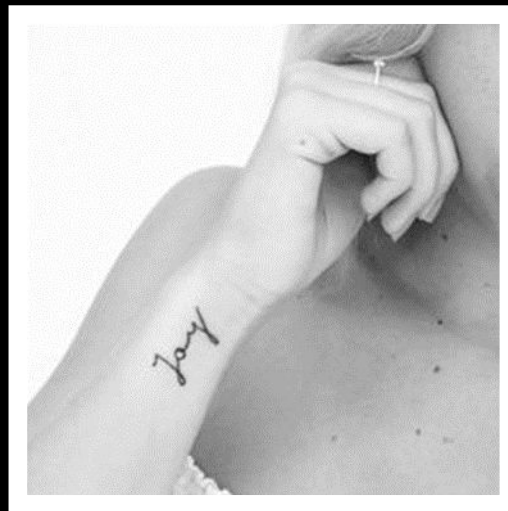
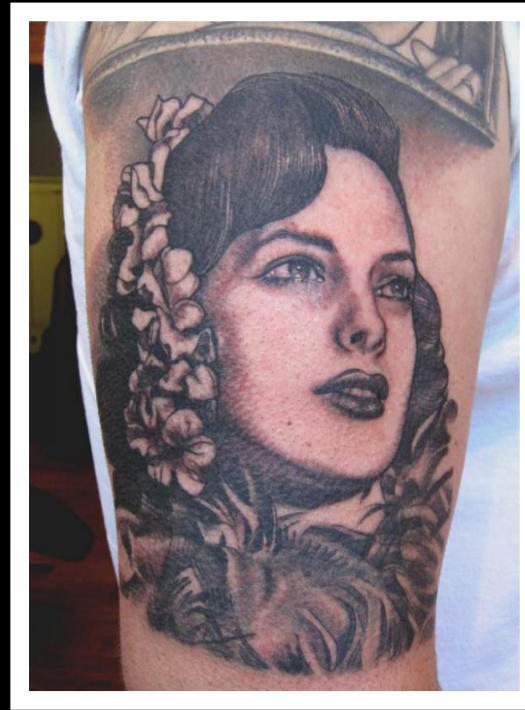

Sentence Structure

Simple Sentence

Compound Sentence

Example: The motivations behind tattoos vary, but they are currently very much in style with no signs of the fad waning.

Complex Sentence

Example: Their body art may not look as crisp with the passage of time, or their interests and passions may change.



VOCABULARY

- *Tribal - a social group existing before the development of a country. Example: Clan and tribal life.*

- *Affiliation - a connection with a political party or religion, or with a larger organization.*

Example: The group has affiliations with several organizations abroad

- *Fad- a style, activity, or interest that is very popular for a short period of time*

Example: In the UK there was a fad for wearing ripped jeans a few years ago.
