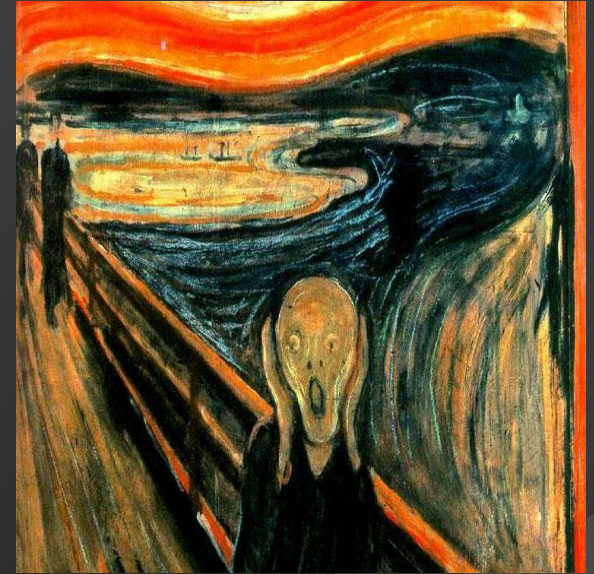

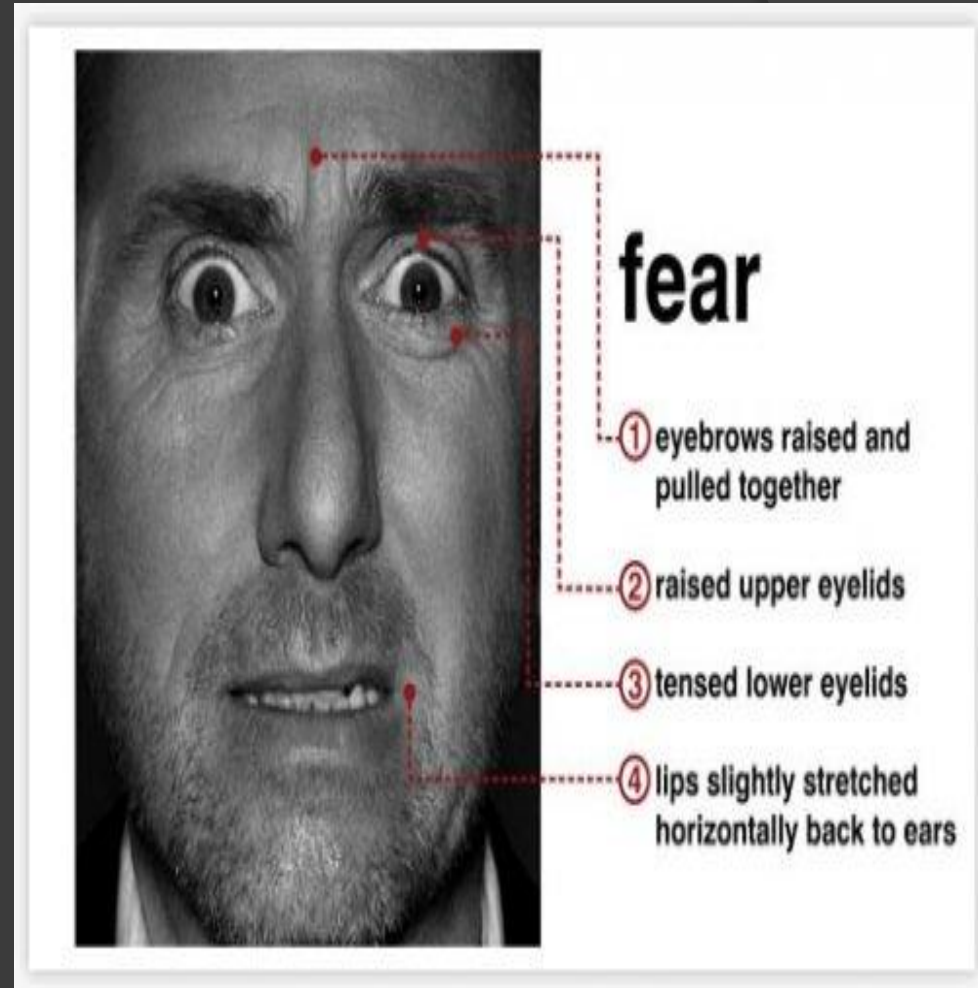
## “Phobias”

- ⦿ A phobia (from the Greek: φόβος, Phóbos, meaning "fear" or "morbid fear")
- ⦿ This is a persistent fear of an object or situation
- ⦿ In the event the phobia cannot be avoided entirely



**Psychologists and psychiatrists classify most phobias into three categories:**

# Social phobia:

Fears involving other people or social situations such as performance anxiety or fears of embarrassment by scrutiny of others, such as eating in public



# Specific phobias:

Fear of a single specific panic trigger such as spiders, snakes, dogs, water, heights, flying, catching a specific illness, etc. Many people have these fears but to a lesser degree than those who suffer from specific phobias.



# Agoraphobia:

**A generalized fear of leaving home or a small familiar 'safe' area, and of possible panic attacks that might follow.**

Androphobia – fear of men



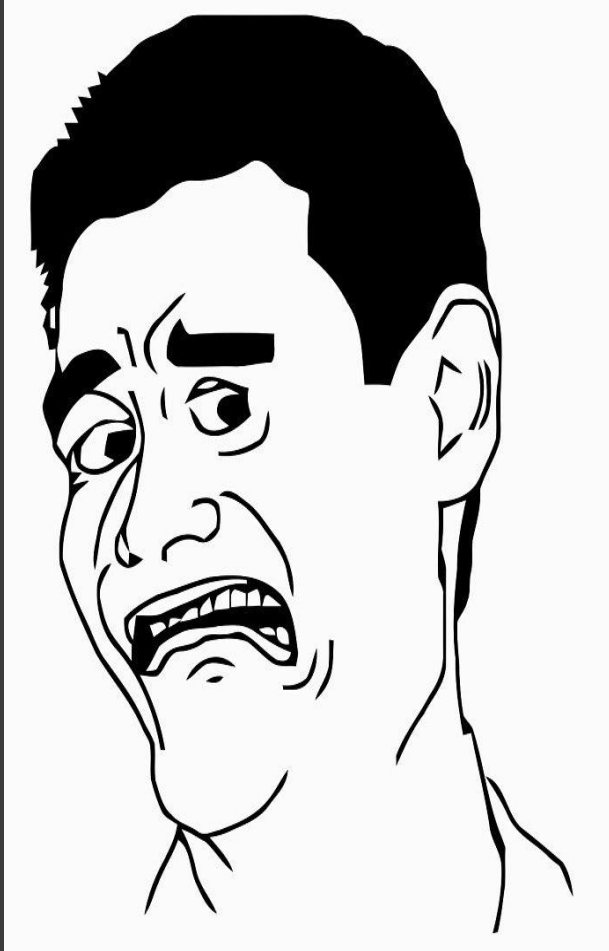
# Somniphobia – fear of sleep
