- But there is a lack for tourists. They can not fully enjoy the view of sights of America.



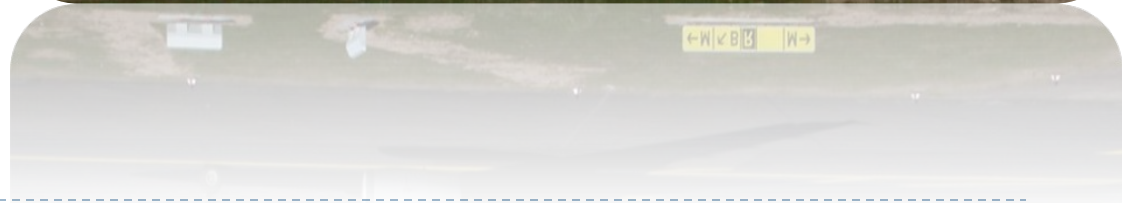
TRANSPORT IN RUSSIA

□ *Well-developed is air transport. The main airports are Moscow, St. Petersburg, Resorts of the North Caucasus Ekaterinburg, Novosibirsk, Irkutsk, Khabarovsk, Vladivostok.*

- it can be done by bus. In Russia, the passenger traffic carried by urban, suburban and intercity routes and buses. However, this type of transport has its drawbacks, this is the roads that are in most in not so good condition.
