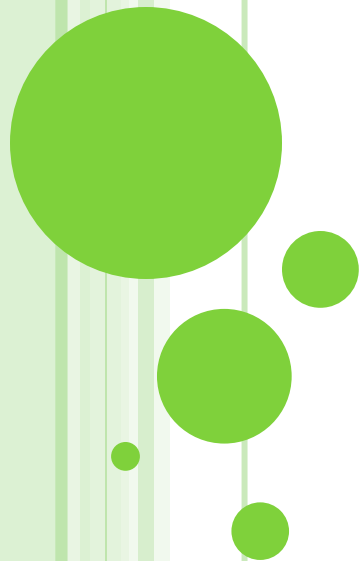



# PREPARATION...

1. International passport
2. Properly and fully completed visa application form
3. One recent passport size photo
4. Visa supporting documents. The documents must contain an applicant's name, passport number, dates and points of arrival and departure, cities to be visited, agency's reference (or registration number) officially provided by the Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The stamp and all the details should be clearly readable.
5. Travel insurance policy
6. Appropriate payment.

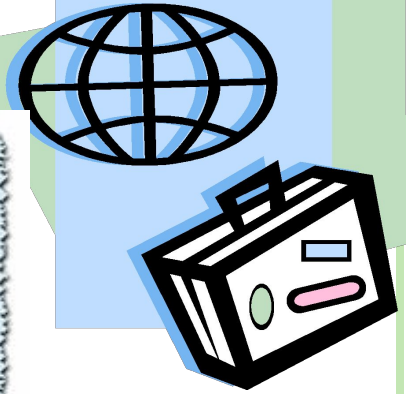

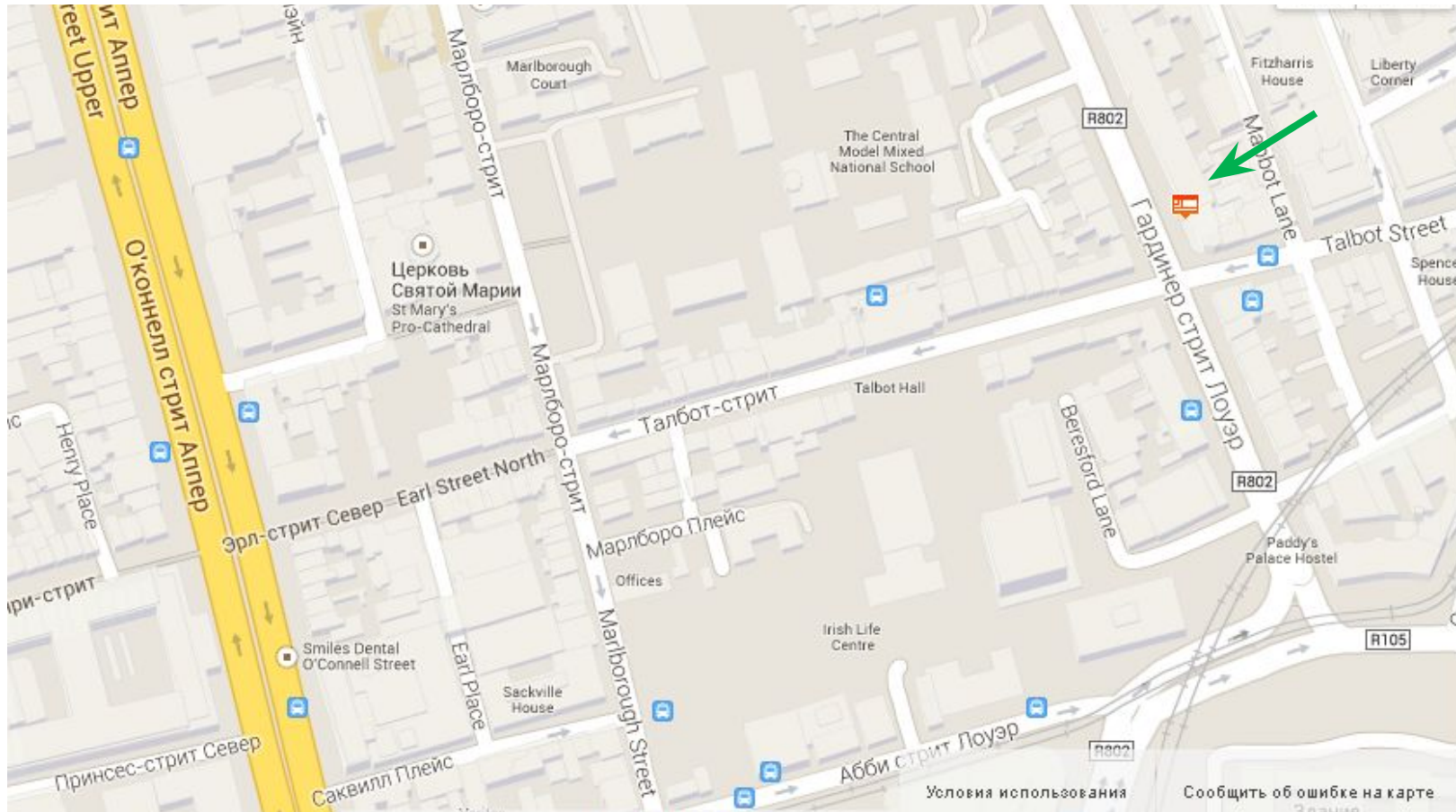
# DUBLIN

Dublin became the capital of the Irish Free State and later the Republic of Ireland in 1922.



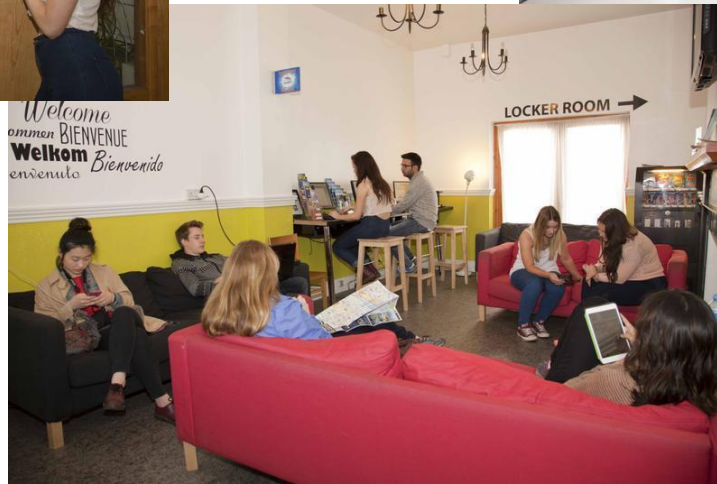

# 21 AUGUST

## 1. King John's Castle in Limerick (free)

The focal point of Limerick's historic English City is this 13th-century castle, commissioned by King John of England.



## 2. University of Limerick (free)

Established in 1972, the University of Limerick is a modern institution that became recognized as a university in 1989, making it the first new university



# 22 AUGUST

## 1. St Mary's Cathedral in Limerick (free)

This 800-year-old cathedral is one of Ireland's oldest and features a Romanesque doorway (West Door). The building is today used by the Church of Ireland as an Anglican place of worship.



## 2. Georgian House and Garden (free)

one of Limerick's architectural gems, having been restored to its original glory and today protected by the Limerick Civic Trust. Visitors can tour its stark servants' quarters and lofty bedrooms as well as its pretty manicured garden and experience the grandeur of a Georgian home.



# 23 AUGUST

## 1. Lough Gur excursion (€ 23)

The remains of an ancient settlement dating to 3,000 BC rest on the banks of Lough Gur, 18 kilometres south of Limerick. Inhabited from Neolithic to medieval times, the settlement is one of Ireland's most significant archaeological sites.

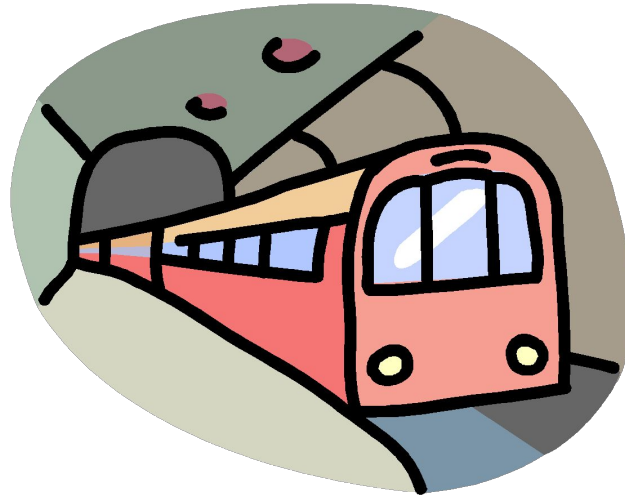

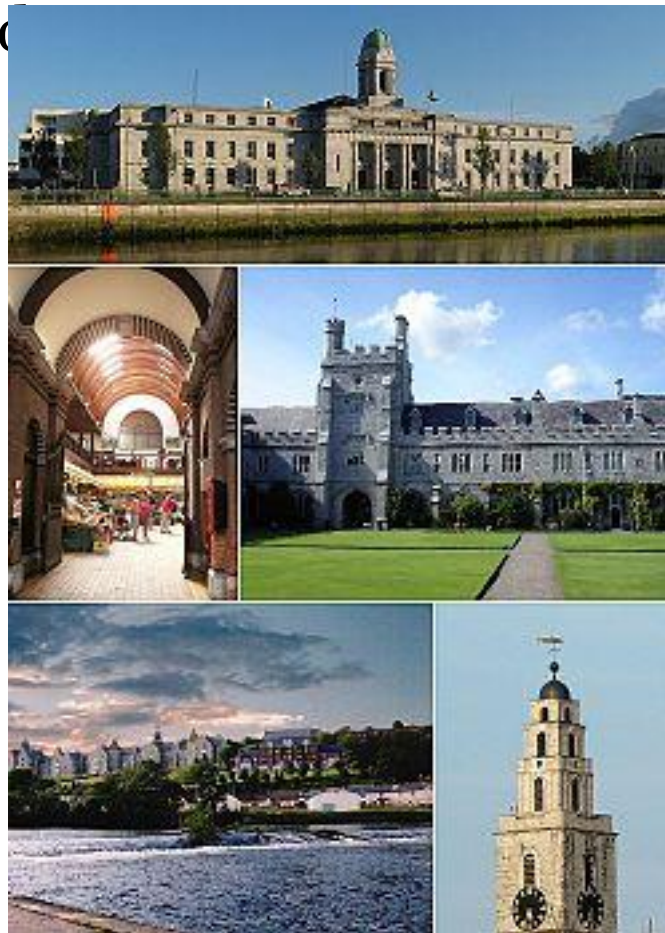

# CORK

It is located in the South-West Region and in the province of Munster. It is the second largest city in the state and the third most populous on the island of Ireland

# 24 AUGUST

## 1. Cork City Gaol Heritage Centre (€28)

Set in a spooky listed building, this somewhat touristy centre nevertheless manages to give an eerie glimpse of 19th-century prison life, including original graffiti on cell walls, and wax figures of inmates and gaolers. An audio-visual presentation sets the mood and explains the reasons why people living in 19th-century Cork turned to a life of crime.

## 2. Opera house (€45)

Many different events are staged here all through the year, including concerts, plays, musicals, comedy gigs, exhibitions, film screenings and a seasonal panto, to audiences of just under 600 people.





# 25 AUGUST

## 1. **Masters of Tradition** (free)

is one of Ireland's leading traditional Irish music festivals which celebrates traditional music in its purest form.

The 2014 festival throws open its doors to some of the very best musicians in the land. The idea for the festival evolved from Artistic Director Martin Hayes' call to create a 'quiet and intimate space' where the heart of traditional music could be exposed.
