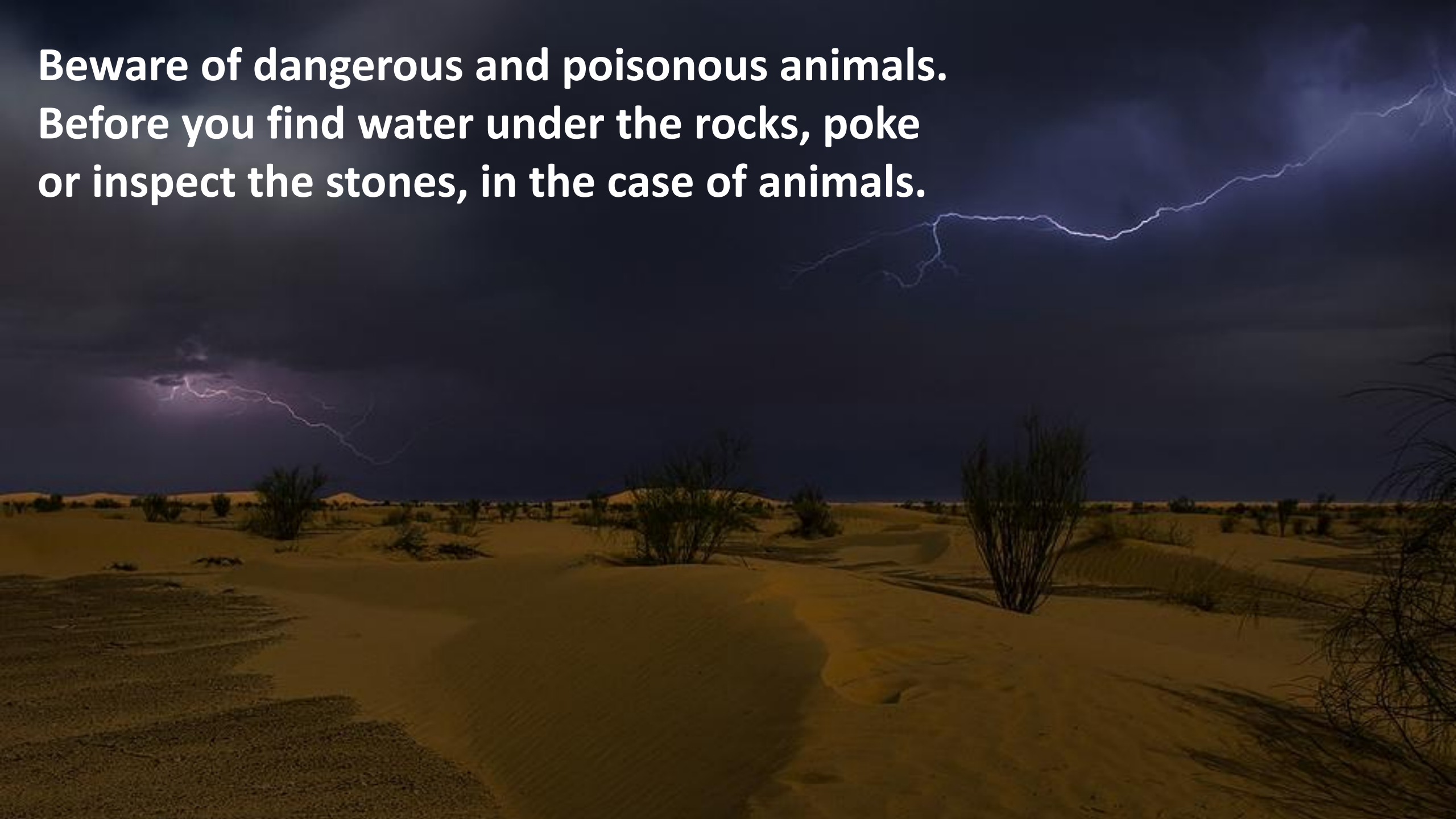
