2. The maxillary sinus is the largest of the paranasal sinuses and is located in the maxilla.

3. The ethmoidal sinuses are located in the ethmoidal labyrinth and consist of the superior, middle, and inferior ethmoidal sinuses.

4. The sphenoidal sinus is located in the sphenoid bone and is the most posterior of the paranasal sinuses.

5. The inferior meatus is the largest of the three meatuses and is located in the inferior nasal concha.

6. The middle meatus is located in the middle nasal concha and contains the maxillary, ethmoidal, and sphenoidal sinuses.

7. The superior meatus is the smallest of the three meatuses and is located in the superior nasal concha.

8. The inferior meatus is the largest of the three meatuses and is located in the inferior nasal concha.
