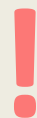

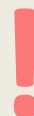

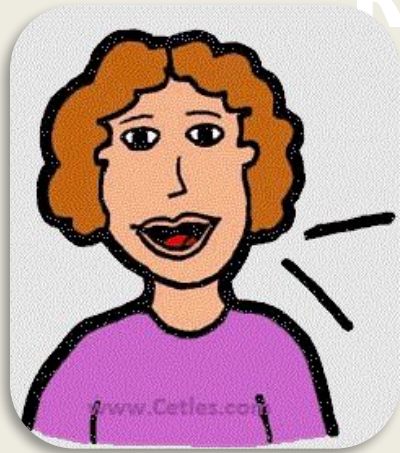

Mrs. John *advised* her son *not to spend* all *his* money on gadgets.

"You have not done your work well," said the teacher to me.



"I don't go to this shop very often," she said.

"Please help me with this work, Henry," said Robert.

Lakshmi said, 'I'm leaving.'

Boris said to them: "How can I get to the railway station?"

I said to Chris: "Does your friend live in London?"

"I am going to the theatre tonight," he said to me.
