Karl Pavlovich Bryullov

(12 December 1799 – 11 June 1852), historical artist and portraitist. His most famous works are Last day of Pompeii (1833), Rider-woman, Portrait of Krylov (1839), Portrait of Strugovschikov (1840), Portrait of A.P. Brullov,



Vasily Andreevich Tropinin

(30 March 1776 – 16 May 1857), a famous Russian portraitist in the Romanticism movement. His most famous works are portraits of Count Morkows (family portrait, 1813), his son Arseny (1818), Nikolay Karamzin (1818), Alexander Pushkin (1827) and Vasily Karatyjin (1842).

(29 July 1817 – 2 May 1900), greatest marine artist in history. His most famous works are: Night. The Blue Wave, The Ninth Wave, View on Leandrian Tower in Constantinople, Black Sea Fleet.
