

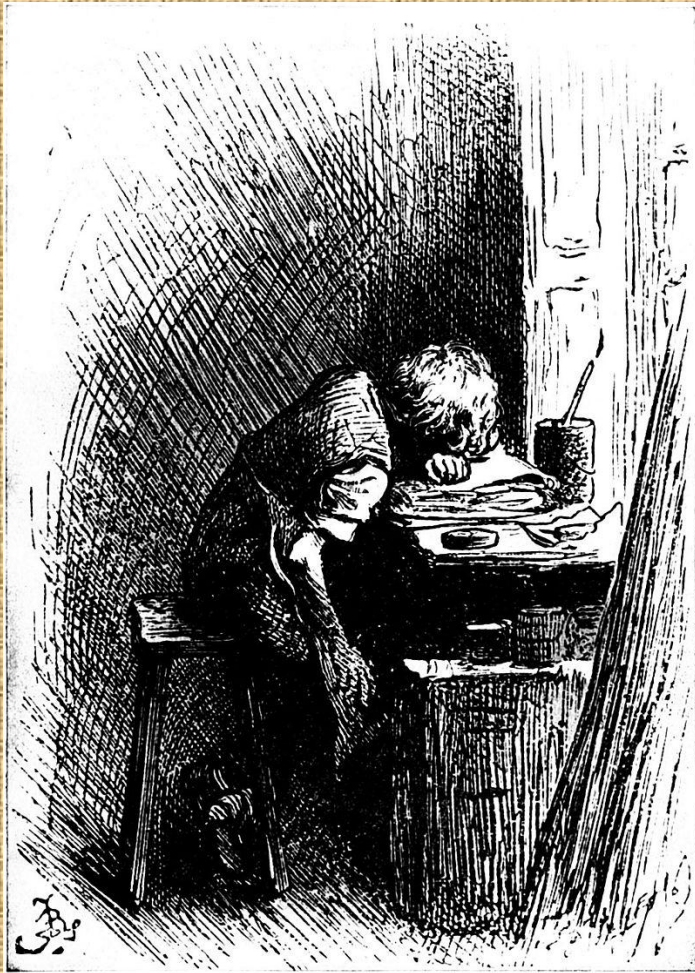

The Audience is earnestly requested to be seated Ten Minutes before the commencement of the Reading.

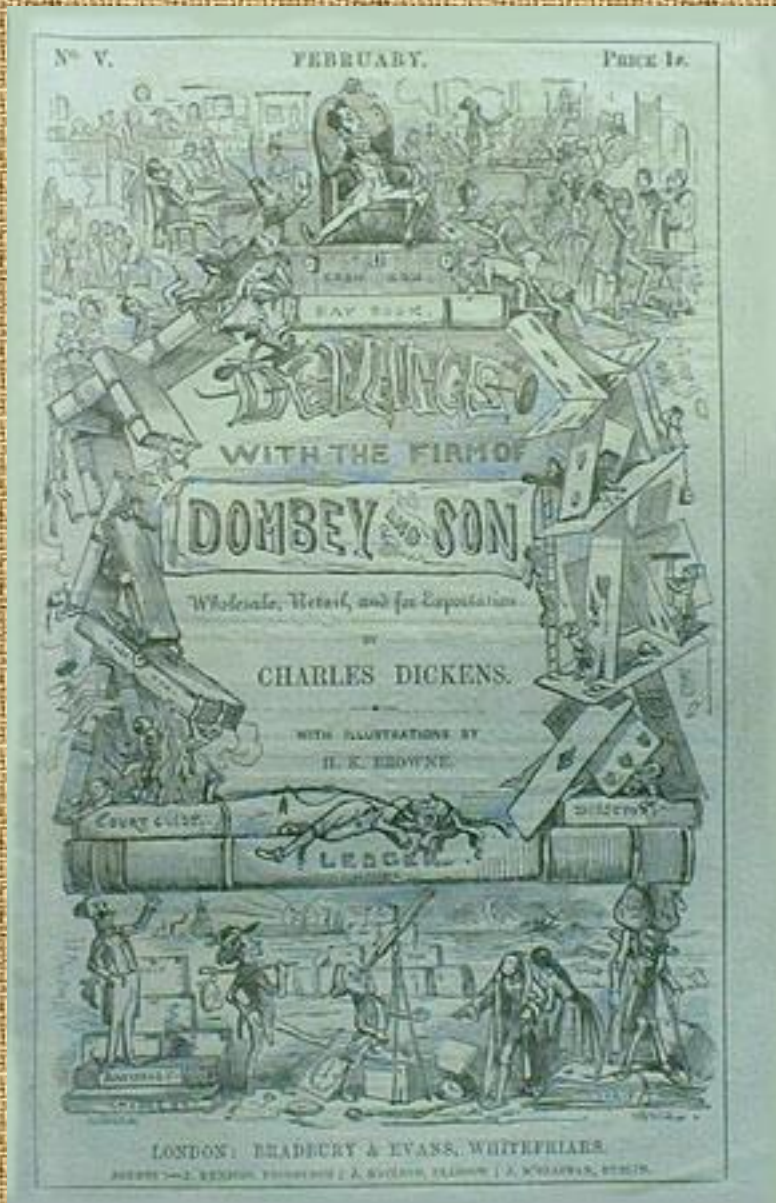

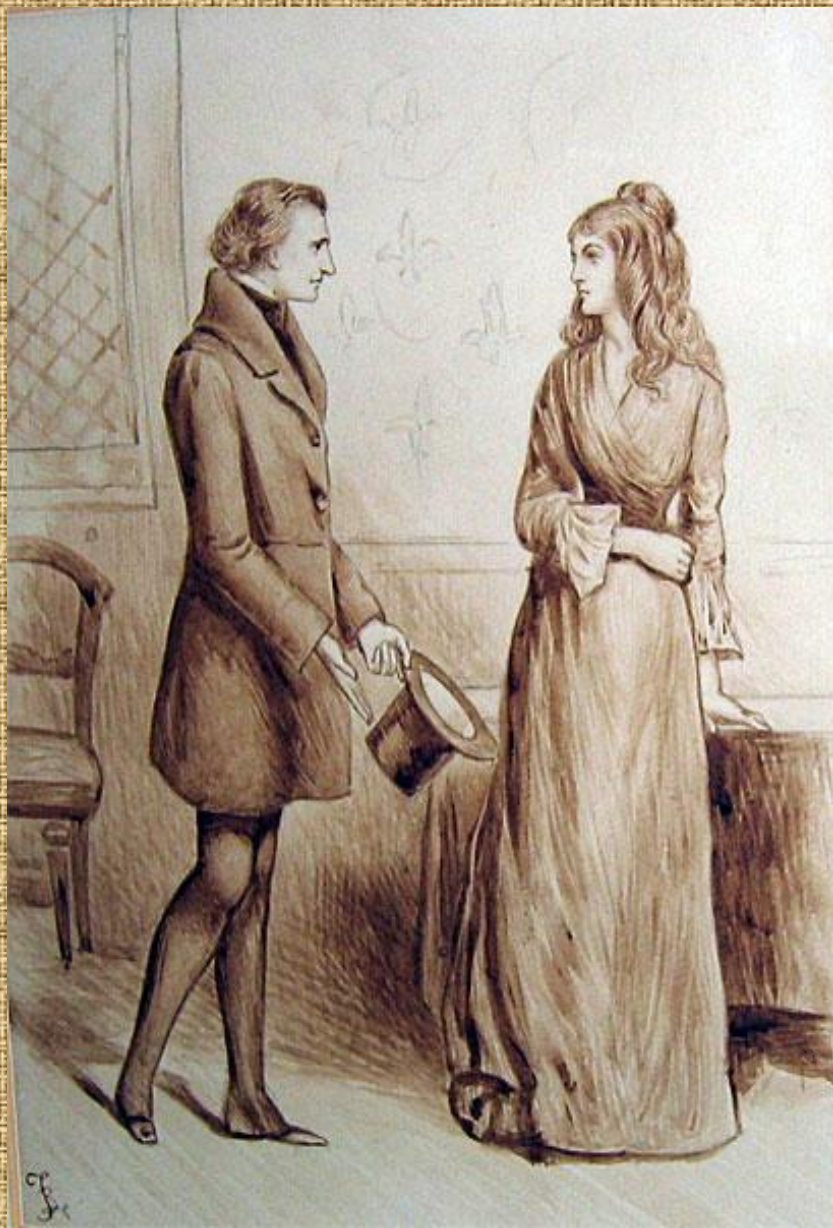
