COLOR MODULE LEVEL 3

- rgba();
- currentColor;
- transparent = rgba(0, 0, 0, 0);

SELECTORS LEVEL 3

- Basic selectors (elname, .class, #id, [attr=value], *);
- Combinators:
 - AB (Descendant selectors)
 - A > B (Child selectors)
 - A + B (Adjacent sibling selectors)
 - <u>A~B</u> (General sibling selectors)
- Pseudo-classes (:empty, :first-of-type, :not, :only-child, :nth-child(n), :nth-child(an+b), :nth-last-child(an+b));
- Pseudo-elements (:first-line, :before, :after);

VALUES AND UNITS MODULE LEVEL 3

- <u>initial</u> and <u>inherit</u>;
