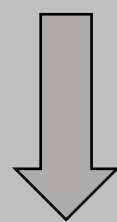
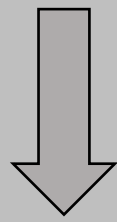
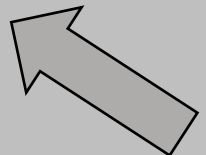
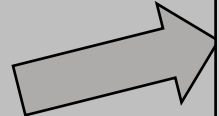
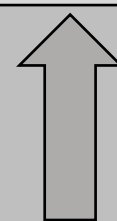
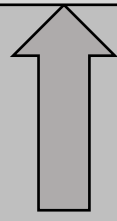
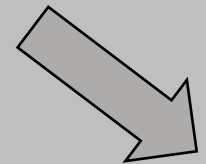
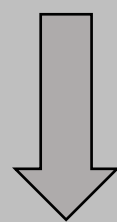
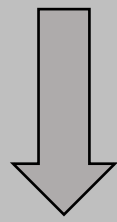
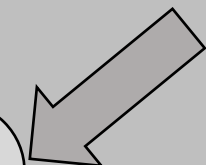
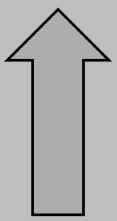
So, he did calendar in the tree and made short cuts
