# Have you got...?



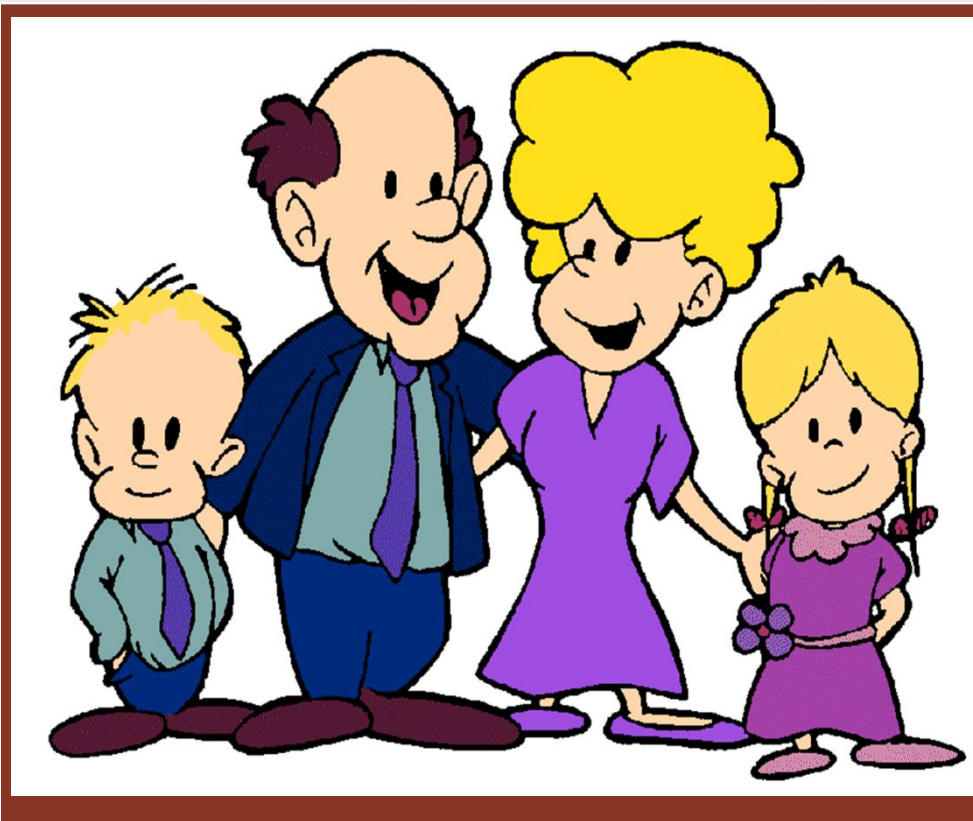
Have you got a big family?
