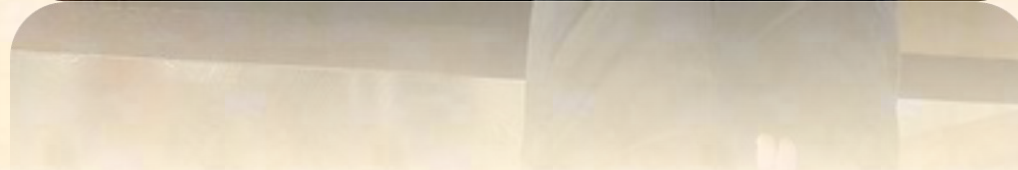


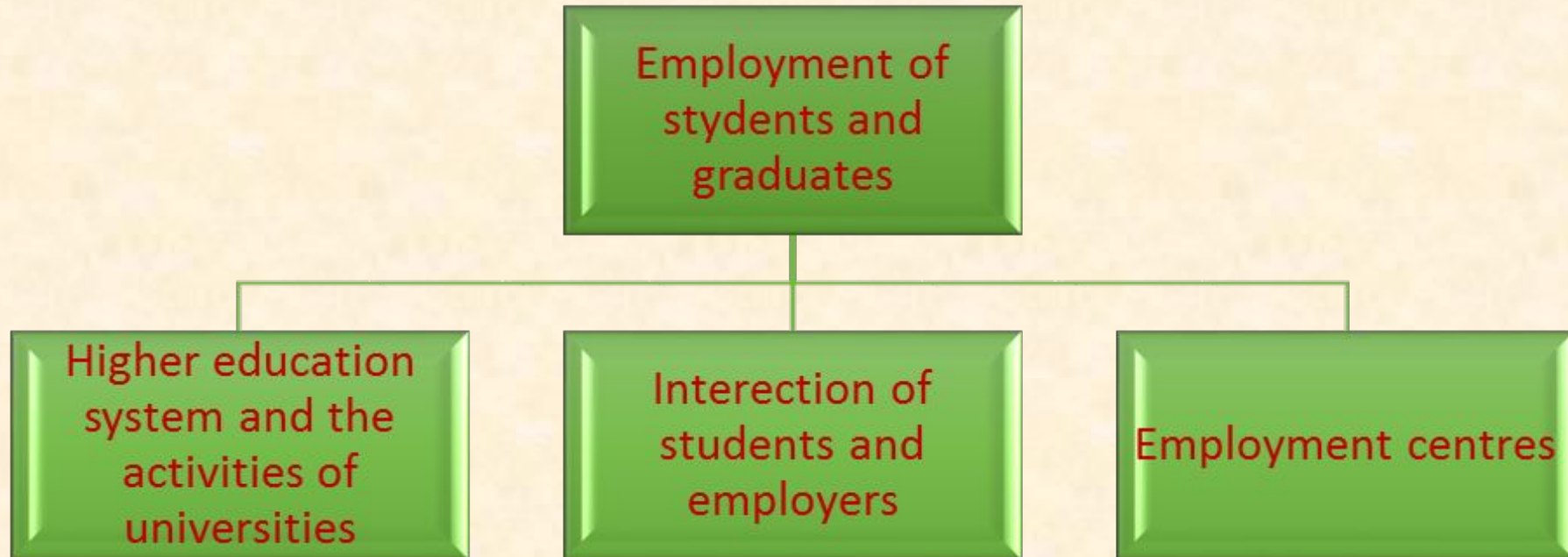

<b>Specialist(Speciality)</b>	<b>Bachelor(Baccalaureate)</b>
- this program of education is rare	- the most widespread form of education
1. you receive specific qualification and practical knowledge 2. the period of study 5 - 5.5 years	1. No specific qualification, wide theoretical knowledge, but minimum practical knowledge 2. the period of study - 4 years



<b>Master(magistracy)</b>
1. continuing studying after bachelor 2. the period of study - 2 years

...NO experience – NO job . And even the name of a prestigious university and a diploma with distinction is not a panacea for unemployment...

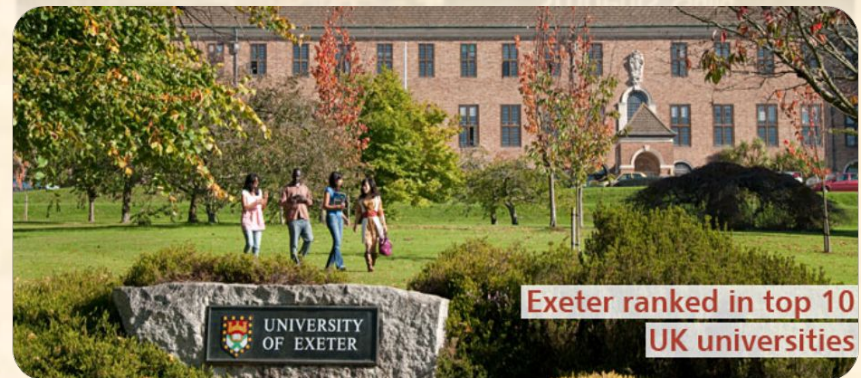
