It was built in 1703

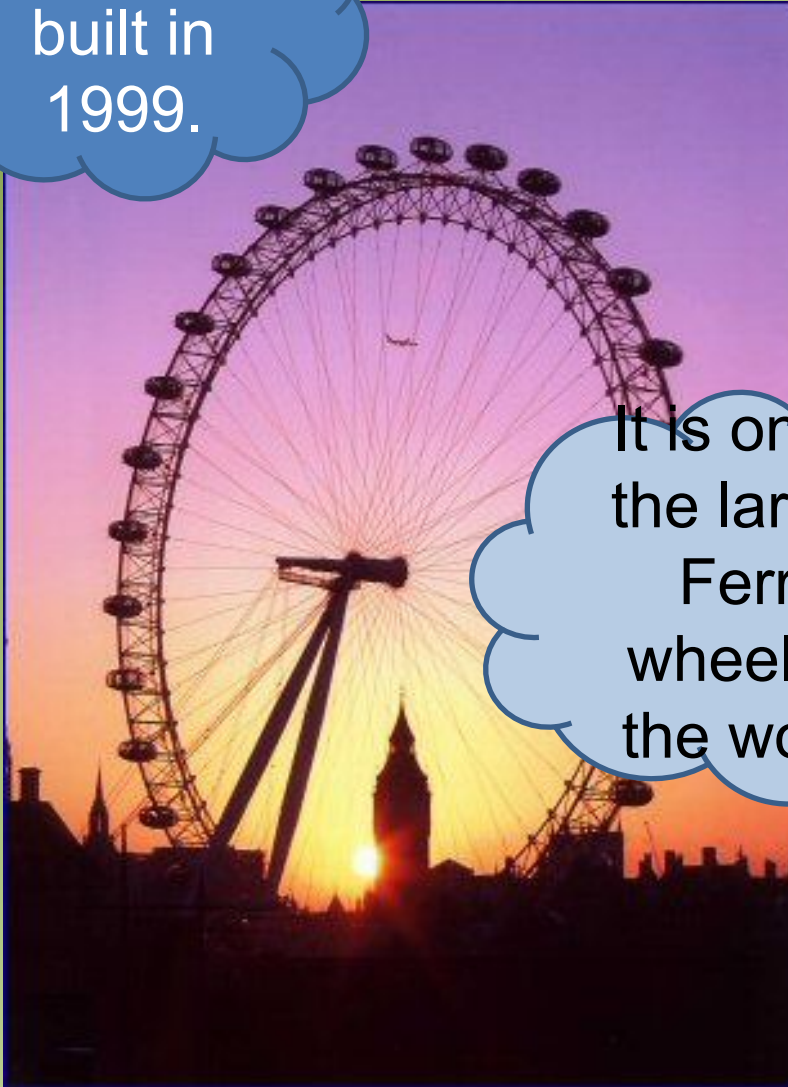


The London Eye
